TODAY'S GAME: The defending World Series Champion Houston Astros, winners of four straight, are in the midst of their longest homestand of the season, an 11-game, 11-day stand, which will take them thru the All-Star Break...speaking of All-Stars, **RHP Charlie Morton** (10-2), who is bidding for his first All-Star selection, will start for the Astros today opposite **RHP James Shields** (3-9) and the White Sox.

#ALLSTROSGAME: All-Star Teams and the Final Vote ballot will be unveiled this Sunday at 6 p.m. CT on ESPN...the 89th MLB All-Star Game will be played on July 17 and televised on FOX.

WINNING WAYS: The Astros are a season-high 28 games over .500 as they are off to their second-best, 90-game start in franchise history, trailing only their 61-29 start in 2017...a win today would give the Astros their fifth winning streak of five-or-more games this season.

VS. THE SOX: The Astros have had their way against the White Sox this season, going 5-0 so far, including a three-game sweep in Chicago in April...dating back to last season, the Astros are 7-1 in their last 8 opposite the White Sox.

HOMER HAPPY: The Astros have homered in a season-long 13 straight games, which ranks as their seventh-longest streak in franchise history...the 2017 club had two streaks longer than 13 games, a franchise record 19-game streak (May 23-June 11) and a 15-game run (June 13-29).

HOME COOKING: **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (10-3) has posted a 4-1 record and a 2.47 ERA (14ER/51IP) in eight starts at Minute Maid Park this season...his career winning percentage and ERA at Minute Maid Park rank as the best in stadium history (min. 200IP).

ASTROS SELECT TUCKER: The Astros have selected **OF Kyle Tucker** (#3) to the Major League roster today...he will take the roster spot of **OF Jake Marisnick**, who was optioned to Triple A Fresno today...per MLB.com, Tucker ranks as the Astros top prospect and the No. 8 prospect in baseball...the Astros will make Tucker available to the media today in the Astros clubhouse.

SPRINGER'S CAUSE: **OF George Springer** will be hosting families from **SAY: The Stuttering Association for the Young** for a meet and greet prior to today's game...the meet and greet will be held in the press conference room following Astros batting practice and is open to the media.

HIT MACHINE: **2B Jose Altuve** leads MLB in hits (119) and in batting average (.337)...he has 56 hits in his last 39 games (since May 25), batting .381 in that span.
