OAKLAND NOTES

- Marcus Semien (1-4, r, hr, rbi) hit his first career leadoff homer to extend his hitting streak to eight games...he homered in back-to-back games fro the first time this season.
- The lead off home run by Semien was the Athletics 127th at home this year, which breaks the Coliseum record of 126 set in 2000 (now have 128).
- Matt Chapman (1-4, 2 so) has turned 34 double plays in 78 games, which are the most double plays by a third baseman in ML history with fewer than 100 games.
- Daniel Mengden (L, 6 ip, 5 h, 4 r, 4 er, 3 bb, 3 so, hr) allowed his first run since September 9 vs Houston...had a 19.0 scoreless innings streak prior to allowing a two-run homer to Alonso.
- **Khris Davis** (1-4, r, hr, 2 rbi) matched his career-high with his 42nd homer of season in the bottom of the sixth inning.

SEATTLE NOTES

- Yonder Alonso (2-3, 2 r, hr, 2 rbi, bb) clubbed his 27th homer of the season and 17th homer at the Coliseum.
- With a double in the first inning, Ben Gamel (3-5, 2b, rbi, 2 so) has 43 extra-base hits (27 2B, 5 3B, 11 HR) this season.
- Seattle won their eighth straight game against the A's, setting a new club-best eight game winning streak against their divisional rival.
- James Paxton (ND, 5.1 ip, 6 h, 3 r, 3 er, 5 so, 2 hr) failed to complete to reach six inning of work for the third straight start...he is 0-3 with a 6.97 ERA (8 er in 10.1 ip) in the month of September.
- Danny Valencia (1-2, r, hr, 3 rbi, bb) clubbed the go-ahead homer in the seventh inning...his 16th homer of the season gave him 66 RBI on the year and is six shiy of his career high 72 (2011).
- Mariners challenged a safe call on the field in the bottom of the seventh inning...after further review, the call was overturned and Renato Nunez was called out.
