OAKLAND NOTES

- **Frankie Montas** struck out six, one off his career high, while giving up three runs in 5.2 innings.
- The Athletics' season-long six-game winning streak was snapped.
- **Mark Canha** extended his career-high hitting streak to ten games...Canha's streak is the longest by an Oakland player since Ryon Healy's 11-game streak from 8/12/17 to 8/23/17.
- **Khris Davis** doubled in his third consecutive game, the first time he has done so since 7/24/16-7/27/16.
- **Yusmeiro Petit** is now holding opponents to an average of .045 (1-for-22) with runners in scoring position and two outs.
- The 11 doubles allowed by the A's are an Oakland record, and the most allowed by the franchise since at least 1908... the 13 extra-base hits allowed are the most since 9/24/40 vs. Boston (14).
- With a seventh-inning single, **Jonathan Lucroy** snapped an 0-for-12 stretch.

CLEVELAND NOTES

- **Mike Clevinger** pitched his 11th quality start of the season, earning his seventh win.
- **Edwin Encarnación** has now hit at least 20 home runs for seven consecutive seasons... **Encarnación, Francisco Lindor, and José Ramírez** are the first trio of teammates with 20 or more home runs this season.
- With a single in the first inning, Encarnación snapped an 0 for 10 streak.
- Lindor recorded his 12th 3-hit game of the season, three behind the major league lead (Segura)...He reached base a total of five times, his most of the season.
- Cleveland is now 7-1 when facing a sweep in a series finale.
- The Indians hit 11 doubles, their most in a game since 7/13/96 at Chicago-AL (12)...The 11 doubles and 13 extra-base hits are both MLB season highs in 2018.
- Cleveland's 15 runs are their most since 6/27/17 vs. Texas (15), their 20 hits are their most since 5/14/14 at Toronto (22), and their 13 extra-base hits are their most since 4/18/09 at New York-AL.
