TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Athletics play the second game of a three-game series today, as the two teams meet this weekend for the first time since the 2014 campaign...This marks just the fifth all-time series between these clubs...The Braves have won three of the previous four series and own a 9-4 record against the A's, including a three-game sweep at Turner Field in Atlanta in 2014.

- For the Braves, this is only their second-ever visit to Oakland and the first visit since 2003.
- Atlanta posted a 3-1 win last night.
- For the Braves, this is the fifth game of a six-game road trip to San Diego (1-2) and Oakland (1-0)... The Braves are 18-21 on the road this season.
- Atlanta has won nine of its last 13 games and 14
- The Braves finished the month of June with a 16-12 record...It marked their best win total in that month since June 2013, when they were also 16-12 en route to a 94-68 season.

FOLTY'S CLOSE CALL: Last night Braves starter Mike Foltynewicz carried a no-hitter into the ninth nning before allowing a solo home run to Matt Olson to ead off the frame...Foltynewicz ended with a line of 8.0 P, 1 H, 1 R, 4 BB and 8 Ks...His eight innings matched nis career best and his 119 pitches were a career high.

Foltynewicz's effort marked the Braves' longest no-hit bid since Shelby Miller went 8.2 innings on May 17, 2015 at Miami (a 6-0 Braves win).

ENTER THE INTERLEAGUE: Today the Braves play the 11th of 20 scheduled interleague contests this eason (10 home/10 road).

The Braves are 5-5 in interleague play this season and have gone just 26-44 (.371) against the AL since 2014...Atlanta owns a 174-175 record against the AL since interleague play began in 1997.

DH HISTORY: In 176 road games against the American League, Braves designated hitters have posted a .243 batting average with 69 runs scored, 16 home runs and 78 RBI.

Braves DHs have hit .233 (7-for-30) with no homers and three RBI in eight games this season.

WINNING THE CLOSE ONES: The Braves have gone 21-18 (.538) in games decided by one or two runs...Last year they went 36-43 (.455) in such games.

RUNS IN JUNE: The Braves scored 138 runs in June, which ranked seventh in the NL...That total also marks the most the team has scored in the month of June since 2005, when they also had 138.

Atlanta averaged 4.9 runs last month and is 29-5 this season when scoring five-or-more runs and 21-0 when scoring six-or-more runs in a game.

THE HIT MAN: OF Ender Inciarte went hitless last night and snapped an 11-game hitting streak...He ranks third in the majors with 102 base hits this season.

- Since the All-Star break last season, Inciarte leads the majors with 202 hits...He has played 151 games in that span and is also one of just eight players to score at least 100 runs in that timeframe (5th with 111).
- Inciarte is just the 35th Atlanta player (since 1966), to collect at least 100 hits prior to the All-Star break, with Freddie Freeman being that last to do so in 2014 (108)...Ralph Garr holds the Atlanta record with 149 hits prior to the All-Star break in 1974.
- He finished second in the NL with 39 hits in the month of June after posting 40 hits in May and fell a hit shy of becoming the fifth player in Atlanta history have consecutive 40-hit months: Felipe Alou ('66); Ralph Garr ('73 & '74); Gary Matthews ('79); Martin Prado ('10).
- Inciarte is hitting .339 (19-for-56) against lefthanded pitching this season, which is the best mark in the majors among left-handed batters...He has only struck out six times when facing a lefty.
- Inciarte is hitting .352 (58-for-165) at SunTrust Park, the fifth-best home mark in the NL.

START ME UP: Rookie INF Johan Camargo stroked a third-inning double last night to extend his hitting streak to a career-high six games...He has made 18 starts this season (15 at 3B) and as a starter he has batted .308 (20-for-65) with nine runs scored and 11 RBI.

ADAMS DAY-TO-DAY: Braves 1B Matt Adams suffered a left foot contusion on a foul ball Thursday at SD...X-rays were negative and he is day-to-day...Adams has played 37 games for Atlanta and is batting .294 with 12 homers and 31 RBI...Of his 42 hits with Atlanta, 21 have gone for extra bases.

- Atlanta's first basemen have combined to hit 26 home runs, which is tied for the most by any single position for a Major League team...Freddie Freeman hit 14 before fracturing his left wrist in May...Yankees right fielders also have 26 homers.
- Since playing in his first Braves game on May 21, Adams is tied for third in the majors with 12 homers and is tied for seventh in the majors with 31 RBI... His 21 extra-base hits are tied for sixth in MLB.

MR. CONSISTENT: OF Nick Markakis has hit .305 (29-for-95) with 18 RBI over his last 25 games... Markakis has reached base safely via hit, walk or HBP in 48 of his last 55 games and in 68 of 79 games overall.

