OAKLAND NOTES

- **Daniel Gossett** was lifted after five innings, allowing three runs on three consecutive home runs in the third inning...Out of four starts this season, Gossett has failed to go further than the fifth inning in three of them.
- The four home runs by A's pitchers tie a season high, for most by the team in a game...the three given up by Gossett also tie a season high for most in a game by a pitcher.
- The Athletics have scored four runs or fewer in 13 consecutive home games, tying the second-longest streak in Oakland history.
- The A's last went 13 home games scoring four or fewer runs from 4/6/73 to 4/29/73...The longest streak in Oakland history is 14 games, from 4/17/68 to 5/11/68.
- **Emilio Pagán** set a new season high for strikeouts, with four in his two innings of work...He reached the mark five times in 2017, while with Seattle.

TAMPA BAY NOTES

- Blake Snell set a new career high in wins with seven, only 12 starts into the season...Snell is now in a seven-way tie for the AL leader in wins (Verlander, Kluber, Morton, Happ, Severino, Porcello)...It was the sixth start this season in which Snell has allowed one or fewer earned runs.
- C.J. Cron, Joey Wendle, and Wilson Ramos combined to hit back-to-back-to-back home runs off Daniel Gossett in the fourth...it was the fourth time in Rays history that they have hit three consecutive homers, the last coming 9/21/16 vs. New York AL (Evan Longoria, Brad Miller, Corey Dickerson).
- C.J. Cron hit his 12th home run of the season, a mark he did not reach until August 29 of last year.
- Jaime Schultz made his major league debut, pitching the seventh inning and striking out the side.
- The three errors committed by Tampa Bay are a season high.
- Sergio Romo recorded his first save since 10/1/16 vs. Los Angeles-NL, while with San Francisco.
- The Rays' four home runs tie a season high (4/28 at Boston).
