OAKLAND NOTES

- Matt Olson (1-4, r, hr, 2 rbi, so) has homered in six of his last seven games...he has 13 homers in the month of September, which is the most in MLB history by a rookie and tied with Jason Giambi for most all-time in A's history.
- Olson is tied for second in MLB history with 24 homers in his first 68 games...he is tied with Cody Bellinger (LAD) and is one behind Jose Abreu (25, CWS).
- Marcus Semien (2-4, 2 r, 2b) extended his hitting streak to four games...he has doubled in three of his four last games and is 17 doubles shy of 100 in his career.
- **Kendall Graveman** (W, 7 ip, 6 h, 1 r, 1 er, 3 bb, 4 so, 1 hr) matched a season-high with seven innings of work...the righty recorded his 10th quality start of the season and improved to 3-0 with a 2.28 ERA (7 ER in 27.2) in four starts against Texas this season.
- Chris Hatcher (1 ip, 1 so) has not allowed a run in 10 straight appearances and a career-best 11 straight innings.
- Athletics won their fifth straight game, which matches their longest winning streak of the season (3x, last 9/5-9/10).
- With 12 wins, the A's matched their previous high for any month this season (12- May, June, July).

TEXAS NOTES

- Shin-Soo Choo (1-5, r, hr, rbi, 2 so) has homered in back-to-back games for the third time this season and is one homer shy from matching his career high (22, 2010 & 2015).
- Adrian Beltre (1-3, 2b, bb) recorded his 22nd double of the season to extend his hitting streak to five games...he is batting .421 (8-for-19) during the span.
- Nick Martinez (L, 6 ip, 5 h, 4 r, 3 er, 1 bb, 6 so) suffered the loss and dropped his second straight game at the Colise-um...he entered the contest 4-1 with a 1.77 ERA in seven games (5 starts) at the Coliseum.
- Rangers had their four game winning streak snapped and are 1-6 at the Coliseum this season...Texas has lost five straight games at the Coliseum.
