## OAKLAND ATHLETICS (44-55) VS. TORONTO BLUE JAYS (45-54)

TUESDAY, JULY 25, 2017 — ROGERS CENTRE — 7:07 P.M. EDT RHP SONNY GRAY (6-4, 3.66) VS. RHP CÉSAR VALDEZ (0-0, 6.05) NBCSCA — A'S RADIO NETWORK (95.7 FM THE GAME)

**ABOUT THE A'S:** Have lost five of the last seven games after winning three straight to start post All-Star Break play...went 10-8 over the first 18 games this year, 17-30 over the next 47 games from April 23 to June 14 and are 17-17 since then...are 44-55 (.444) for the season, which is the second worst record in the American League...have been in sole possession of last place in the AL West every day dating back to May 30...trail first place Houston by a season-high tying 22 games (also July 22)...have spent one day tied for first this year, seven days in second, six days tied for second, 13 days in third, four days tied for third, 14 days in fourth, four days tied for fourth and 60 days in fifth.

**COUNTDOWN TO 1,000:** Bob Melvin recorded his 999th career win Sunday at New York (NL) and needs one more to become the 64th manager in Major League history with 1,000 wins...there are eight active managers with at least 1,000 wins (Bochy, 1827; Baker, 1825; Scioscia, 1539; Showalter, 1477; Francona, 1433; Hurdle, 1093; Yost, 1057; Maddon, 1032).

**DEFENSIVE DOINGS:** The A's have committed 26 errors in the last 44 games after making 58 in their first 55 contests...have 84 errors for the season, which is the most in the majors (MIL, 77)...have 56 unearned runs, which is the most in the majors (CWS and SD, 49) and 13 more than the A's season total from last year (43)...have allowed 77 stolen bases, which is second most in the majors (CHC, 79) and two more than the A's season total from last year (75)...have the second fewest outfield assists in the American League (12).

**OFFENSE:** The A's were held to two hits last night for the second time in the last seven games and the fourth time in the last 20 games...it was the fifth time this year Oakland has been held to two or fewer hits, which ties the Cubs for the most such games in the majors...are now hitting .211 (141-for-669) over the last 21 games and .236 for the season, which is second lowest in the American League...the only time in Oakland history the A's have hit under .238 is in 1982 (.236)...have struck out 10 or more times in a game 50 times this year, which is second most in Oakland history (59 in 2012)...have 937 strikeouts for the season, which is second most in the AL to Tampa Bay (960)...have the third lowest on-base percentage in the AL (.310) but rank third in extra base hits (321)...have the lowest batting average in the majors among leadoff hitters (.197), two hitters (.190) and outfielders (.223)...are hitting .230 with runners in scoring position, which is second lowest in the majors to Toronto (.219)...have the third lowest mark in the majors with the bases loaded (.205).

**PITCHING:** The A's have compiled a 3.29 ERA (32 er in 87.2 ip) since the All-Star Break after logging a 4.78 ERA before the break...have a 4.63 ERA overall, which is fourth highest in the American League...rank second in the AL in wild pitches (52) and hit batters (39).

**STARTING PITCHING:** A's starting pitchers are 6-7 with a 3.46 ERA (48 er in 124.2 ip) over the last 20 games but are 32-40 with a 4.52 ERA (277 er in 551.0 ip) for the season...have the second most losses in the American League but are tied for the fewest home runs allowed (72)...are one of four AL teams without a complete game...have not tossed a complete game since Aug. 19 of last year and their streak of 139 consecutive games without a complete game is the third longest active streak in the majors (TB, 228 and ATL, 190)...it is also third longest in Athletics history (151 from 7/9/08-7/5/09, 148 from 8/8/15-7/22/16).

HOME AND AWAY: The A's are 1-3 on this seven-game road trip to New York-NL (1-2) and Toronto (0-1)...went 2-2 on the last road trip to Seattle and are 7-7 over the last 14 road games after going 6-23 over the previous 29...are 16-32 (.333) on the road compared to 28-23 (.549) at home... have the second worst road record in the majors (PHI, 16-36)...return home following the game Thursday for a five-game homestand against Minnesota (three games) and San Francisco (two games)...went 4-2 on the last homestand against Cleveland (3-0) and Tampa Bay (1-2)...are 9-5-2 in home series compared to 2-12-1 in road series.