Now in his 12th Major League season, Markakis stands 24 hits shy of 2,000 for his career...Markakis ranks 11th among all active career hit leaders, despite being tied for the fewest number of years of service among players in the top 20...The other two who are also in their 12th season are Ian Kinsler (No. 17 - 1,757) and **Dustin Pedroia** (No. 18 - 1,753).

Today's Game

- A Set to make his 16th start with the Braves after signing with the team as a free agent on 11/18/16...This turn will also mark his 385th career appearance and his 284th start.
- Æ Faces the A's for the first time since 7/16/16, when he allowed five hits and five runs over 6.0 innings to take the loss...Has tossed at least 6.0 innings in eight consecutive starts against Oakland, including seven "quality" turns.
 - A In 19 career games against Oakland (15 starts), is 4-6 with a 4.38 ERA (49 ER/100.2 IP)...Tossed a complete game on 7/3/14 at O.co Coliseum, allowing four runs (two earned) over 8.0 innings in a 4-1 loss.
- A Is 15-9 with a 3.94 ERA (91 ER/207.2 IP) in 43 career interleague outings (30 starts)...Today marks his first interleague start of the season.
- A Since becoming a full-time starter in 2010, has made 236 starts, tied for the fifth most in baseball over that time frame...His 1532.1 innings are the eighth most in baseball since that season.
- A Among active pitchers, his 15 complete games are tied for 14th, while his six shutouts are tied for 16th.

2017 Recap

- A Has walked two over his last four starts, and 6/8 and 6/13 marked his first two this season without a base-on-balls...Walked 34 through his first 11 games...Finished 2016 with 63 walks...His 3.6 BB/9 rate is his highest since 2009, when he had a 4.2 mark
- A Allowed one run over 7.0 innings to earn the win in his last start, 6/24 vs. MIL... Tossed 7.0 innings and allowed one earned run or fewer in three of his last four turns, all at home.
 - A Is 1-4 with a 6.88 ERA (26 ER/34.0 IP) in six starts on the road...In comparison, is 5-1 with a 3.30 ERA (21 ER/57.1 IP) in nine turns at home.
- A Went 7.0 shutout innings, 6/19 vs. SF, allowing three hits and one walk to earn his fifth win of the season...His start tied the longest scoreless outing by pitcher at SunTrust Park...Mike Foltynewicz (6/7 vs. PHI) and WSH's Max Scherzer (4/18) are the only other pitchers to go as long in a scoreless effort...Foltynewicz is the only other Braves pitcher to have a scoreless start there.
- A Snapped a six-start winless stretch, 6/8 vs. PHI...Allowed just three hits and one run over 7.0 innings, fanning a season-best eight batters...The win was his first since 5/2 vs. NYM.
- An official scoring change credited Dickey with two more earned runs in his start vs.WSH on 5/19...A Jace Peterson error was changed to a double for Bryce Harper, resulting in all four runs against Dickey being earned.
- A Pitched on short rest in taking a no-decision in a 6-5 win over PIT on 5/23... Marked the 16th time in his career he started on less than four days of rest... Went 6.0 innings, allowing 11 hits and three runs, earned... For his career is 5-8 with a 5.65 ERA (59 ER/94.0 IP) on short rest.
- $\mathcal A$ Dropped his second decision of the season, 3-2 on 4/20 vs.WSH, despite going 7.0 innings and limiting the Nationals to three hits and three runs.
 - A Threw only 73 pitched to complete his 7.0 innings, the fewest pitches he needed to go as deep into a game in his career.
- Mon his first decision in a Braves uniform after beating San Diego 4-2 on 4/15 at SunTrust Park...Went 6.0 innings and allowed two runs, earned, while striking out six...Threw 89 pitches, 63 for strikes.
- Æ Lost his Braves debut, 6-4 on 4/8 at PIT...Allowed six runs, but only three earned, as the Braves had three passed balls and made two errors behind him.
 - ${\cal A}~$ Drove in two runs, his first RBI since 2013, with a second-inning single.

2016 Recap

- A In his fourth season with Toronto, compiled his highest ERA (4.46) since becoming a full-time starter in 2010...His 169.2 IP were his fewest since 2010, while he lost a career-most 15 games.
- A Snapped a five-season string of at least 200.0 IP...From 2011-2015, tossed the fourth-most innings in MLB (1,097.0)...Only James Shields (1135.0), Clayton Kershaw (1128.0) and Felix Herandez (1107.2) worked more.
- A After the first of August, compiled a 3.76 ERA (16 ER/38.1 IP) and allowed only two home runs over eight games, seven starts to finish the season...From the beginning of the season through the end of July, tied for the MLB lead with 26 home runs allowed while tying for second with 12 losses.
- A Reached 30 games pitched for the sixth consecutive season...Is one of seven MLB pitchers with such a streak (James Shields, Max Scherzer, Jon Lester, Ian Kennedy, Cole Hamels and Madison Bumgarner).

