OAKLAND NOTES

- Matt Olson (1-4, r, hr, 2 rbi, so) notched his fifth homer of the season, first since being recalled on Tuesday, in the fourth inning.
- Paul Blackburn (ND, 5.2 ip, 10 h, 4 r, 4 er, 2 bb, 3 so) failed to reach six inning for only the second time in his career... he has tossed six or more innings in six of his eight career starts.
- Jed Lowrie (2-4, r, 2 2b, rbi, so) tallied a double in his third straight game...he notched his 7th multi double game of his season and 20th of his career...his five hits in the homestand have all been doubles...he entered the contest tied for the MLB lead in doubles with Daniel Murphy (35).
- **Simon Castro** (1.1 ip) tossed 1.1 innings of scoreless basesball...he has not allowed an earned run in eight of his last nine appearances (2 er in 13.1 ip).
- Chad Pinder (2-3, rbi, sf) added his 11th multi game, fourth in the month of August with a two-hit night.
- The Athletics recorded their 58th double digit strikeout game of the season. They are one shy from their all-time mark of 59, which they set in 2012.

- Right-hander **Ubaldo Jimenez** (ND, 5.1 ip, 6 h, 3 r, 3 er, 1 bb, 11 so) recorded a season-best 11 strikeouts...it was his largest output since 9/29/13 at Minnesota when he fanned a career-high 13.
- **Tim Beckham** (2-4, r) extended his hitting streak to 11 games with a single in the first...he is one of six players to begin their Orioles career with a hitting streak of 10 game or more, and the first since Eric Byrnes (11 games, 7/30-8/10/2005).
- Adam Jones (1-4, r, hr, rbi) clubbed his 22nd homer of the season in the second inning, the solo homer gave him 800 career RBI.
- Jonathan Schoop (2-4, 2b, 2 rbi) recorded two RBI in the contest to move into sole possesion of third place in Orioles history for RBI by a second baseman in a season (Leader: Roberto Alomar, 94).
