WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have won four of their last six games and five of eight as they continue a six-game, seven-day trip this afternoon with the finale in Oakland.
- RHP Mike Pelfrey, who is 3-2 with a 3.24 ERA (15 ER/41.2 IP) and 33 strikeouts over his last eight starts and 2-1 with a 2.08 ERA (4 ER/17.1 IP) over his last three on the road, is scheduled to start for the White Sox.
- The Sox have split the first two games of this series, posting a 7-2 win on Monday before losing, 7-6, yesterday.

 • Following today's game and a day off tomorrow, Chicago
- closes the first half with three games in Colorado (7/7-9).
- The Sox went 4-6 on their last homestand vs. Oakland (0-3). New York-AL (2-2) and Texas (2-1) from 6/23-7/2 and 3-3 on their last trip to Toronto (2-1) and Minnesota (1-2) from 6/16-22.

TODAY'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox have won eight of their last 10 games in Oakland after losing the previous seven.
- The Sox have won back-to-back series in Oakland for the first time since 2008-09 and are looking to win three in a row for the first time since 1996-97.
- José Abreu owns a .330 (34-103) average with 11 doubles, six home runs and 25 RBI in his last 24 games ... Abreu has eight homers and 21 RBI in 25 career games against the A's.
- Melky Cabrera is hitting .345 (57-165) with eight home runs and 32 RBI in his last 40 games
- Mike Pelfrey is 0-5 with a 7.56 ERA (21 ER/25.0 IP) in five career starts vs. Oakland.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- After Melky Cabrera tied the game with a RBI single off Santiago Casilla in the top of the ninth inning, Franklin Barreto hit a game-ending homer off Tommy Kahnle with one out in the bottom of the ninth to lift Oakland to a 7-6 win over the White Sox.
- Cabrera went 2-5 with a home run (No. 10) and three RBI, and José Abreu hit a three-run homer (No. 16) to pace Chicago's 13-hit attack.
- Avisaíl García returned to the lineup after missing five games with left knee soreness, singling in his first at-bat to end an 0-20 streak ... Adam Engel, Matt Davidson and Omar Narváez added two hits apiece.
- James Shields received a no decision, allowing six runs on six hits (three home runs) over 4.2 IP.

PITO POWER

- José Abreu is attempting to join Al Simmons (11), Albert Pujols (10), Ted Williams (8) and Joe DiMaggio (7) as the only players in major-league history to record 100-plus RBI in each of their first four seasons.
- Abreu is tied for fifth in the American League with 58 RBI, including a league-best 25 since 6/10 (see box at right), and is on pace to finish with a career-high 113

- INF Tyler Saladino is 2-5 with a walk through two games of his rehab assignment with Class AAA Charlotte \dots Saladino has been on the disabled list since 5/27 with back spasms.
- Leury García, who has been on the disabled list since 6/16 with a sprained finger on his left hand, is rehabbing in Arizona.

- Class AAA Charlotte RHP Reynaldo López allowed one run on five hits over 6.0 IP last night in a loss at Durham ... López, the No. 5 prospect in the White Sox system and No. 36 in baseball according to MLB.com, has given up two runs in 12.2 IP with 17 strikeouts over his last two starts.
- Jake Burger, the White Sox first-round pick (No. 11 overall) in the June draft, hit his first professional home run yesterday for the AZL White Sox, a solo shot vs. the AZL Dodgers.

AVI'S AN ALL-STAR

- OF Avisaíl García has been named to his first American League All-Star Team, selected via the player vote ... he is the first White Sox outfielder named to the All-Star Team since Carlos Quentin in 2011, and the first native of Venezuela since Magglio Ordonez in 2003.

WHITE SOX VS. OAKLAND

- Oakland leads the season series, 4-1 ... the A's swept a three-game series from 6/23-25 (18-5 margin), their first at Guaranteed Rate Field since 7/8-10/05.
- The White Sox are batting .253 (43-170) with a 5.08 ERA (25 ER/44.1 IP) against the A's and have been outscored, 27-18.
- Chicago has won three straight season series against the A's (first time since 1993-95) and eight of the last nine games at the
- The Sox are 287-306 all-time, going 149-146 at home (61-64 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 138-160 on the road.

