### OAKLAND NOTES

- The A's have the majors best record since the All-Star Break (10-4) and since June 16 (31-10) and have the fourth best record overall (65-46).
- The A's are a Major League best 20-9 in one-run games and lead the majors with 10 extra inning wins.
- In the no-run, seven-inning outing, **Brett Anderson** lowered his season ERA from 5.55 to 4.64.
- **Matt Chapman** extended his career-high on-base streak to 19 games with a single in the ninth...during the streak, he is 24-for-69 (.348).
- **Ramón Laureano** made his major league debut, starting the game in center field, going 1 for 5, and recording a walk-off RBI single for his first major-league hit.
- In six appearances with the Athletics, **Jeury Familia** has yet to allow an earned run.
- **Jed Lowrie** has hit safely in each of his five games against Detroit this season, and now has an 11-game hitting streak against the Tigers, dating back to 5/5/17...this is the longest hitting streak vs. Detroit by an A's player since an 11-game streak by Miguel Tejada from 8/24/01 to 4/22/03.
- The A's have now beaten the Tigers 10 straight times, which is the longest streak since the Philadelphia A's 10-game winning streak from 5/19/31 to 6/28/31.

### DETROIT NOTES

- **Blaine Hardy** did not allow a hit until a single to Jed Lowrie in the seventh inning, also the longest no-hit bid of his career.
- In the 11th start of his career, Hardy allowed no runs on only one hit, both career bests for games in which he has started, in 7 innings of work, which ties a career high.
- The 106 pitches thrown are also a career high...Hardy's previous career high, 95, also came against Oakland, on 6/26/18 in Detroit.
- Hardy's no-hit bid was the longest by a Tigers pitcher since **Matthew Boyd** pitched 8.2 no-hit innings on 9/17/17 vs. Chicago-AL.
- After Hardy's seven scoreless innings, Detroit starters have not allowed a run in 17 consecutive innings...this is the longest streak since 18 straight from 6/14/15 to 6/16/15.
- With a single in the seventh inning, **Nicholas Castellanos** snapped an 0-for-19 stretch.