NIGHT AND DAY: The A's have compiled a 20-20 (.500) record during day games compared to 24-35 (.407) at night...are batting .264 (361-for-1369) and are averaging 4.90 runs per game during the day (196 runs), .217 (418-for-1927) and 3.90 runs per games at night (230 runs)...the night batting average is the lowest in the majors while the day batting average is sixth best...according to Stats, Inc., the last time a team hit under .223 in night games was in 1972 (Rangers, .213; Mets, .221).

**SCORING MARGIN:** The A's have a run differential of -78, which is second worst in the American League to Toronto (-88)...each of the A's four games on the road trip and seven of their last nine have been decided by two runs or fewer...are 32-28 (.533) in games decided by three runs or fewer compared to 12-27 (.308) in games decided by four runs or more... the mark in games decided by four runs or more is the worst in the majors (SD, 13-28/.317).

A'S IN JULY: The A's are 9-10 in the month of July...went 12-16 in June, which marked the A's eighth consecutive month with a losing record...that ties the Oakland record for consecutive months with a losing record (also Aug. 1978-Sept. 1979)...have not posted a winning record in a month since going 13-12 in April of 2016...have a 3.77 ERA (71 er in 169.2 ip) this month after the ERA increased each of the first three months of the season (4.14 in April, 4.70 in May, 5.57 in June)...have issued 47 walks, which is second fewest in the American League (LAA, 44)...are batting .220 (134-for-608), which is the lowest in the majors...are tied for second in the AL in walks (78) and rank third in stolen bases (15)...the steals are the A's most in one month since April of 2016 when they also had 15.

THIS AND THAT: Home runs have accounted for 208 of the A's 426 runs this year (48.8%)...the Oakland record for highest percentage of runs scoring on home runs is 46.3% in 1996...the A's have used 84 different lineups over the first 88 games but have repeated a lineup three times in the last 11 games...are 9-12 in replay challenges while opposing managers are 18-11...are averaging 3 hours, 7 minutes and 46 seconds per game...the Oakland record for longest average time of game is 3:08:28 in 2000...have faced a left-handed starting pitcher 23 times, which is third fewest in the American League (BOS and TEX, 22).

THE DISABLED LIST: The A's currently have eight players on the disabled list (Bassitt, Cotton, Dull, Graveman, Pinder, Smolinski, Triggs, Wahl), but six of those players are currently on rehab assignments (all but Smolinski and Triggs)...have had at least seven players on the DL every day dating back to May 24 and at least five players on the DL all year...have had at least three players on the DL every day since July 30, 2011 and have not had fewer than two players on the DL since the end of the 2006 season when they had just one...Oakland has used the disabled list a total of 20 times this year, which marks the third consecutive season and seventh time in the last 11 years the A's have used the DL at least 20 times...the Oakland record is 27 set last year...currently have three players on the 60-day DL (Bassitt, Smolinski and Triggs).

A's vs. BLUE JAYS: The season series is even at two games each... the A's lost the first game in Toronto last night after winning two of three in Oakland, June 5-7...have now lost nine of the last 10 games at Rogers Centre but have won nine of the last 13 games in the Coliseum...have lost the season series just once over the previous six seasons (1-5 in 2015) but are 24-25 against the Blue Jays over that span...are 217-192 all-time, including 109-97 in Oakland, 108-93 in Toronto and 0-2 in Las Vegas...are 67-61 (.523) in Rogers Centre, which is the second best record by a visiting American League team at this ballpark (Boston, 127-101, .557).

#### TODAY'S TIDBITS

Matt Chapman is the first A's rookie to homer in three straight games since Josh Donaldson (Aug. 29-31, 2012)...the Oakland record for consecutive games with a home run by a rookie is four by Dan Johnson (Aug. 3-6, 2005)...Khris Davis ranks third in the American League with 28 home runs...leads the majors in home runs off right-handed pitchers (26) and is tied for the lead in go-ahead home runs (14) and home runs on the first pitch (9)...Rajai Davis leads the AL with nine stolen bases in the month of July...has 135 career steals as an Athletic, which ties Jose Canseco for seventh place on the Oakland career stolen base list.