SOUTH SIDE HITMEN

- The White Sox are hitting .280/.333/.454 with 61 home runs and 235 runs scored (5.0 R/G) in 47 games since 5/16 ... the .280 average ranks second in the majors behind Houston (.297).
- Over their last eight road games, the Sox are batting .315 (94-298) with 12 home runs, 50 runs scored (6.3) and a .882 OPS, collecting 12-plus hits five times.

- C Zack Collins and RHP Michael Kopech (U.S. Team) and INF Yoán Moncada (World Team) will represent the White Sox in the All-Star Futures Game on 7/9 in Miami.
- Moncada, the No. 1 prospect in baseball, was the Most Valuable Player of the 2016 All-Star Futures Game ... Kopech (No. 11) and Collins (No. 68) are ranked by MLB.com among the Top 100 prospects in baseball.

THE RUNS ARE UNEARNED

• The White Sox have allowed 43 unearned runs in 2017, the second-highest total in the American League behind Oakland (53) ... since 2013, the Sox lead MLB with 308 unearned runs.

WALK THIS WAY

 White Sox pitchers have issued 305 walks this season, the second-highest total in the American League behind Baltimore (315) ... the Sox are on pace for 595 walks, which would be their most in one season since 2000 (614).

SEARCHING FOR QUALITY

- Chicago's starting rotation owns a 5.27 ERA (122 ER/201.2 IP) over the last 41 games, making 10 quality starts.
- The White Sox rank last in the American League with 29 quality starts this season after finishing second in 2016 with 95.

NOT SO RIGHTY TIGHTY

- The White Sox have gone 13-10 vs. left-handed starters this season, compared to 24-36 in games started by right-handers.

 • The Sox are hitting a major-league best .292 (216-739) vs.
- lefties in 2017 and .251 (528-2,103) against right-handers.
- Avisaíl García (3rd, .423) and José Abreu (5th, .392) rank among the major-league leaders in average vs. left-handers.

POWERFUL PROSPECT PIPELINE

- The White Sox system is rated by MLB.com as No. 3 in MLB and by Baseball America as No. 5 ... the Sox seven Top 100 prospects according to MLB.com are tied for the most in baseball.
- Cuban OF Luis Robert (No. 25) became the Sox seventh Top 100 prospect according to MLB.com, joining Yoan Moncada (1), Michael Kopech (11), Lucas Giolito (30), Reynaldo López (38), Carson Fulmer (61) and Zack Collins (70).

ON DECK: COLORADO ROCKIES

- The White Sox conclude the first half this weekend with a three-game series at Colorado ... LHP Derek Holland (5-8, 4.52) is scheduled to start Friday's series opener ... Holland has never faced the Rockies in the regular season.
- The Sox lead the all-time series, 7-5, including a 6-3 record at Coors Field ... they are averaging 6.3 runs per game in Colorado, have twice scored 15 runs and hit six home runs on 4/8/14.
- The Rockies won two of three games in the last matchup on 4/7-9/14 at Coors Field

PELFREY AT A GLANCE

- The 33-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 14th start of the season, seventh on the road and second against Oakland.
- Is 3-2 with a 3.24 ERA (15 ER/41.2 IP) over his last nine appearances (eight starts), compared to 0-4 with a 5.70 ERA (15 ER/23.2 IP) over his first five ... won back-to-back starts (5/20-26) for the first time since 7/21-31/16 (also two) ... struck out a season-high seven batters on 5/26 vs. Detroit, his most since 9/25/15
- Has allowed 14 stolen bases (15 attempts) this season, the third-most in MLB ... allowed a season-high four stolen bases on 6/7 at Tampa Bay
- Had his contract purchased by the White Sox from Class AAA Charlotte on 4/22 ... signed a minor-league contract with the Sox on 4/8, after being released by Detroit on 4/3 ... went 0-2 with a 7.50 ERA (5 ER/6.0 IP) and four strikeouts over two starts with Charlotte before joining the White Sox.
- Went 4-10 with a 5.07 ERA (67 ER/119.0 IP) and 56 strikeouts in 24 appearances (22 starts) with the Tigers last season ... was on the disabled list from 8/1-9/5/16 with a lower back strain.
- Has gone 68-97 with a 4.55 ERA (718 ER/1,421.2 IP) and 800 strikeouts in 255 games (248 starts) over 12 career seasons with New York-NL, Minnesota, Detroit and Chicago-AL.
- Was originally selected by Tampa Bay in the 15th round of the 2002 First-Year Player Draft, but did not sign \dots was drafted by the Mets in the first round (ninth overall) in the 2005 draft.

