OAKLAND NOTES

- Brett Anderson walked only one batter, the seventh straight start in which he has walked one or fewer...he did not allow a run in 7+ innings for the third straight home start.
- The six strikeouts by Anderson tie a season high...The one hit allowed by him is a career-low for a start of at least four innings (140 career starts).
- A's starting pitchers have tossed seven innings or more and allowed one hit or fewer in back-to-back games for the first time in Oakland history...they have done it three times in the last four games.
- Oakland won their 76th game of the season, which tops their final win total from 2017...it is the most wins the Athletics have had in a season since 2014 (88), and it is the earliest the A's have bested their previous year's win total since 1980, when they topped their 1979 win total on August 5.
- Khris Davis drove in three runs, giving him 102 RBI on the season...he has now driven in at least 100 runs in each of his three seasons with the A's...he is the first Athletic to knock in at least 100 in three straight seasons since Eric Chávez and Miguel Tejada both did it from 2001-03.
- Matt Olson is now 0 for his last 10, and Chad Pinder is now 0 for his last 12.

TEXAS NOTES

- Ariel Jurado gave up a career-high 10 hits en route to his third loss.
- Texas has lost six straight to the A's, their longest losing streak since dropping seven straight to Oakland from 8/25/17 to 9/28/17.
- Nomar Mazara's failed to extend his hitting streak to nine games...it had been his best hitting streak since a career-best 11-game streak from 5/9/17 to 5/23/17.
- Matt Moore gave up a home run to Khris Davis after three scoreless outings, which was his longest such streak since three scoreless outings from 9/29/12 to 4/10/13.
- Texas was shut out for the second game in a row for the first time since 8/13/16-8/14/16, both coming against Detroit.
