OAKLAND NOTES

- **Stephen Piscotty** hit his 22nd home run of the season, which ties his career high, set in 2016 with St. Louis.
- In Piscotty's last 16 games, he is batting .361 (22 for 61) with four doubles, seven home runs, and 16 RBI.
- Despite the loss, Oakland is 49-21 since June 16, the best record in the majors over that span...At 83-57, the Athletics have the fourth-best record in the majors...The A's are 98-64 over their last 162 games.
- **Ryan Buchter's** streak of 12 scoreless outings was snapped.
- **Daniel Mengden** pitched 4.1 scoreless innings in relief, while allowing just one hit and striking out four...it was his longest career relief appearance, as well as his career low for hits allowed.
- The A's recorded two errors, just the second time since the start of August they have recorded more than one error (31 games).
- The two hits by the A's were their fewest since 5/30/18 vs. Tampa Bay (84 games).
- **Dean Kiekhefer** made his Athletics debut...he had not pitched in the majors since 10/2/16, while with the Cardinals.

NEW YORK NOTES

- **Miguel Andújar's** career-long 17-game on-base streak was snapped.
- **J.A. Happ** logged his seventh straight start without a loss, and is yet to lose a decision since joining the Yankees on July 27 (5-0)...In his 13th quality start of the season, Happ went six innings, allowing only one run on two hits.
- **Giancarlo Stanton** snapped an 0 for 14 stretch with a single in the seventh inning.
- The Yankees broke a combined Oakland no-hitter with two outs in the sixth inning...it marked the sixth time in 2018 that the Yankees had been no-hit through five innings.
- **Luke Voit** hit his seventh homer as a Yankee (eighth overall), all seven coming in his last 12 games...he has homered in three straight games.
- **David Robertson** struck out three in one inning pitched, upping his career K/9 ratio to 12.00 (863 K in 647.1 ip), the highest of all time (min. 600 ip).
