### OAKLAND NOTES

- The A's are now 11-4 since the All-Star break and 32-10 since June 16, both of which are the best marks in the majors over those stretches.
- The A's are 20 games over .500 for the first time since Sept. 2, 2014 (79-59) and are 66-46, which is the fourth best record in the majors.
- **Matt Chapman** extended his career-high on-base streak to 20 games with a triple in the first...during the streak, he is 26-for-72 (.361)...the 20-game streak is tied with Cleveland's José Ramírez for the longest active streak in the American League.
- **Ramón Laureano** recorded his second outfield assist in as many days...in two major-league games, he now has more assists than any other Athletics centerfielder in 2018.
- With his 30th home run of the season, **Khristian Davis** became the sixth player in Oakland history to hit 30+ homers in three straight seasons, and the first since Miguel Tejada (2000-02).
- Davis' nine home runs since the All-Star break are tied for the most in the major leagues (Carpenter, St. Louis).
- The A's beat the Tigers for the 11th straight time, tying a record set by the Philadelphia A's from 8/10/1902 to 9/4/1902.

### DETROIT NOTES

- **Jordan Zimmermann** lost his fourth decision in a row... he has not won a game since 7/6/18 vs. Texas, before which he was 4-0.
- In his fourth quality start of 2018, Zimmermann allowed two runs, both of which came on solo homers, in 6.1 innings...it was the fourth straight start in which he allowed at least two home runs, the longest such streak of his career.
- With three walks, Zimmermann tied a season high...he has only walked three or more batters in 34 of his 240 career starts (14.2%).
- Matt Chapman's third-inning homer snapped the 19-inning scoreless stretch by Detroit starters, which had been the longest since 21.1 scoreless innings from 4/6/15 to 4/9/15.
- With an error in the fourth inning, **JaCoby Jones** 104-game errorless streak, which stretched back to 9/11/17, was snapped.
- **José Iglesias** has now doubled in five of his last six games, the second time he has done so in his career (7/19/15 to 7/25/15).
