26 **3044 Adrian Beltre** 27 3023 Lou Brock 4-1, and have a 4-3 record on this 10-day, 9-game road trip to LAA (1-2), SEA (3-0), and OAK (0-1)...last night's loss snapped a 4-G win streak, most consecutive wins since 8/14-17 (also 4-0)...club had lost 5 straight prior to the win streak, which matched longest losing skid of the season (3rd time)... Texas has dropped 6 of 10, 8 of 13 and 9 of last 15 but has won 19 of 37, 22 of 40, and 25 of the last 47, longer span beginning 8/2...Rangers have gone 33-32 since the AS break, are 49-45 since 6/9 and 71-67 beg. 4/20.

WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers lost to the A's last night,

• At 76-77 (.497), the Rangers are T6th in A.L. in winning pct....reached the .500 mark with Thursday's win for 1st time since 9/12 (72-72)...the 76 victories are 2nd fewest through 153 games in last 9 years beg. 2009 to records of 61-92/61-93 in 2014...Texas was 75-78/75-79 in 2008...a year ago, the Rangers were 90-63/91-63 thru 153/154 G.

• Club has been season-high 3 G above .500 twice, last on 5/21 (24-21)...team was 7 G under .500 (13-20) on 5/8...10-G win streak 5/9-19 was 4th-longest in franchise history.

INTO THE WILD: After being 5.0 games back of MIN for the 2nd A.L. Wild Card slot for 4 consecutive days through Sunday, the Rangers currently sit 3.5 games behind the Twins... Texas is tied with LAA for 3rd place in the A.L. Wild Card standings behind NYY (+5.5 G) and MIN (0.0 GB)...club was just 2.5 GB of MIN after wins on Wed. and Thurs., which matched team's smallest WC deficit since a win on 9/11 vs. SEA (-2.0 GB).

IN THE STANDINGS: The Rangers are in a 2nd place tie with LAA in the A.L. West for a 2nd straight day, this after not holding 2nd place since 7/23 (also T2nd)...club was in 4th place for 6 straight days from 9/13-18 ahead of a sweep at SEA...club dropped to 18.0 GB last night, and have gained ground in the division just once beg. 9/12...Texas has lost 4.0 games in the standings in the last 10 days to drop to 18.0 games back...team was a season-high 19.0 GB on 7/31-8/1, largest at any point since end of the 2014 (31.0 GB)...days in each position (alone or tied): 1st-0 days, 2nd-40, 3rd-47, 4th-72. 5th-13.

• After winning the A.L. West Division championship in 2015 and 2016, the Rangers were officially eliminated from the 2017 division race on 9/15 in game #147...in 2014 Texas was eliminated on 8/30 through 135 games...prior to that, the club had not been eliminated so early in the season since 9/10/08 through 145 games.

ON THE ROAD: The Rangers are 37-42 (.468) away from home, 7th in the A.L. in road winning percentage...the 42 road losses are most in a season since 2014 (34-47), 2nd most in last 7 years since a 39-42 mark in 2010...Texas has won 4 of 5 and 8 of last 13 on road, and .586 (17-12) away winning pct. beg. 7/21 is 3rd-best among A.L. clubs in that span, 5th in MLB...Texas is 5-2-2 in last 9 road sets after securing a series win this week in Seattle.

VS. OAKLAND: This series begins a season-ending span in which TEX will play OAK for 7 of its final 10 contests...each of clubs' last 2 series have resulted in sweeps in favor of the home team, as OAK went 3-0 for Players Weekend here at the Coliseum, 8/25-27, and TEX was 3-0 from 5/12-14 in Arlington...Rangers have gone 6-7 vs. the A's in '17, including just 1-6 in Oakland...TEX has lost 6 of last 9 meetings overall, but has won 12 of 22 and 20 of last 36...season series has been decided by a 10-9 margin for 4 straight years... have dropped 6 straight at the Coliseum after winning 1st game of '17 here on 4/17...club is 6-10 at the Coliseum since the start of 2016...all-time, Rangers lead 359-348, but A's have 183-169 edge at the Coliseum.

HAN SOLO: The lone Texas run last night came on a solo HR by Shin-Soo Choo...it marks the 10th time this season for a solo HR to account for the club's only run in a game...the 10 instances are T3rd-most in MLB: 11-CLE/MIL, 10-TEX/SD/TOR...it was just the 3rd instance since the AS break by Texas, the others on 8/13 vs. HOU (Beltre HR) and 7/18 at BAL (also Choo).

CHOO AGAIN: Shin-Soo Choo has HR in 2 straight and owns 3 of the club's 6 HR on this road trip (others by Gallo, Odor, Beltre)...the HR surge has raised his season HR total to 21, one shy of matching his career high (22 in both 2010 w/ CLE and 2015 w/ TEX).

