OAKLAND NOTES

- **Sean Manaea** gave up a season-high-tying six runs, his-most in 15 starts, since 5/25/18 vs. Arizona...the nine hits also tie a season high (7/27 at Colorado).
- With a single in the sixth inning, **Matt Olson** extended his hitting streak to seven games, which ties a career high.
- **Khris Davis** recorded his 21st career multi-homer game, and his 6th of 2018...he also recorded his 8th three-hit game of the season, a career high
- **Shawn Kelley** allowed his first hit with Oakland, a single to Tyler White.
- **Mark Canha** is now 0 for his last 11 and is batting .125 (5 for 40) in August.
- **Jonathan Lucroy** snapped an 0 for 15 skid with a single in the seventh inning.
- The five home runs allowed by A's pitchers tie a season high (6/5/18 at Texas).

HOUSTON NOTES

- **Martín Maldonado** became the first catcher in Astros history to record a double, triple, and a home run in a single game, as well as the first No. 9 hitter in Houston history to accomplish this feat...his three extra-base hits tie a career high (three times, last on 6/21/17 at New York-AL).
- **Justin Verlander** earned the 200th victory of his career, making him the 114th pitcher in MLB history, and the third active pitcher, to reach the plateau.
- **Alex Bregman** extended his road on-base streak to 39 games, the longest active streak in the majors and the fourth-longest in Houston history...his five homers against Oakland in 2018 are the most of any player facing the A's this season.
- **Tyler White** extended his career-long hitting streak to eight games with a single in the sixth inning.
- **Evan Gattis** hit his ninth home run at the Coliseum, his most at any visiting ballpark.
- The Astros tied a season high with five home runs...it is the second time in a week they have reached the mark (8/15 vs. Colorado).
