OAKLAND NOTES

- Khris Davis (2-4, r, hr, 2 rbi, bb) struck out in the first inning...he has struck out at least once in 22 consecutive games dating back to Aug. 11, which is an Athletics record for a non-pitcher.
- With a homer in the fourth inning, Davis has a combined 80 homers in the last two season.
- Matt Joyce (1-4, r, hr, 2 rbi, bb) clubbed his career-best 22nd homer of the season...with his 69 runs scored, he matched his season-high set in 2011.
- Matt Olson (1-5, r, hr, rbi, 2 so) clubbed his 15th homer in fifth inning, homering in three straight games for the third time this season.
- Olson clubbed his 38th combined homer of the season between Triple-A Nashville and Oakland...his previous high was 37 at High-A Stockton in 2014.
- Jed Lowrie (2-5, 2 r, 2b, bb) recorded his 42nd double of the season, he is now tied for fourth in Oakland history with Miguel Tejada for most doubles in a season.
- The A's dropped their eighth straight game, marking their first losing streak of eight or more games since May 22- June 1, 2012.

LOS ANGELES-AL NOTES

- **Mike Trout** (0-3, bb) walked in the third inning, drawing a walk in his 13th straight game...he matched the Angels all-time record of 13 straight games with a walk, which was set by Albie Pearson in 1961.
- **Brandon Phillips** (2-6, r, rbi) recorded his second multi-hit game since being acquired from the Braves...he has hit safely in four of his first five games with the Halos.
- C.J. Cron (3-4, 2 r, 3b, hr, 3 rbi) has 15 RBI in his last seven games...he has hit safely in nine straight games, batting .343 (12-for-35) during that span.
- Cron is batting .395 (17-for-43) with three homers and 10 RBI vs Oakland this season.
- **Garrett Richards** (3.1 ip, 4 h, 1 r, 1 er, 1 bb, 3 so) made his first start since April 5, and only his second appearance since May 1, 2016.
- Ben Revere (1-1, rbi) delivered go-ahead rbi single in the 10th...it was his fifth pinch hit of the season and his 19 of his career (19-for-81, .267)
- The Angels have won five straight games against the A's and have matched their win total from last season (12).