Career Recap

- A Won the National League CyYoung Award in 2012 after winning a career-best 20 games...Also made his only All-Star game that season.
- A Won his only Gold Glove award in 2013.
- Used the knuckleball as his primary pitch during his second stint with TEX during the 2005 season... Began throwing the knuckler with Triple-A Oklahoma in July... Worked on the pitch with Rangers Hall of Famer Charlie Hough during a road trip to Anaheim in September.

Saves/Opp: 0/0 Holds: 0 1st Batter/retired: 1/1 Inherited Runners/Scored: 1/1

- Made his Braves debut with 1.0 inning of relief, 6/29 at SD, allowing two hits and fanning one...Inherited one
 baserunner, which came around to score...Signed by the club as a minor-league free agent on 2/3.
- Tallied 14 appearances between Double-A Mississippi and Triple-A Gwinnett, posting a 1.93 ERA (3 ER/14.0 IP) with 22 strikeouts and one save...Logged 10 outings with the M-Braves before being transferred on 6/18.
- Prior to joining the Braves made 286 appearances in a five-year major league career, all with Colorado...Worked to a 16-11 record with a 3.42 ERA (92 ER/242.1 IP), 278 strikeouts and 20 saves.
- Made at least 70 appearances in three consecutive seasons from 2012–14, and his 221 total outings in that span tied for fourth most in the majors.

- Collected his first two holds of the season in back-to-back appearances on 6/23 and 6/24 vs. MIL...Went 1.2 innings over the stretch, striking out four.
- · Has gone more than 1.0 inning in six of his 19 relief appearances, including four outings of at least 2.0 innings.
- Lefties are 7-for-38 (.184) against him.
- The Braves selected his contract from Triple-A Gwinnett, 5/4...Went 3-1 with one save and a 0.87 ERA (1 ER/10.1 IP) in nine games out of the bullpen for GWN...Went unscored upon over his final eight appearances.

Saves/Opp: 0/0 Holds: 1 1st Batter/retired: 18/11 Inherited Runners/Scored: 15/6

- Tossed a career-most 4.0 innings on 6/25 vs. MIL, allowing two hits and striking out a career-high four batters...It was
 the longest scoreless outing by a Braves reliever since Freddy Garcia tossed 4.2 scoreless frames on 9/1/13 vs. MIA.
- Has been scored upon in only two of his last 15 outings (20.1 IP).
- Lefties are hitting .179 (7-for-39) against him.
- Earned his first Major League win after retiring the only batter he faced on one pitch, 5/23 vs. PIT.
- The Braves recalled him for the second time this season from Triple-A Gwinnett, 5/20, to replace LHP Eric O'Flaherty...Also up from 4/14-4/19.
- Worked in both the rotation and out of the bullpen for the G-Braves...Went 0-3 with a 7.36 ERA (15 ER/18.1 IP) in four starts...Moved to the bullpen on 5/12 and collected one save and a 2.08 ERA (1 ER/4.1 IP) in three games.

- Has a save in his last four appearances, including 6/27 at SD on his 34th birthday...Marked just the second time
 he pitched on his birthday and the first time he saved a game.
- His 10.9 K/9 mark is the best of his career...Eight of the last nine outs he has recorded have been via strikeout.
- Suffered his fifth blown save of the season, 6/21 vs. SF... Blew just three saves last season...The Braves are 2-3 in
 games in which he fails to convert a save this season.
- Batters leading off the inning against him are hitting .118 (4-for-34) with no walks and 12 strikeouts.
- Logged his sixth double-digit save season of his career with his 10th save on 5/26 at SF...Is one of eight active
 major leaguers with that many double-digit save seasons.
- Picked up his ninth save of the season with a hitless inning, 5/22 vs. PIT, and retired 28 of 32 batters (one single, one walk, one home run, one hit by pitch) faced over an 11-outing span from 4/28-5/22.
- Led the American League in saves in back-to-back seasons, collecting 51 saves in 2012 and 50 during the 2013 season...Became the second pitcher in MLB history to record back-to-back 50-save seasons, joining LAD's Eric Gagne (2002-03).

- Retired 18 consecutive batters from 5/30 at LAA to 6/13 vs. WSH...Ryan Zimmerman singled to snap the streak...Has allowed 11 hits over his last 4.1 innings (six games), while surrendering five runs total.
- Has stranded 10 of the 14 runners (71%) he has inherited this season.
- Lefties are hitting .277 (13-for-47) against him this season...Righties are 13-for-65 (.200).
