OAKLAND NOTES

- Khris Davis hit his 40th home run, retaking sole possession of the major league lead...he is the first player in Oakland history to hit 40 home runs in three straight seasons, and the first Athletics player since Jimmie Foxx (1932-34)...Davis is the first major leaguer to hit 40 in three consecutive seasons since 2006-09 (Ryan Howard, Philadelphia).
- The A's used a total of nine pitchers, which sets an Athletics record for a nine-inning game...the 24 players used set an Oakland record for players used in a nine-inning game (previous: 22, 9/28/03 at Seattle).
- Ramón Laureano extended his career-long hitting streak to six games with a single in the eight inning.
- Catcher Beau Taylor made his major league debut as a defensive replacement in the ninth inning.
- Mark Canha hit his 15th home run, one shy of his career high...it was his first since 7/30/18 vs. Toronto, ending a 19-game homerless streak.
- Cory Gearrin made his Athletics debut, pitching one inning and allowing two runs...he is the 32nd pitcher the A's have used this season, an Oakland record.
- **Jed Lowrie** recorded his third error of the season, and his first since 7/8/18 at Cleveland...his errorless streak had stood at 43 games.

SEATTLE NOTES

- James Paxton made his first start since being placed on the disabled list on August 15...Paxton struck out 10, his eighth game of ten or more strikeouts in 2018...he is now tied for sixth in the American League in strikeouts.
- Mitch Haniger extended his hitting streak to 13 games, tying a career high (4/6/17 to 4/19/17)...it is now the longest hitting streak by a Seattle player this season.
- Jean Segura recorded his 19th 3-hit game of the season, the most in the major leagues.
- Edwin Díaz recorded his 51st save, tied for the ninthmost all-time in a single season...it is the most since current Athletic Jeurys Familia also notched 51 in 2016 while with New York-NL.
- The Mariners improved to 60-0 when Díaz enters with a lead...with four strikeouts, and 112 on the season, he set the Seattle record for strikeouts in a season by a reliever...Bill Caudill had held the record with 111 in 1982.
- **Nelson Cruz** recorded the 997th RBI of his career, and now sits only 3 away from being the 12th active major league player to reach the 1,000-RBI mark.
