OAKLAND NOTES

- The Athletics are now tied for first in the AL West after trailing Houston by a season-high 12 games through June 18.
- The A's are 74-49 (.602), which is tied for the third best record in the majors and tied for fourth best in Oakland history after 123 games
- The A's hit eight doubles which ties the Oakland single game record
- Khris Davis doubled in the bottom of the first inning to snap an 0-for-13 skid...with the double Davis now has 7 go-ahead RBI this season.
- Trevor Cahill posted his eighth quality start of the season...he struck out 7+ for the fourth time this season and retired 20 out of the 22 batters he faced...the Athletics have won each of Cahill's last seven starts.
- Matt Olson recorded two doubles to bring his season total to 26 and extended his hitting streak to 6 games.
- Matt Chapman's career long hitting streak ends at 14 games and his career high on base streak ends at 30 games.

- The Astros recorded just two hits, their third game of two or fewer hits this year.
