**TODAY'S TILT**...the Mariners continue a 2-state, 3-city, 10-day, 10-game road trip with the finale (3-0) of 4 games at Houston...began the trip by going 1-2 at Texas...will also travel to Oakland (3 G)...following the series in Oakland and an off day on Thursday, will return to Safeco Field for a 6-day, 6-game homestand against Los Angeles-NL (3 G) and Houston (3 G)...today's game will be televised on ROOT SPORTS NW and broadcast live on 710 ESPN Seattle and the Mariners Radio Network...today's game will also be televised nationally on TBS.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners have won 3 in a row and 5 of their last 7 games...are 13-19 (7/4-current) since winning a season-high 8 straight games (6/25-7/3)...the Mariners have won 28 of their last 54 games, 35 of their last 63, 39 of their last 69, 44 of their last 75 and 46 of their last 79...Seattle is 54-39 in its last 93 games, 59-42 over its last 101 games and 64-46 in its last 110 games...Seattle is 21-19 during the day and 47-31 at night...Seattle is 36-24 at Safeco Field, 32-26 on the road.

- **Break Out the Brooms** - the Mariners are seeking their first 4-game sweep of the Astros in club history; are 1-3-2 in the previous 6 4-game series between these two clubs...needless to say, the Mariners have never swept a 4-game series at Minute Maid Park...the Mariners have swept 2 3-game series at MMP (last: 6/30-7/2/14).
- **Double Double** - Mitch Haniger has 4 doubles so far in this series...the club record for doubles in a 4-game series is 5, done 4 times - including twice by Edgar Martinez - and most recently by Kyle Seager from Aug. 22-24, 2011 at Cleveland.
- **Dallas, You Have a Problem** - Nelson Cruz leads all players with 5 career home runs off Astros starter Dallas Keuchel...Kyle Seager has belted 3 home runs vs. Keuchel, while Jean Segura has 2 homers vs. the lefty.
- **Eight is Great** - Edwin Diaz has earned the save in each of the Mariners last 8 wins (7/25-c)...marks the 2nd time this season he has picked up the save in at least 7 straight team wins (also: 7, 6/30-7/20)...Tom Wilhelmson (8/28-9/22/12) and Danny Farquhar (8/3-29/13) share the club record of 10 saves in 10 consecutive team wins.
- **Keeping Them in the Yard** - the Mariners have held the Astros to 1 home run so far in this series...only one team has limited Houston to 1 home run in a 4-game series this season: New York-AL, April 30 - May 3 in Houston.
- **Road Warrior** - Kyle Seager has 13 home runs and 43 RBI in 58 games on the road this season...among AL leaders in road games, Seager ranks T4th in RBI and T10th in home runs (also: Nelson Cruz and 5 other players).

**ON THE OFFENSIVE**...in the first 3 games of this series, the Mariners are batting .292 (31x106) as a team, slugging 11 doubles, 2 triples and 3 home runs while recording 16 RBI, 3 HBP, 3 walks, a .327 on-base percentage and a .519 slugging percentage (.846 OPS)...four Mariners are batting at least .333 so far in this series: Denard Span (.600/6x10, 3 R, 3B, HR, 4 RBI, BB), Mitch Haniger (.500/6x12, 3 R, 4 2B, HR, 3 RBI, BB), Nelson Cruz (.385/5x13, R, 2 2B, 3 RBI) and Jean Segura (.333/4x12, 3 R, 2B, HR, 2 RBI).

**CLIMBING THE RANKS**...with his 45th save of the season last night, Edwin Diaz moved into a tie with Kazuhiro Sasaki (2001) for the 2nd-most saves in single-season club history...he now trails only the club record of 48 saves, set by Fernando Rodney in 2014...Diaz leads the Majors with 45 saves, while ranking 2nd among all relievers with 98 strikeouts (Josh Hader-MIL, 104)...Diaz is already 1 of 7 pitchers in Major League history (done 10x) with at least 45 saves and 98 strikeouts in a season (last: Kenley Jansen-LAD, 2016).

**ONE IS ALL IT TAKES**...with last night's 3-2 victory over Houston, the Mariners improved to 29-14 (.674) in one-run games this season...Seattle leads the Majors in one-run wins in 2018, while ranking 2nd in winning percentage behind Oakland (.688/22-10)...the Mariners are 12-7 (.632) in one-run games on the road this season, leading the Majors in wins while ranking 4th in winning percentage...with 44 games remaining in the regular season, the Mariners 29 one-run wins rank T5th-most in single-season club history (also: 1993), trailing only the Mariners clubs of 2009 (35), 1982 (31), 2016 (30) and 1984 (30)...since 2016, the Mariners are 85-59 (.590) in games decided by one run, leading the Majors in wins, winning percentage and games played (144).

**LOCK IT DOWN**...Edwin Diaz has successfully converted 26 consecutive saves, the 3rd-longest streak in club history...he trails only J.J. Putz (31, 9/30/06 - 7/20/07) and Eddie Guardado (27, 4/13-8/9/05)...Diaz's current streak began on June 2, and over that span, he is 26-for-26 in save opportunities while posting a 0.95 ERA (3 ER, 28.1 IP) with 48 strikeouts and 3 walks in 28 games...he has held opponents to a .153 (15x98) average against since June 2, including a .115 (10x87) average against in save opportunities...Diaz has allowed only 1 run over 26.1 innings in 26 save opportunities in that time.

**SPANNING THE GLOBE**...in 57 games with the Mariners this season, Denard Span is batting .309 (58x188) with 23 runs, 9 doubles, 5 triples, 5 home runs, 23 RBI, 2 HBP, 13 walks, a .351 on-base percentage, a .489 slugging percentage and an .840 OPS...since making his Mariners debut on May 25, Span leads the club in batting (min. 200 PA), while ranking 2nd in slugging and OPS...Span has hit safely in each of his last 7 games (8/5-c), batting .440 (11x25) with 4 runs, 1 double, 2 triples, 1 home run, 5 RBI, 1 HBP and 1 walk...he is 10-for-20 (.500) in 6 games so far on this road trip...in 6 games against Houston this season, he is batting .500 (10x20) with 5 runs, 2 triples, 2 home runs, 5 RBI, 1 HBP and 3 walks...for his career vs. the Astros, Span is batting .459 (17x37) with 11 runs, 1 double, 3 triples, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, 1 HBP, 5 walks, 4 stolen bases, a .523 on-base percentage and an .811 slugging percentage (1.334 OPS) in 10 games.