HR MARK CLIMBING: Despite ranking T9th in the A.L. with 24 HR in 20 G this month, Texas is still 2nd in MLB with 228 HR in 2017 (229-BAL)...the 228 HR are 6th-most in any season in franchise history and could reach as high as 3rd in club annals with 12 HR over the final 9 contests.

KEEP IT 100: Nomar Mazara has 96 RBI this season...the only Ranger to reach 100 RBI in the past 5 seasons (2013-17) is Adrian Beltre (104 in 2016), and just 4 Rangers have posted 100-RBI seasons since 2007: Beltre (3x), Josh Hamilton (3x), Michael Young (1x), Vladimir Guerrero (1x)...the club's best candidates to reach 100 runs are Elvis Andrus (98) and Shin-Soo Choo (94)...in 2016, Adrian Beltre had 104 RBI and lan Desmond posted 107 runs, this after Texas had not seen 100-RBI and/or 100-R players since 2012.

• Elvis Andrus' 98 R this season are already a career high, and he is seeking his 1st career 100-run campaign.

SOME QUALITY: Nick Martínez posted a quality start in last night's loss, the 4th straight QS by the rotation and 5th in the past 6 G...marks most consecutive QS by the TEX staff since a 5-game run spanning the AS break, 7/9-17...rotation's 75 QS rank 3rd in the A.L. this season (86-BOS, 81-CLE).

RISP-Y BUSINESS: Texas went 0-for-6 with RISP last night's loss, dropping to 6-26 this season in games when going hitless with RISP...club has lost 11 straight games without a hit w/ RISP since back-to-back wins 7/22-23 at TB.

13 YEARS AGO TODAY: On 9/23/04 vs. OAK, Texas saw one of its most exciting finishes of the early aughts, as the Rangers posted a 3-run 9th for a walk-off win to cap a 3-G sweep of division-leading Oakland...David Dellucci, in an 0-2 count with 2 on and 2 outs, hit a line double that just eluded a diving Jermaine Dye in RF as TEX pinned a loss on A's closer Octavio Dotel...Brian Jordan slid home with the game-winner on a double that snapped an 0-for-23 stretch for Dellucci...at that point, the Rangers trailed OAK by just 2.0 G in the West.

SHORTS: TEX clinched the 2016 A.L. West title one year ago tonight (9/23/16) here at the Coliseum...Adrian Beltre has reached safely multiple times in 5 straight, T2nd-longest span by a Ranger in '17 to his own 6-G streak from 7/1-7... team's current 6-G losing skid at the Coliseum is longest here since club-record 8-G drought in 2003-04...Drew Robinson posted his 2nd career multi-hit game last night (also 6/25 at NYY), the only Ranger with multiple hits last night.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#36 Miguel González, RHP (8-11, 4.75)

TONIGHT: The 33-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 4th start with Texas and 26th start overall tonight in the Rangers' penultimate road contest of the regular season...is 1-1, 10.45 (12 ER/10.1 IP) in 3 starts for the Rangers... opponents have slashed .317/.420/.683/1.103 (13-41) w/ 6 XBH (4 HR, 2B, 3B) in his starts w/ Texas, and season ERA has increased from 4.31 to 4.75...earned his 1st win as a Ranger on Sun. at LAA, a 4-2 Texas victory...was acquired in a trade with the White Sox in exchange for INF Ti'Quan Forbes in the final hours of August 31...was 7-10 with a 4.31 ERA (64 ER/133.2 IP) with Chicago, leading the White Sox staff in innings and matching Holland for the team lead in wins at the time of the trade...was on the disabled list, 6/18-7/14, with A/C joint inflammation in his right shoulder...was in his 2nd season with the White Sox and was a member of the club's season-opening rotation in 2017...signed with the White Sox as a free agent in April 2015 after he was released by the Orioles...debuted with the Orioles at age 28 in 2012 and was 39-33 with a 3.82 ERA (246 ER/580.1 IP) over 101 games/95 starts with the club...Texas has won 2 of González's 3 starts.

 $\underline{\textbf{BRING IT BACK:}}$ Was activated from the disabled list after the All-Star break and went 3-2 with a 3.11 ERA (19 ER/55.0 IP) over his final 9 starts with the White Sox...since the break, his 0.96 HR/9 rate ranks 8th in the A.L. (min. 12 GS), this after allowing 1.49 HR/9 in 13 starts prior to All-Star break...over the post-break period, González's 3.86 BB/9 rate ranks 5th-highest in the A.L. (min. 12 GS).

