OAKLAND NOTES

- Chris Bassitt tied a season high with six strikeouts, but failed to get out of the fifth inning, allowing two runs on seven hits.
- With a sixth-inning solo homer, Mark Canha's extended his career-best hitting streak to 11 games...it is the best hitting streak by an Oakland player since Ryon Healy's 11-game streak from 8/12/17 to 8/23/17.
- Emilio Pagán has not allowed a run in 16 of his 17 appearances since being recalled from Triple-A on May 18, and has an ERA of 0.81 over that stretch.
- The Athletics are now 33-0 when leading after seven innings, and are the only team in the majors to be undefeated when leading after seven.
- The A's grounded into five double plays...the last time the A's grounded into five double plays and still won was 6/2/73 at Boston.

SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Clayton Richard** pitched at least six innings for the 11th consecutive start, but allowed five runs, his most since 5/2/18 at San Francisco.
- After Richard's 6-inning outing, he now sits at 1000.2 innings with San Diego. He is the ninth Padre to reach the 1000-inning plateau, and the second lefty after Randy Jones (1766 innings pitched).
- **Travis Jankowski** recorded his third 3-hit game of 2018, which ties a career high for 3-hit games in a season.
- Freddy Galvis is now 0 for his last 14.
- The Padres turned five double plays, their most since 8/26/16 at Miami (6)...this was the first time San Diego had turned five double plays and lost since 4/12/02 vs. Los Angeles-NL.
- The Padres have lost five consecutive games in which they collected nine or more hits.
