OAKLAND NOTES

- **Daniel Gossett** (3.2 ip, 9 h, 5 r, 4 er) turned in his shortest start since his major league debut on 6/14/2017 at Miami... tonight, Gossett lasted only 3.2 innings and allowed five runs, four of which came in the top of the 4th inning.
- With his two-run double in the 4th inning, Ryan Lavarnway (1 for 3, 2b, 2 rbi) recorded his first hit and his first runs batted in as an Athletic.
- Prior to tonight, Lavarnway's most recent hit was 10/4/2015 vs. STL, and his most recent RBI came on 8/23/15 at Chicago-NL, both while he was a member of the Atlanta Braves.
- Marcus Semien (2 for 4, r, 2b) has reached base in each of his last ten games and is hitting .395 over that span (since 7/18/2017 vs. Tampa Bay).
- Ryon Healy (1 for 4) snapped an 0-for-18 streak with his single in the 5th inning.
- Athletics pitchers allowed seven walks, the most allowed by the team since 7/3/2017 vs. Chicago-AL...was the fifth time that Oakland pitchers have allowed seven or more bases on balls in a game this season.
- Chad Pinder went 1 for 3 in his rehab start with the Nashville Sounds today.

- Jaime Garcia (6.2 ip, 3 r, 7 so) made his first start with the Twins since being acquired from the Braves on 7/4/2017.
- Tonight's win was Garcia's first career start at Oakland.
- Zack Granite (2 for 5) extended his hiting streak to eight games, the longest of his major league career. He has also reached base in his past ten games.
- Brian Dozier (1 for 5, rbi) recorded the first 4-strikeout game of his career (793 games).
- **Joe Mauer** (0 for 3, 2 bb) reached base for the 12th consecutive game.
- Ehire Adrianza (2 for 3, r) set a new career high with his 24th hit of the season.
- Every single Twin in the batting order reached base at least once.