LAST START: Earned his 1st win as a Ranger on Sun. at LAA (5.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R-ER, 5 BB, 2 SO, 87 pitches/50 strikes), a 4-2 Texas victory...exited with a 3-1 lead after stranding the bases loading in the 5th inning...was staked to an early lead courtesy of a 2-run double by Adrian Beltre and a tape-measure solo homer by Joey Gallo in the 1st 2 innings...matched career high with 5 walks, done 10 other times, but earned his 1st career win in such a start...became the 6th pitcher in Rangers history to issue 5-or-more walks and earn a win when throwing fewer than 90 pitches, 1st since Rich Harden (5 BB, 87 pitches) on 4/28/10 vs. CWS.

ON THE ROAD: Will be making his 3rd road start with Texas, 16th overall...has gone 4-7 with a 5.27 ERA (48 ER/82.0 IP) in 15 road starts this season...road ERA is more than one run higher than his home figure (4.06)...has gone 3-1 with a 4.37 ERA (17 ER/35.0 IP) over 7 road starts since returning from the disabled list, with 7 of the 17 runs allowed coming in a start on 8/3 at Fenway Park.

VS. OAKLAND: Has gone 0-1, 4.82 (10 ER/18.2 IP) in 4 G/3 GS career vs. OAK, all as a member of the Orioles...will be facing A's for 1st time in over 2 calendar years, as he last worked on 8/15/15 vs. OAK (ND, 7.0 IP, 3 R-ER)...Mark Canha and Marcus Semien were the only current A's in the lineup that day...pitched in relief on 8/25/13 vs. OAK (1.0 SHO IP), one of 7 career relief appearances...has made 2 starts at the Coliseum, going 0-1, 5.91 (7 ER/10.2 IP) in those outings.

2017: His 5.63 SO/9 would be a career low (previous low was 6.28 in 2014) and his 3.38 BB/9 would be a career high (current high of 3.17 in 2015)...opponents swing and miss on 14.8% of pitches, a career low...has been supported with an average of 5.63 runs per start, nearly a run higher than his career average (4.67)...batters leading off an inning are hitting .301 (43-143) w/ 14 XBH (9 2B, 5 HR) and 6 BB/23 SO...opponents are batting .275 (41-149) with RISP... opponents by PA: .250 (48-192) in 1st PA; .269 (52-193) in 2nd PA; .325 (54-166) in 3rd PA; .190 (4-21) in 4th PA...Robinson Chirinos has caught 2 starts (1-1, 9.82) and Brett Nicholas caught his 1st start with Texas...failed to reach 4th inning in 1st 2 starts w/ Texas, joining Derek Holland (5/5-10/16) as only Rangers with back-to-back starts of 3.0-IP-or-less since 2012...allowed multiple HR in backto-back games 9/6-12, 1st time to do so since 2015 (8/9-15/15) w/ BAL...threw just 44 pitches on 9/12 vs. SEA, lowest total for TEX starter to exit in a non-injury situation in last 5 seasons (since '13) to only Chi Chi Gonzalez (38 pitches) on 7/2/16 at MIN.

DISABLED LIST: Was on the disabled list, 6/18-7/14, with A/C joint inflammation in his right shoulder...made a pair of rehab starts in the minors prior to re-joining the White Sox, starting for Triple-A Charlotte on 7/6 at Durham (4.2 IP, 3 R-ER) and Double-A Birmingham on 7/12 vs. Mobile (4.1 IP, 5 R).

WITH THE WHITE SOX: Was a member of the White Sox season-opening rotation and went 7-10 with a 4.31 ERA (64 ER/133.2 IP)...at the time of the trade, led the Sox staff in innings and was tied with Derek Holland for the team lead in wins...went 3-0 with a 2.00 ERA (6 ER/27.0 IP) over his 1st 4 starts... was 1-8 with a 6.79 ERA (39 ER/51.2 IP) in next 9 starts leading up to placement on the disabled list on June 18...made a pair of rehab starts in the minors prior to re-joining the White Sox, starting for Triple-A Charlotte on 7/6 at Durham (4.2 IP, 3 R-ER) and Double-A Birmingham on 7/12 vs. Mobile (4.1 IP, 5 R)...was 3-2 with a 3.11 ERA (19 ER/55.0 IP) in 9 starts after returning from the disabled list.

CAREER: Is in his 6th major league season...signed with the White Sox as a free in April 2015 after he was released by the Orioles and was 12-18 with a 4.02 ERA (120 ER/268.2 IP) in 46 games/45 starts for the Pale Hose...was a key member of Baltimore's rotation from 2012-15, contributing to one A.L. East title and two playoff appearances overall...debuted with the Orioles at age 28 in 2012 and was 39-33 with a 3.82 ERA (246 ER/580.1 IP) over 101 games/95 starts with the club...also started a pair of playoff games for the O's, going 0-1 with a 1.42 ERA (2 ER/12.2 IP)...was originally signed by the Los Angeles Angels as an undrafted free agent and spent time in the Boston Red Sox minor league system prior to his debut...missed the entire 2008 and 2009 seasons due to injury
