### OAKLAND NOTES

- Chris Smith (6 ip, 7 h, 5 er, bb, 3 so, 4 hr) gave up four home runs in six innings, the most by an Athletics starter in 2017... the four long balls are also the highest total allowed by Smith in his career.
- Athletics starters have now allowed at least four runs in each of the last four games and in 11 of the last 13 games.
- Matt Chapman (0 for 1) left the game in the third inning due to illness.
- **Jed Lowrie** (2 for 4, 2 2b, 2 rbi) hit his 34th and 35th double, his most in a season since 2013...Lowrie now leads the American League in doubles and is tied for the major league lead with Washington's Daniel Murphy.
- Ryan Dull (ip) posted his ninth straight scoreless outing, the longest streak of any current Athletics reliever.
- Athletics pitchers allowed seven or more runs for the 39th time this season, equaling their total from last year.

### HOME RUNS

Player Inning Count RBI Location Pitcher

- Wade Miley (7 ip, 3 h, r, 0 er, 3 bb, 7 so) turned in a strong outing, going seven innings while allowing only one unearned run...Miley threw 111 pitches, and has now thrown 110 or more pitches seven times this season.
- **Miley** has now walked at least three batters in 14 of his 24 starts...Miley's 69 bases on balls lead the major leagues.
- With his triple to begin the game, **Tim Beckham** (2 for 5, 2 r, 2b, 3b) extended his season-long hitting streak to ten games.
- Beckham is the sixth player in Orioles history to start their Baltimore career with a hitting streak of at least ten games... he was acquired from Tampa Bay on 7/31/2017.
- With Adam Jones' (2 for 4, 2b, hr) and Trey Mancini's (3 for 4, 2 hr, 2b) back-to-back home runs in the fourh inning, and Mancini and Mark Trumbo's (1 for 4, hr) consecutive shots in the sixth inning, the Orioles hit back-to-back home runs for the eighth and ninth time in 2017.
- Mancini recorded the fourth multi-home run game, the second three-hit game, and the first three extra-base hit game of his career.
- Trumbo also snapped an 0-for-24 skid with his homer in the sixth.
- With a double in the fourth inning, Welington Castillo (1 for 3, 2b, bb) also extended his hitting streak to ten games, the longest of his career.
