WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers lost to the Indians last night, 16-3, and club is 0-2 to begin this 2nd 'half' opening 7-day, 7-game homestand against CLE (0-2) and OAK (4 G)...team has dropped 4 straight, 7 of 8, and 9 of 11, as 3-12 (.200) record in July is tied w/ SD (also 3-12) for lowest win pct. in MLB this month...all 3 wins in July have come against DET (2) and BAL (1)...TEX has more losses this month (3-12) than in entire month of June (14-11)...team still has a 14-14 record beginning 6/16.

• At 41-58 (.414), Rangers rank 12th in A.L. in winning pct...the 41 wins are the fewest for Texas after 99 games since 2014 (40-59) and 2nd fewest in last 16 seasons (beg. 2004).
 • Texas has been under the .500 mark since a season best 1-1 on 3/30...Rangers have matched low mark of season at 17 games under .500 (2nd time, also 27-44 thru 6/15)...this was just 4th season in TEX history to be 17+ under as early as 6/15 (last 2007, club-record 6/3)...last 18-under at end of 2014 (67-95)...club lost a season high 7 straight games from 6/7-15 and directly followed that with a 2018 best 7 consecutive wins from 6/16-23.

SERIES FINALE: Texas enters today needing a win to avoid going winless in a series for a 6th time...the current 5: 4/9-11 vs. LAA (3), 6/7-10 vs. HOU (4), 6/12-13 at LAD (2), 7/3-4 vs. HOU (2), and 7/9-11 at BOS (3)...team is also 4-12 (.250) in Sunday games, lowest win pct. in MLB and tied w/ COL and MIL (both 4-11) for fewest wins on this day of the week...Rangers have lost 10 of last 12 Sunday tilts.

IN THE STANDINGS: Texas is a season high 24.0 GB of the division-leading Astros for the 1st time...this is the 2nd-earliest date ever for Rangers to have a 24-game deficit (6/4 in 2001) and just the 10th season overall in club history to have a deficit so large...only other season with a 24+ game deficit in last 16 seasons (beg. 2004) was 2014...club has lost 7.5 games in the standings over the last 18 days...current deficit is 3rd-largest in the majors...club has been in 5th place in the A.L. West for the last 103 days and in either 4th or 5th place for 113 of 114 days (T2nd following win on 3/30).

AT HOME: Texas is 19-30 (.388) in Arlington this season, 3rd-lowest home win pct. in A.L. and 4th-lowest in MLB...team has lost 5 straight at home after having gone 6-1 in Arlington from 6/16-6/30...longest home losing streak in '18 was 0-6 span from 4/8-21...team is still 6-6 in last 12 at home, this after a 5-G losing skid from 6/7-15, and are 12-13 in last 25 G after opening year at 5-15...overall 19-30 record matches slowest 49-G start at home in TEX history (also 19-30 in 2014)...club also dropped next home game in '14.

VS. CLEVELAND: Rangers are 1-4 vs. Tribe in '18 entering final meeting of the year today...TEX has dropped 6 of 7 and 10 of 12 vs. CLE, and club's 12-26 (.316) record vs. Tribe since start of 2013 is lowest win pct. vs. any A.L. opponent in that span...at home, Rangers have lost 5 straight, 6 of 8, 11 of 15, and 13 of 18 since 6/11/13...TEX is now 1-4-1 in season series w/ CLE since 2013 after losing the '18 season series...Rangers still have leads vs. Tribe all-time (251-219), in Arlington (131-107), and at Globe Life Park (60-52).

THE SWINGIN' A'S: The A's will be in Arlington for a 4-G series beginning Monday night...Rangers are 5-4 vs. OAK in '18, only A.L. West opponent with a winning record against...TEX has won 3 straight and 4 of last 6 vs. A's, and have a 3-2 mark in Arlington...this is the 3rd straight series between the clubs to be played at Globe Life Park, as each of final 2 meetings will be at the Coliseum (8/20-22 and 9/7-9).

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Last night's 16-3 loss was Rangers' largest margin of defeat in '18, season-highs in runs and hits (21) allowed...Tribe has 38 hits in 1st G this weekend...TEX record for hits allowed in 3-G series is 47 (4x, last 7/3-5/15 vs. LAA).

QUITE A RUN: Shin-Soo Choo's went 0-for-4 last night, as his on-base streak ended at 52 games from May 13-July 20...Choo's figures during the streak: .337/.468/.588/1.056 (67-199), 13 HR, 29 RBI, 32 R, 48 BB/52 SO...the 52-game on-base streak set a club record for a single season, the longest in MLB since Kevin Millar (52 G, 6/20-8/25/07), and the 1st LH batter with a streak of 50+ G since Barry Bonds in 2003 (58 G, 6/27-9/20/03) - credit STATS.

• Choo ranks 3rd in the A.L. in OBP (.401) and BB (63) this season.

BELTRÉ GOES DEEP: Adrián Beltré hit a 2-R HR in the 7th last night to account for the Rangers' 1st 2 runs...it was career HR no. 467 for Beltré, as he is now one behind Chipper Jones (33rd, 468) on the all-time HR chart...last night was Beltré's 114th career HR at Globe Life Park in Arlington, 3rd-all-time to only Rafael Palmeiro (130) and Juan Gonzalez (115).

ELVIS APPROACHES MILESTONE: Elvis Andrus enters today's series finale with 1498 career hits, 2 shy of becoming just the 5th player in Rangers history to reach 1500 hits with the club...the others: Michael Young (2230), Ivan Rodriguez (1747), Rafael Palmeiro (1692), and Juan Gonzalez (1595).

