OAKLAND NOTES

- **Trevor Cahill** matched his season high in innings pitched, with seven (4/17 vs. Chicago-AL)...Cahill's 102 pitches were his most of the season, and his most since 5/13/17 at Chicago-AL, while with San Diego.
- The A's broke a streak of ten consecutive games with a home run, their longest such streak of the season.
- **Matt Olson** extended his hitting streak to six games, the longest of his major league career.
- Oakland has scored two or fewer runs in six straight home games...during their recent ten-game road trip, the A's only managed two runs or fewer on one occasion, a 5/13 loss at New York-AL.
- Marcus Semien has recorded three straight multi-hit games, and has 17 on the season.
- **Lou Trivino** has not allowed a run in each of his last nine outings.
- Oakland fell to 9-18 against AL West teams...the A's are 16-5 against the rest of the MLB.

SEATTLE NOTES

- Mike Leake allowed the fewest earned runs of his 2018 campaign (10 starts), with 1...Leake lasted into the seventh inning for the third time this season, all Mariners wins.
- With the win, the Mariners improved to nine games over .500...Seattle last reached nine games over .500 on 10/1/16.
- Mitch Haniger was replaced in the fifth inning by Andrew Romine, and is listed as day-to-day with an elbow injury...X-rays came back negative.
- Since the start of 2016, the Mariners are 30-10 when Mike Zunino hits a home run...this is a better record than when any of Robinson Canó, Kyle Seager, or Nelson Cruz homer in that time frame.
- James Pazos recorded his 17th consecutive game without a walk...entering the day, he trailed only Houston's Ken Giles and Kansas City's Kelvin Herrera in walk rate among major league relievers, at 1.5%...Pazos has not allowed a run in 15 of his last 16 appearances.
- Manager Scott Servais was ejected in the ninth inning, his second of the season (5/15 vs. Texas).
- Seattle is 4-0 in extra-inning games.
