OAKLAND ATHLETICS (94-62) VS. SEATTLE MARINERS (85-70)

ABOUT THE A'S: Had their four-game winning streak snapped on Sunday and are now 5-5 over their last 10 games...are 39-20 (.661) since the All-Star Break, which is the best record in the majors...are 60-26 (.698) over their last 86 games dating back to June 16, which is the best record in the majors over that span...are 94-62 (.603) overall, which is the fourth best record in the American League and the majors...are 32

games over .500, which is one short of the season high of 33 (94-61 on Sept. 22)...are 12-2-2 over the last 16 series and 22-3-3 over the last 28...are 35-35 (.500) against the AL West, 59-27 (.686) against all other teams.

MAGIC NUMBER: The A's have a magic number of one to clinch their fourth postseason berth in the last seven years and their ninth in the last 19 seasons...over the last seven years, only the Dodgers (5) have more than four postseason appearances (Cardinals could also get their fifth) and over the last 19 seasons only the Yankees (15), Cardinals (12), Red Sox (10) and Braves (10) have more than nine...it would be the A's 27th postseason appearance all-time, a total surpassed only by the Yankees (54), Dodgers (31) and Cardinals (28)...trail New York by 1½ games for the first Wild Card (split the season series with the Yankees and trail in the second tiebreaker, which is intradivision record)...trail first place Houston in the American League West by 4½ games and have a tragic number of three to be eliminated from the division race...were a season-high 11 games back of the second Wild Card at the conclusion of play June 15.

WINS: The A's have won 94 games after winning 75 last year and the 19-win improvement is the fourth biggest turnaround in Oakland history...it is the best since the A's went from 74 wins to 94 from 2011-12...the 94 wins are tied for 11th most in Oakland history and are the most since 2013 (96-66).

MONTH BY MONTH: The A's are 13-7 (.650) in September, which is tied for the fourth best record in the majors...posted a winning record in each of the first five months and need one more win to clinch a winning record in September...have posted a winning record in all six months six times in Oakland history (1971, 1972, 1990, 2003, 2013).

OFFENSE: The A's are batting .264 (179-for-677) with a Major League leading 129 runs scored in 20 games in September (6.45 runs per game)...overall, rank second in the majors in doubles (315) and extra base hits (548), third in home runs (214) and slugging percentage (.438), fourth in OPS (.763) and fifth in runs (775)...the extra base hits are third most in Athletics history (555 in 2001, 554 in 2017), the home runs rank fifth (243 in 1996, 239 in 2000, 235 in 1999, 234 in 2017) and the doubles are sixth (336 in 2004, 334 in 2001, 323 in 1928, 319 in 1930, 317 in 2003).

IN THE PINCH: A's pinch hitters have 30 plate appearances in the last 11 games (2.7 per game) and are 6-for-23 (.261) with a double, home run, six walks and a hit by pitch over that stretch...overall, A's pinch hitters lead the American League in extra base hits (10), doubles (7), walks (16) and plate appearances (128), rank second in hits (27), on-base percentage (.344) and slugging percentage (.391), tied for second in RBI (16), third in home runs (3) and fourth in batting (.245).

PITCHING: The A's have a 3.38 ERA (201 er in 535.1 ip) since the All-Star Break, which is second lowest in the majors to the Dodgers (3.19)...overall, rank third in the American League in OPS (.691) and fourth in ERA (3.77), opponents batting average (.237), slugging percentage (.390) and on-base percentage (.301)...are tied for second in shutouts (14), rank fourth in fewest walks (453) and fifth in fewest home runs (175)...are tied for second with 83 wild pitches, which is one short of the Athletics record of 84 set last year... have used an average of 6.05 pitchers per game in September (121 in 20 games), including nine once and eight four times...used eight pitchers in a nine-inning game a total of two times over the first 50 years in Oakland.

STARTING PITCHING: A's starting pitchers are 3-3 with a 3.09 ERA (15 er in 43.2 ip) and .228 (37-for-162) opponents batting average over the last 12 games... have a streak of 37 consecutive games of seven innings or fewer...have 807.1 innings pitched, which is tied for fifth fewest in the American League...the fewest in a non-strike season is Athletics history is 858.2 in 1997.