• Andrus posted his 1000th career hit against the Indians, a double on 5/25/15 at CLE...he has hit safely in 60 of 66 career games vs. CLE, with his .373/.441/.546/.987 (93-249) slash line holding his highest marks in those categories against any A.L. opponent.

ODOR STILL GOING: Rougned Odor had 2 hits last night, the only Ranger with multiple hits, as he has gone 5-for-10 to begin the 2nd 'half'...Odor is batting .327/.417/.500/.917 (17-52) in July to raise his average for the year from .229 to a season-high .250...since the start of June, Odor's .285 (39-137) batting average ranks 2nd among all Rangers (regardless of AB total) to only Shin-Soo Choo (.338).

KEONE KELA has a 1.57 ERA (4 ER/23.0 IP) over his last 24 appearances to drop his season ERA from 6.55 to 3.18, lowest since 4/28 (3.00)...he is 23-for-23 in save chances, 5th in A.L. in saves, and has the most saves in MLB without a blown save...Kela's 25 straight saves converted dating to 2017 ranks T2nd-best streak in club history (31-Joe Nathan, 4/15-9/12/12; 25-John Wetteland, 7/25/97-5/20/98)...Kela has the victory or save in 26 of Texas' 41 wins.

EVERYBODY WANTS SOME: Texas has used at least 12 position players in each of the 1st 2 G of this series (13 Friday, 12 last night)...it marks the 1st time for the Rangers to use 12+ position players in back-to-back games in A.L. parks (25-man rosters) since 5/30-31/17 vs. TB.

HOT STUFF: Game-time temperature for the 1st 2 games of this series has been 107 degrees, the warmest figures in the history of Globe Life Park in Arlington...the forecast temperature for 2pm CT today in Arlington is 105 degrees, making today unlikely to surpass the record set the past 2 nights.

#49 Yovani Gallardo, RHP (3-1, 8.60)

TODAY: The 32-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 9th appearance/6th start of the season in the finale of this 3-game set in Arlington...has gone 3-1 with a 6.75 ERA (21 ER/28.0 IP) over 5 starts with the Rangers (Texas is 4-1 in those starts)...will be working on extended 11 days' rest after picking suffering his 1st loss in '18 with Texas in the Rangers' 8-4 defeat on 7/10 at BOS (5.0 IP, 7 H, 6 R-ER, 2 BB, 2 SO, 97 pitches/52 strikes)...opponents have batted .282/.333/.482/.815 in last 5 starts...had contract purchased from Round Rock (AAA) prior to start on 6/17, where he went 2-1 with a 3.81 ERA (21 ER/49.2 IP) in 10 starts after signing with Texas as a minor league free agent on 4/13... prior to joining the Texas organization, Gallardo had early season stints with Milwaukee and Cincinnati...the Fort Worth resident was a member of the rotation for the Rangers' 2015 division-winner in his lone season with the club...was the Rangers Opening Day starter in 2015, posting the lowest ERA of his career and starting Game 1 of the 2015 ALDS vs. Toronto...since 1st stint with Texas, has spent seasons with Baltimore (2016) and Seattle (2017)...was a mainstay in the Brewers starting rotation from 2009-14 as one of the National League's most durable pitchers over that period...was one of just 9 pitchers to work at least 180.0 innings and one of 10 hurlers to make 30+ starts each year from 2009-14...has fanned 200 or more batters in a season 4 times (2009-10-11-12) and remains the Milwaukee franchise's career strikeout leader...was a 2nd round selection by the Brewers in the 2004 1st Year Player Draft out of Trimble Tech High School in Fort Worth, TX...has the 2nd-most strikeouts (1546) among natives of Mexico, and also ranks among the all-time Mexican leaders in wins (3rd, 116), starts (3rd, 294), and innings (4th, 1752.2).

LAST START: Suffered the loss in the Rangers' 8-4 loss on 7/10 at BOS (5.0 IP, 7 H, 6 R-ER, 2 BB, 2 SO, 97 pitches/52 strikes)...exited the game trailing 6-4, exiting the game after pitching the 5th inning...had worked into the 6th inning in the four prior starts...did not allow a hit through first 2.1 innings of work before allowing 5 runs in the 3rd...allowed five extra-base hits.

VS. THE INDIANS: Has gone 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER/11.0 IP) over 2 career starts vs. the Indians...both starts came at Progressive Field...has not faced the Indians as a member of the Rangers...last season, took the loss for Seattle in a 4-3 setback on 4/29/17 (6.0 IP, 4 R-ER)...after allowing 4 R/3 H in the 1st, allowed no runs and just 3 H over the next 5 frames...his 7 K's matched a season high in 2017 (4/23)...had at least 7 K's in consecutive starts for the first time since 6/8-14/14...in career at home against A.L. Central opponents, has gone 6-2 with a 3.68 ERA (32 ER/78.1 IP).

IN ARLINGTON: Has gone 1-0, with a 5.84 ERA (8 ER/12.1 IP) in 2 home starts with the Rangers...has gone 5-3 with a 5.53 ERA (33 ER/53.2 IP) over his 10 starts at Globe Life Park in Arlington since 2015...opponents have batted .245/.310/.434/.77 in 3 G/2 GS at home compared to .361/.420/.611/1.031 in 5 G/3 GS at home.