#### THIS DATE IN A'S HISTORY

In 1930 the A's have two triple steals in the same game...Al Simmons, Bing Miller and Dib Williams turn the trick in the first inning and Mickey Cochrane, Simmons and Jimmie Foxx steal together in the fourth inning...in 1936 Frankie Hayes ties a major league record with four doubles in a game against Cleveland...in 1996 Mark McGwire hits a 488 foot home run into the fifth deck at SkyDome...at the time it was the longest home run in the majors since all home runs have been measured starting in 1992.

## TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Sonny Gray (6-4, 3.66 ERA)

LAST FIVE STARTS: Is 4-1 with a 1.62 ERA (6 er in 33.1 ip) and .155 (18-for-116) opponents batting average over his last five starts...went 2-1 with a 3.34 ERA and .216 opponents batting average over his first five starts this year and was 0-2 with a 6.43 ERA and .319 opponents batting average in five starts in between from May 30 to June 20.

QUALIFICATIONS: Spent the first month of the season on the disabled list with a strained right shoulder and, with 91.0 innings pitched, is eight innings short of qualifying for the league leaders...based on a minimum of 90 innings

pitched, he ranks seventh in the American League in opponents slugging percentage (.362), eighth in on-base percentage (.289) and 10th in batting average (.230).

IN JULY: Is 3-0 with a 1.96 ERA (4 er in 18.1 ip) and .179 (12-for-67) opponents batting average in three starts in July...has won three games in a month for the first time since April of 2016...has won more than three games in a month twice in his career: 5-0 in July, 2014 and 4-1 in April, 2014...is now 12-5 with a 3.24 ERA (46 er in 127.2 ip) in 21 career appearances in July...the wins are his most for any month of the season.

BEFORE AND AFTER THE BREAK: Is 2-0 with a 1.46 ERA (2 er in 12.1 ip) in two starts since the All-Star Break after going 4-4 with a 4.00 ERA in 13 starts before the break...last year, he had just two wins total after the break...his career numbers are 27-18 with a 3.29 ERA in 67 games before the break compared to 17-17 with a 3.68 ERA (114 er in 278.1 ip) in 46 games after the break.

THE SECOND INNING: Has not allowed a run in the second inning and opponents are 5-for-46 (.109)...his 15.0 innings pitched in the second inning are second most in the majors among pitchers with no runs allowed in the second inning (Nova, PIT 20.0).

THE BIG INNING: Has allowed 34 of his 44 runs in the single biggest inning of his 15 starts (30 er in 15.0 ip, 18.00 ERA)...has a 0.83 ERA (7 er in 76.0 ip) in all other innings...last year, he allowed 58 of his 80 runs in the single biggest inning of his 22 starts (25.13 ERA)...had a 1.84 ERA in all other innings.

HOME AND AWAY: Is 5-2 with a 3.08 ERA (21 er in 61.1 ip), .208 (47-for-226) opponents batting average and three home runs allowed in 10 starts at home compared to 1-2 with a 4.85 ERA (16 er in 29.2 ip), .274 (32-for-117) opponents average and five home runs allowed in five starts on the road...ranks eighth in the American League in home ERA.

NIGHT AND DAY: Is 4-0 with a 2.45 ERA (12 er in 44.0 ip) in seven starts during the day compared to 2-4 with a 4.79 ERA (25 er in 47.0 ip) in eight starts at night...has allowed six of his eight home runs at night...ranks fourth in the American League in day ERA...his career numbers are 20-10 with a 2.98 ERA (84 er in 253.1 ip) in 41 starts during the day, 24-25 with a 3.72 ERA (184 er in 445.2 ip) in 72 games at night.

**OPPONENTS BATTING:** Six of the eight home runs he has allowed have been solo shots...three have been hit by the number one hitter in the order...has yielded a .138 (26-for-188) batting average with two strikes...has held the clean-up hitter to a .186 (8-for-43) batting average, no home runs and two RBI.

THIS AND THAT: Ranks sixth among American League pitchers in putouts (11)...has 85 career putouts, which already ranks 10th in Oakland history among pitchers (9th in Matt Keough with 90)...has allowed seven unearned runs, which is tied for seventh in the AL...has walked two batters or fewer in 12 of his 15 starts.