LAST START

- Received a no a decision on 6/30 vs. Texas after allowing a season-high five runs on a season-high eight hits over 5.0 IP ... walked two and struck out two.
- Surrendered a pair of home runs to Joey Gallo (solo) in the third inning and Rougned Odor (two-run) in the fourth ... marks the second straight game he has allowed two home runs and third time this season
- Departed with the White Sox trailing, 5-3 ... tossed 101 pitches (60 strikes), topping 100 pitches for the $third\ time\ this\ season\dots the\ Sox\ scored\ three\ runs\ on\ four\ hits\ in\ the\ ninth,\ including\ a\ game-ending,\ two-run$ double by Melky Cabrera, to win, 8-7.

ROAD TROUBLES

- Owns a 29-52 record and a 5.09 ERA (365 ER/646.0 IP) in 120 road games (118 starts) lifetime.
- Is 2-3 with a 3.94 ERA (14 ER/32.0 IP) over six road starts this season ... has not won three road starts in a season since 2013 (also three).
- Earned his last road win on 6/17 at Toronto (1 ER/6.0 IP) ... has lost three of his last five road starts and is 3-16 with a 5.07 ERA (88 ER/156.1 IP) on the road since 5/14/15 (31 starts).

FAMILIAR ROUTINE

- Opponents are hitting .410 (16-39) with three doubles, one triple and four home runs when facing Pelfrey for the third time in a game.
- Has worked 5.0 or fewer IP in nine of his 13 starts ... owns a combined 2.31 ERA (10 ER/39.0 IP) over the first three innings compared to an 7.11 ERA (20 ER/25.1 IP) from the fourth to the six ... has only allowed four earned runs in the second and third innings combined (26.0 IP).

KEEPING IT ON THE GROUND

- Is tied for second in MLB with 63 double plays induced since 2015 ... has posted a 51.5 groundball percentage during that span ... has produced 10 double plays this season, including three on 6/12 vs. Baltimore.
- Has allowed 0.78 home runs per 9.0 IP (123 HR/1,421.2 IP) in his career, the sixth-lowest mark among MLB pitchers with at least 1,400.0 IP since 2006.

- Has gone 14-19 with a 4.43 ERA (119 ER/241.2 IP), 143 strikeouts and a .294 (280-951) opponents average in 44 career appearances (43 starts) in July ... his 14 wins are the most during any month of his career
- Went 2-2 with a 3.99 ERA (13 ER/29.1 IP) and .298 (34-114) opponents average in six starts with Detroit in 2016 ... recorded a pair of quality starts.

- Ranked second in the American League with 24 double plays induced.
- Missed a month of the season (8/1-9/5) with a strained lower back ... made two rehab starts with Class AAA Toledo.
- Snapped an 18-game winless streak on 6/4 vs. the White Sox (2 ER/6.0 IP), earning his first win since 8/12 vs. Texas (1 ER/7.0 IP).

- Is scheduled to make his sixth career start against the Oakland Athletics ... is 0-5 with a 7.56 ERA (21 ER/25.0 IP), 13 strikeouts and a .333 (36-108) opponents average lifetime.
- Has allowed five or more earned runs in three games. .. his career ERA vs. Oakland is the highest among the 29 teams he has faced, second-highest is 6.65 (16 ER/21.2 IP) vs. Minnesota.
- Oakland is one of two teams he is winless against ... is 0-2 vs. Tampa Bay.

- LHP Derek Holland (5-8, 4.52) is set to make his 17th start of 2017, 10th on the road and first vs. Colorado... is 1-5 with a 7.91 ERA (29 ER/33.0 IP) and 10 home runs allowed over his last seven starts.
- Made his first career start against his former team in his last start on 7/1 vs. Texas ... allowed five runs over 5.1 IP in a losing effort ... the Sox bullpen gave up five runs over 3.2 IP.
- Is scheduled to make his first career start against Colorado ... is 3-6 with a 4.26 ERA (86 ER/82.1 IP) in 14 interleague starts lifetime.
