 Paul Blackburn set a new career high with five strike- outs, and pitched his first scoreless outing of the season as well as his longest start since 8/5/17 at Los Ange- les-AL. Jonathan Lucroy recorded his 13th caught stealing of the season, which leads the American League. After a second-inning RBI single, Marcus Semien is now hitting .400 and has 10 RBI with runners in scoring posi- tion and two outsSemien recorded his first game with multiple RBI since 5/20/18 at Toronto. Jonathan Lucroy is now 0 for his last 10. The Athletics are now 31-0 when leading after seven innings, and are the only team in the majors to be unde- feated when leading after seven. The A's have now won 11 of their last 13 games, their best 13-game stretch since winning 11 of 13 from 5/7/14 to 5/22/14. Blake Treinen has converted each of his last 18 save op- portunitiesTreinen now has more saves in 2018, (21) than in his first four major league seasons combined (20). 	 Trevor Bauer pitched through the sixth inning, allowing two runs on six hitsBauer's struck out eight, marking the seventh straight start with at least eight strikeouts. Bauer threw 108 pitches, and has tossed at least 100 pitches in each of his 17 starts this season. Jason Kipnis has now hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games. In the eighth inning, Oliver Pérez was inserted into the game to face Mark Canha, to whom he issued an intentional walk. Pérez was then removed without throwing a pitchin 564 previous major league games across 16 seasons, Pérez had never before made an appearance in which he did not throw a single pitch. Francisco Lindor recorded his 32nd multi-hit game, and is now tied for 2nd in the American League (Segura, 35). Rajai Davis made his first appearance at the Coliseum since being traded by the A's in August 2017.
