OAKLAND NOTES

- **Sean Manaea** retired his first 14 batters of the game... this season, opposing batters are hitting .172 against Manaea their first time through the order, and .257 their second time through the order.
- **Stephen Piscotty's** season-best 11-game hitting streak was snapped.
- With **Matt Olson's** home run, Oakland became the sixth team in the American League to have at least two players with 20 home runs or more (Boston, New York, Cleveland, Los Angeles, Seattle).
- Olson recorded his fourth career 2-homer game, and his second of the season...the other came on 6/1 at Kansas City.
- **Lou Trivino's** 15-inning scoreless streak was snapped.
- **Khris Davis** recorded his fourth multi-homer game this season, matching his total from 2017.
- **Jeurys Familia** made his A's debut with two scoreless inning, tying his longest outing of the season and earning his first win with the team.
- **Matt Chapman** recorded the first game-ending RBI of his career with an RBI single in the 10th.

SAN FRANCISCO NOTES

- **Johnny Cueto** gave up three home runs, his most in a start since 6/14/17 vs. Kansas City...Cueto pitched through the seventh for the third time in 2018.
- Today marked the fourth time that Cueto has allowed multiple home runs to a single batter in a game...The last time came on 9/13/15 at Baltimore (Jonathan Schoop).
- **Buster Posey** failed to extend his Coliseum hitting streak from eight to nine games.
- **Chase d'Arnaud** tied the longest hitting streak of his career, at five games.
- **Pablo Sandoval** is now 5 for his last 10 with runners in scoring position, and is batting .321 with RISP overall.
- **Andrew McCutchen** hit his 10th home run of the season...He has now hit at least 10 home runs in every year of his 10-year major league career.
- **Mark Melancon** surrendered his first home run since 6/18/17 at Colorado (Nolan Arenado).