HOME AND AWAY: The A's begin their final road trip of the season tonight, a six-game trip to Seattle (three games) and Los Angeles-AL (three games)... went 3-3 on the last road trip to Baltimore (2-1) and Tampa Bay (1-2) and are 36-19 (.655) on the road dating back to May 14 after starting the year

8-12...are 44-31 (.587) on the road compared to 50-31 (.617) at home...have the fourth best road record in the majors and have a winning record on the road for the first time since going 44-37 in 2013...have not won more than 44 games on the road since 2002 (49-32)...went 4-2 on the final homestand against Los Angeles-AL (2-1) and Minnesota (2-1)...were 32-11 (.744) over the final 43 home games after starting the year 18-20 in the Coliseum.

HOME AND AWAY SPLITS: The A's are batting .263 (702-for-2666) with 123 home runs and an average of 5.41 runs per game on the road (406 runs in 75 games), compared to .241 with 91 home runs and an average of 4.56 runs per game at home...lead the majors in home runs on the road, rank second in runs per game and third in batting...the 123 road home runs are tied for second most in Athletics history and are seven short of the record of 130 set in 1996...have a .464 slugging percentage, which is currently an Athletics road record (.458 in 2000)...have 275 extra base hits, which is fourth most in Athletics history (300 in 2001, 287 in 2000, 281 in 2004, 280 in 1996)

ONE-RUN GAMES AND OTHER CLOSE CALLS: The A's are 31-13 (.705) in one-run games, which is the best record in the majors...the Athletics record for winning percentage in one-run games is .698 in 1928 (30-13) and the Oakland record is .696 in 2002 (32-14)...the 31 one-run wins are sixth most in Athletics history and are two short of the record of 33 set in 2004...are 13-5 (.722) in extra inning games, which is the second best record in the majors... the wins are tied with Seattle for the most in the majors and are one short of the Athletics record of 14, set in 1998...are 25-9 (.735) in games decided in the last at bat, which is the best record in the majors...the wins are the most in the majors and are one short of the Oakland record of 26 set in 2004...are tied for second in the majors in most walk-off wins (10) and fewest walk-off losses (3).

THE LATE INNINGS: The A's are the only team in the majors that is undefeated when leading after seven innings (67-0)...have an Athletics record 82-game winning streak in those games and have not lost since Sept. 2, 2017 at Texas...the last team to go undefeated when leading after seven is the 2012 Orioles (74-0)...the A's (76-0) and Mariners (74-0) are the only teams that have not lost when leading after eight innings...have a 103-game winning streak in those games and have not lost since July 27, 2017 at Toronto.

ROSTER NOTES: The A's have 38 players on the active roster...have used 53 players overall, including an Athletics record 34 pitchers...have one player with at least 128 starts at each of the four infield positions for the first time in Oakland history...the last Athletics team to do it was the 1963 Kansas City A's, who had all four infielders with at least 129 starts...have one player with at least 115 starts at seven different positions for the first time since the 2000 club had one with at least 118 starts...have used 117 different lineups... the last time the A's used fewer than 126 different lineups was in 2006 when they had 121...have not used fewer than 121 since 2004 when they had 119.

A's vs. MARINERS: The A's are 7-9 against the Mariners, including 5-5 in Oakland and 2-4 at Seattle...eight of the 16 games have been decided by one run and three others by two...have lost the season series in each of the previous five years, which is the A's longest season series losing streak against the Mariners...are 44-67 (.396) against Seattle dating back to the start of the 2013 season, which is the second worst record by any American League team against the Mariners (TB, 13-26/.333)...all-time, the A's are 348-291 against the Mariners...that includes 189-132 in Oakland, 158-158 in Seattle and 1-1 in Tokyo...are 82-94 at Safeco Field.

TODAY'S TIDBITS

Matt Chapman leads the majors with an Oakland record 25 doubles since the All-Star Break...ranks second in extra base hits (41), tied for second in hits (76) and third in runs (49)...Khris Davis has a career-high 45 home runs, which is fourth most in Oakland history and sixth in Athletics history...leads the majors in home runs and ranks second in RBI (119)...Blake Treinen has a 0.81 ERA, which leads all relievers and is the lowest in Major League history among pitchers with 75 or more innings pitched.

