OAKLAND NOTES

- **Matt Olson** hit a solo home run to win the game in the 10th inning, the second walk-off hit of his career.
- **Matt Chapman** extended his career-long on base streak to 30 games, which is the longest active streak in the American League...it is the second-longest in the major leagues behind St. Louis' Matt Carpenter (35).
- Chapman also extended his hit streak to a career-high 14 games with an RBI single in the bottom of the fifth inning...it is the longest active hitting streak in the MLB.
- **Khris Davis** is now 0 for his last 13.
- **Jonathan Lucroy** is 0 for his last 13...Lucroy tossed out his 21st attempted base stealer of the season (Tyler White), and pulled ahead of Philadelphia's Jorge Alfaro and Kansas City's Salvador Pérez for the major league lead.
- In 2.2 innings with the A's, **Shawn Kelley** has allowed no runs, no hits, and only one baserunner.
- Four out of **Jed Lowrie's** last five games have been multi-hit games, the first time he has done so since 4/15/18 to 4/20/18.
- In five appearances with the A's, **Fernando Rodney** has yet to allow a run.

HOUSTON NOTES

- **Charlie Morton** failed to last more than five innings for the second time this season while facing the Athletics... Morton struck out four, and has struck out at least four in 22 of his 24 starts this season.
- **George Springer** has hit safely in all six of his games at the Coliseum this season...in those games, he is batting .429 (12 for 28).
- **Alex Bregman** hit his sixth career home run against Oakland, his most against any team...it was also Bregman's fourth of the season facing the Athletics, tied for the most of any player this season (Joey Gallo, Texas).
- Bregman also extended his road on-base streak to 37 games, the longest active streak in the majors and the fourth-longest in Houston history.
- **Martin Maldonado** hit his first hme run with the Astros...it was his first overall in 27 games, since 6/29/18 at Baltimore while he was a member of the Angels.
