OAKLAND NOTES

- The A's have won each of their last 65 games when leading after seven innings, which matches the longest streak in Athletics history (July 21, 1927-June 23, 1928)
- The A's are 38-12 ailing back to June 16, which is the best record in the majors and their best record over a 50-game stretch since 2005.
- **Marcus Semien** led off the bottom of the first inning with a home run for the first time this season. It was the second time of his career 9/26/17 vs. Seattle also off James Paxton.
- **Matt Chapman** extended his career-long on base streak to 28 games, which is the longest active streak in the American League and the second-longest in the major leagues behind St. Louis' Matt Carpenter (32)
- Chapman extended his hit streak to a career high 12 games with a double in the bottom of the eighth inning...during this span he is 17-for-49 (.346) with 12 runs, seven doubles and three home runs.
- **Jed Lowrie** hit his 100th career home run and registered his 76th RBI which is a new career high...Lowrie has hit 3 home runs off of Felix Hernandez this season.
- **Jonathan Lucroy** has thrown out 20 attempted base stealers which is tied for the Major League lead (Jorge Alfaro PHI).

SEATTLE NOTES

- **James Paxton** left the game after his shortest start of the season, with a left forearm contusion.
- With a single in the top of the first inning **Mitch Haniger** collected his fourth hit of the series...Since being moved to the leadoff spot on August 9, he is batting 13 for 26 (.500).
- **Félix Hernández** made his first career relief appearance in 398 starts. Only Mike Mussina made more career starts (498) before his 1st relief appearance.
- Hernández worked 5.2 innings in his 1st career relief appearance, the longest outing by a Mariners reliever since Andrew Moore tossed 6.0 innings in relief on Sept. 11, 2017 at Texas.
- **Cameron Maybin** extended his hitting streak to nine games.