OAKLAND A'S 50th ANNIVERSARY MOMENTS

In **1975** Vida Blue wins his 21st game and Reggie Jackson hits two home runs as the A's defeat the Chicago White Sox 13-2 to clinch their fifth consecutive AL West title...in **1988** Dave Stewart strikes out 11 in the A's 5-2 win at Milwaukee to win his 20th game of the season...in **2000** Jason Giambi hits the 5000th home run in Oakland history, a two-run shot in the sixth inning of a 3-2 A's loss at Seattle.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Daniel Mengden (7-6, 4.00 ERA)

FOR STARTERS: Was recalled from Triple-A Nashville Aug. 27 for his second stint with the A's this year and has pitched five times since his return, all in relief...the last four have come in "opener" games started by Liam Hendriks... is 1-0 with a 1.83 ERA (19.2 ip, 12 h, 5 r, 4 er, 6 bb, 12 so, 1 hr) since his return... has tossed four or more innings in four of his appearances and has not allowed a run three times...the relief appearances are the first of his career... was in the A's starting rotation to begin the season and was 6-6 with a 4.47 ERA in 16 starts when he was placed on the disabled list June 27 retroactive to June 24 with a sprained right foot...was reinstated from the DL and optioned to Nashville July 14.

THE WEST AND THE REST: Is 0-6 with a 6.90 ERA (34 er in 44.1 ip) and .295 (54-for-183) opponents batting average in 10 games American League West teams compared to 7-0 with a 2.04 ERA (15 er in 66.0 ip) and .188 (45-for-239) opponents average in 11 games against everyone else...is 1-12 with a 6.27 ERA (68 er in 97.2 ip) in 20 career games against divisional foes, 11-5 with a 3.38 ERA (48 er in 127.2 ip) in 22 games against all other teams...his only win against an AL West team came on Oct. 1, 2017 at Texas...has a ninegame winning streak in interdivision games (15 er in 82.0 ip, 1.65 ERA) and has not lost since May 29, 2017 at Cleveland.

BY INNING: Has allowed 14 of his 55 runs in the first inning...has a 7.88 ERA (14 er in 16.0 ip) and .348 (23-for-66) opponents batting average in the first inning, a 2.84 ERA (23 er in 73.0 ip) and .206 (56-for-272) opponents average from the second through fifth innings and a 5.31 ERA (12 er in 21.1 ip) and .238 (20-for-84) opponents average from the sixth inning on.

IN SEPTEMBER: Is 1-0 with a 2.30 ERA (4 er in 15.2 ip) in four relief appearances in September...is now 4-1 with a 1.78 ERA (10 er in 50.2 ip) in nine games, including five starts, in September and October over the last two years.

OPPONENTS BATTING: Has walked just three batters to lead off an inning and opponents are hitting .186 (21-for-113) with a .214 on-base percentage in that situation...based on a minimum of 110 innings pitched, the on-base percentage is the lowest mark in the majors while the batting average is fourth lowest in the American League...has issued 20 of his 25 walks this year and 27 of 34 over the last two years to right-handed hitters...has yielded 16 home runs, 12 of which have come with the bases empty...has a .292 (50-for-171) opponents batting average the first time through the lineup, .146 (23-for-157) the second time and .277 (26-for-94) after that.

DON'T WALK: Has walked 25 batters in 110.1 innings this year, an average of 2.04 per nine innings...now has 34 walks in 153.1 innings over the last two years (2.00 per nine innings) after issuing 33 walks in 72.0 innings in his first season in 2016 (4.13 per nine innings).

DAYS REST: Is scheduled to pitch on five days rest today...is 3-2 with a 2.88 ERA (16 er in 50.0 ip) in eight games on four days rest or fewer compared to 4-4 with a 4.71 ERA (33 er in 63.0 ip) in 13 games on five days rest or more

HOME AND AWAY: Is 3-4 with a 3.60 ERA (30 er in 75.0 ip) and .222 (63-for-284) opponents batting average in 13 games at home compared to 4-2 with a 4.84 ERA (19 er in 35.1 ip) and .261 (36-for-138) opponents average in eight games on the road...entered the season with a 6.43 career ERA in Oakland, 4.12 on the road.

CAREER: Has seven wins in 21 games this year after combining for five wins in 21 starts over the first two seasons of his career...in addition to wins, he also has career highs in games (21), games started (16), innings (110.1), hits (98), runs (55) and home runs allowed (16)...is 10-7 with a 3.41 ERA (55 er in 145.1 ip) over his last 26 games dating back to Sept. 9, 2017...went 2-10 with a 6.86 ERA over the first 16 starts of his career.

