#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- Oakland fell to 90-61 with the loss today, which is the fourth best record in the majors... Despite the loss, the Athletics have the best record in the major leagues since since June 16 (56-25).
- With Tampa Bay winning, the A's still have a magic number of seven to clinch a playoff spot...with Houston winning, have a tragic number of seven to be eliminated from the AL West race.
- Liam Hendriks turned in his fifth straight scoreless appearance as an "opener"...lowered his ERA as a starter to 2.70 (six starts).
- **Jed Lowrie** set a career high with his 74th walk of the season...the three walks in a game also tie a career best (nine times, last on 8/28/18 at Houston).
- Shawn Kelley's 14-game scoreless streak to start his Oakland career was snapped...it had been the second longest scoreless streak of his career, after a streak of 24 scoreless outings from 9/22/15 to 5/20/16...Kelley's ERA with the A's is now 1.38.
- With the loss, Oakland fell to 6-8 against Los Angeles-AL...the Angels have defeated the A's in each of the last four season series.

### **LOS ANGELES NOTES**

- The Angels hit their 199th home run this season, second-most in team history (236 in 2000).
- Tyler Skaggs made his first start since being placed on the disabled list on 8/12/18...he pitched three no-hit innings, striking out three...it was his first appearance in which he did not allow a hit since 7/31/14 at Baltimore...Skaggs now has 395 career strikeouts.
- Andrelton Simmons is batting .364 (16 for 44) over his last 11 games.
- Mike Trout recorded his third season with 35 or more home runs, and first since 2015... he is the first Angel with three seasons of 35+ home runs, passing Troy Glaus, who had two such seasons with the Halos in 2000 and 2001.
- Trout is batting .424 (14 for 33) with two home runs and six RBI at the Coliseum in 2018.
- Kaleb Cowart hit his first career grand slam...it was the Angels' first grand slam since Cliff Pennington's on 8/30/17, also vs. the A's.