2017 HIGHLIGHTS: Began the season on the 10-day disabled list with a strained right shoulder...it was his third career stint on the DL (had two last year)...started a rehab assignment with Single-A Stockton on April 22 and was the winning pitcher in the Ports 7-0 win over San Jose that day (5.0 ip, 1 h, 6 so, 47 pitches)...also made one start with Triple-A Nashville April 27 against New Orleans and earned the win in a 9-2 decision (6.0 ip, 2 h, 7 so, 77 pitches)...did not allow a run or walk a batter in his two starts (11.0 ip, 3 h, 13 so) before he was reinstated May 1...went 2-1 with a 3.34 ERA and .216 opponents batting average over his first five starts.. allowed a career-high tying three home runs in his first start, a 9-1 loss at Minnesota May 2...made his 100th career appearance in his next start on May 7 against Detroit in Oakland and had a no decision in the A's 8-6 win... left his start on May 13 at Texas with a 4-2 lead but the bullpen allowed four runs in the seventh inning for the blown save and loss...was the winning

GRAY'S CAREER HIGHS

pitcher in his 100th career start, an 8-3 win over Boston in Oakland on May 18...became the 22nd pitcher in Oakland history to make 100 starts... struck out 11 batters in his next start on May 24 to defeat Miami...it was his third career game of 10 or more strikeouts...then went 0-2 with a 6.43 ERA and .319 opponents batting average over his next five starts from May 30 to June 20...allowed a career-high tying seven runs in 4.2 innings in a 9-4 loss at Cleveland May 30...struck out 10 batters in a no decision inning at Tampa Bay in the first game of the June 10 doubleheader...it was his second game of 10 or more strikeouts this year and the fourth of his career... allowed four hits or fewer while tossing six innings or more in four consecutive starts from June 25 to July 14, which matched the second longest such streak in Oakland history...it was the longest since Dallas Braden also had a four-game streak (Aug. 11-28, 2010)...opponents hit .122 (11for-90) during the streak...allowed just one run on two hits and a walk in 8.0 innings in a 3-1 loss to Atlanta June 30...is just the second pitcher in Oakland history to toss eight or more innings, allow three baserunners or fewer and take the loss (Mulder, July 4, 2003 vs. Anaheim)

LAST START: He won his third consecutive start in the A's 7-2 win over Tampa Bay last Wednesday in Oakland...it was his sixth win of the season, which is one more than his season total from last year...allowed two runs in 6.1 innings of work, all in the fourth inning...Ramos had a RBI single and Morrison scored on a Miller fielders choice...the A's then scored four times in the fifth inning for the win.

## TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER

RHP Paul Blackburn (1-1, 2.88 ERA): Was recalled from Triple-A Nashville July 1 and is scheduled to make his fifth start of the season and his career...allowed four runs in his last start after allowing just five runs (four earned) over his first three starts (1.83 ERA)...opponents are 1-for-16 (.063) with runners in scoring position, including 0-for-7 with RISP and two outs...was the losing pitcher in his last start, a 7-5 A's loss at New York (NL) last Friday (5.1 ip, 6 h, 4 r, 4 er, 1 bb, 1 so)...has never faced the Blue Jays in his career...was 5-6 with a 3.05 ERA in 15 games, including 14 starts, with Triple-A Nashville...ranked second in the Pacific Coast League in ERA and fourth in opponents batting average (.231) at the time of his July 1 promotion to Oakland...went 4-2 with a 1.84 ERA (9 er in 44.0 ip) over his last eight starts after going 1-4 with a 4.54 ERA over his first seven games (six starts).

## HLETICS BULLPEN BRIEFS

12-15, 4.80 ERA (171 er in 320.2 ip) Saves/Opportunities: 20-for-35 (57.1%)

- The A's bullpen has not allowed a run in six of the last 12 games (9 er in 32.0 ip, 2.53 ERA) after allowing at least one run in each of the previous 12 contests...that tied the Oakland record for consecutive team games with a run allowed by a reliever.
- The pen now has a 4.80 ERA for the season, which is second highest in the American League (DET, 5.04).
- Has the fewest inherited runners in the AL (117), is tied for first in most stolen bases allowed (36), tied for third in fewest wins (12) and fourth in fewest walks (114).