2018 HIGHLIGHTS: Was 2-3 with a 4.68 ERA and .276 opponents average over his first six starts through the end of April...then went 4-1 with a 1.51 ERA and .181 opponents average in six starts in May...was one of four American League pitchers to win four games in May and had the second lowest ERA to the Astros Justin Verlander (0.86)...had never won more than two games in a month in his career...the ERA was the lowest in a single month in his career... won four consecutive starts from May 15 to 31, which is the longest winning streak of his career...compiled a 1.20 ERA and .171 opponents batting average during the streak...had a career-high and A's season-high 25.0 inning scoreless streak during the winning streak...tossed 7.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball May 20 at Toronto followed by a two-hit shutout in a 3-0 win on May 26 against Arizona...is just the second A's pitcher since at least 1908 with back-to-back scoreless outings of seven innings or more and two hits or fewer...the other is Bobby Witt from June 23-28, 1994...walked two batters May 31 against Tampa Bay, ending a season-opening streak of 11 starts with one walk or fewer...that was the longest season-opening streak by an Athletics starting pitcher since at least 1908...had a streak of 12 consecutive starts with one walk or fewer dating back to last year, which was third longest by an A's starter since at least 1908 (excludes starters who pitched in relief in between)...was 0-2 with an 11.57 ERA and .333 opponents average in four starts in June before he was placed on the disabled list June 27 retroactive to June 24 with a sprained right foot...was reinstated from the DL and optioned to Nashville July 14...was recalled by Oakland Aug. 27 and made his first career relief appearance that night Houston...entered the game to start the fourth inning with the A's trailing 5-4 and tossed 4.0 scoreless innings.

LAST APPEARANCE: He had a no decision in the A's 9-7 loss to Los Angeles (AL) last Tuesday in Oakland...relieved Hendriks to start the second inning... pitched 4.0 innings and allowed his only run on a solo home run by Trout with one out in the fourth inning...was relieved by Kelly to start the fifth inning with the A's leading 4-1 but the bullpen allowed six runs in the sixth inning for the blown save and loss.

WITH NASHVILLE: Was 4-1 with a 2.98 ERA in nine games, including eight starts, with Nashville...surrendered just two home runs in 45.1 innings, an average of 0.40 per nine innings...walked one batter or fewer in each of his nine appearances and issued seven free passes total, an average of 1.39 per nine innings...struck out 34 for a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 4.86...allowed a .231 opponents batting average, including .204 (22-for-108) against right-handed hitters compared to .279 (17-for-61) against left-handers...walked just one batter to lead off an inning and opponents hit .222 with a .255 on-base percentage and .289 slugging percentage...went 3-0 with a 1.54 ERA in four games at Nashville, 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA in five starts on the road.

LHP Brett Anderson (4-5, 3.96 ERA): Was reinstated from the 10-day disabled list Sept. 13 and is 1-1 with a 3.60 ERA in two starts since his return...was placed on the DL Aug. 28 with a strained left forearm and did not have a rehab assignment...3-3 with a 2.98 ERA and .229 opponents batting average in nine starts since the All-Star Break after going 1-2 with a 6.08 ERA and .356 opponents average in six starts before the break... combined with Dull, Montas and Brooks on a four-hit shutout in his last start, a 10-0 A's win over Los Angeles (AL) last Wednesday in Oakland (6.2 ip, 3 h, 3 so)...is 8-4 with a 1.82 ERA (108.2 ip, 97 h, 28 r, 22 er, 23 bb, 82 so, 7 hr) in 18 career appearances, including 17 starts, against Seattle...the eight wins are his most against any team...the ERA is second lowest ever against the Mariners by a pitcher with at least 100 innings (Pedro Martinez, 1.57)...is 0-0 despite a 1.29 ERA (14.0 ip, 10 h, 2 r, 2 er, 1 bb, 6 so) in two starts this year.

- The A's bullpen was credited with its 42nd win of the season Saturday, which is an on-going Athletics record for wins by the bullpen...it is also second most in Major League history (TB 52 in 2018)...are 42-14 (.750), which is the best winning percentage in the Majors (Boston, .736).
- A's relievers have 605.0 innings pitched, which is an Athletics record, T3rd
 most in the majors this year and tied for sixth most in Major League history.
- Has compiled a 2.92 ERA (98 er in 301.2 ip) over the last 71 games dating back to July 3.
- Has converted 43-of-59 (72.9%) save opportunities, which is fifth best in the Majors...ranks fifth in the American League in saves.
