THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY - AUG. 14

2000 - **OF Moises Alou** hits two home runs in the Astros 16-2 win over the Pirates at Minute Maid Park...the day prior, Alou had also hit two home runs in a 14-7 Astros win at PHI...he is one of three players in franchise history to hit two home runs in consecutive games, also **Richard Hidalgo** (2000) and **Doug Rader** (1973).

TONIGHT'S GAME: The defending World Series Champion Houston Astros will continue this six-game homestand tonight with the first game of a two-game mini-series with the Rockies...**RHP Justin Verlander** will get the start for the Astros, as they try to snap their eight-game losing streak at Minute Maid Park, opposite **RHP German Márquez** and the Rockies.

QUEST FOR #200: **RHP Justin Verlander** enters tonight with 199 career victories and is seeking to become the 114th pitcher in MLB history to reach 200 wins...only two active pitchers have reached 200 wins: **RHP Bartolo Colon** (247) and **LHP CC Sabathia** (244).

PUNCHING TICKETS: **RHP Justin Verlander** (206K) and **RHP Gerrit Cole** (207K) both rank in the top five in the AL in strikeouts...they are the first pair of Astros teammates to reach 200 strikeouts in the same season since **RHP Roger Clemens** (218K) and **RHP Roy Oswalt** (206K) in 2004.

FIVE GUYS: The Astros have only used five starting pitchers this season, the fewest in the Majors, and two less than their closest counterparts, the Rockies (7) and Indians (7)...the Astros rotation has posted the best ERA (3.07) and WHIP (1.09) and the most strikeouts (837) in the Majors this season.

119-GAME RECORD: The Astros are 27 games above .500, standing at 73-46, which ties as their best record thru 119 games in franchise history, also reached by the 1998 and 2017 squads...the best 120-game record in franchise history is currently a 74-46 record, reached by both the 1998 and 2017 squads.

TAP THE ROCKIES: The Astros are matching up with the Rockies for the second time this season after splitting a two-game set in Denver last month...the Astros have posted a 56-30 all-time record in home games vs. COL, including a 32-13 record at Minute Maid Park.

INTERLEAGUE SUCCESS: The Astros have gone 10-5 in Interleague play this season, including matchups with SD (2-1), ARI (1-2), SF (4-0), COL (1-1) and LAD (2-1)...since manager **AJ Hinch** took the helm in 2015, Houston has combined to go 52-23 (.693) in Interleague play, the second-best record in the Majors in that span behind Boston (51-19, .729).

SKIPPERING: Speaking of wins under the leadership of **AJ Hinch**, the Astros manager has posted a 344-270 managerial record in his three-plus years at the helm...he already ranks fifth in Astros history in managerial wins and is just 11 wins shy of tying **Harry Walker** (355-353) for fourth on the all-time list.

SUNDAY SCARIES: The Astros dropped their fourth straight game on Sunday to the Mariners in Houston, dropping a 10-inning contest by a score of 4-3...**LHP Dallas Keuchel** (1ER/7IP) pitched another solid outing for the Astros in the no decision...**3B Alex Bregman** (2x4) and **2B Marwin Gonzalez** (2x4) each recorded two hits, while **SS Carlos Correa** (1x5) picked up his first hit since returning from the Disabled List.

INJURY REPORT: The Astros injury report continued to grow over the weekend as **OF Jake Marisnick** was placed on the 10-day DL (left groin discomfort) on Saturday...the report already included five former All-Stars in **2B Jose Altuve** (right knee soreness), **RHP Chris Devenski** (left hamstring tightness), **C Brian McCann** (right knee discomfort), **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (right elbow discomfort) and **OF George Springer** (left thumb sprain).

STEPPING UP: Since **2B Jose Altuve** was placed on the DL on July 29, the Astros have gone 6-7...since that date **IF Marwin Gonzalez** has hit .326 (15x46) with a double and four home runs, while **IF Tyler White** has hit .317 (13x41) with two doubles, a triple and three home runs.

THE KID: **IF Alex Bregman** has been a steady performer for the Astros all season, as he leads the club in runs (76), doubles (37), home runs (22), RBI (73), slugging (.516), OPS (.899) and WAR (5.1)...he's been all over the bases dating back to May 15, reaching base safely in 72 of his last 74 games.

VINTAGE KEUCHEL: **LHP Dallas Keuchel** has found his form over his last 11 starts, posting a 6-1 record with a 2.19 ERA (17ER/70IP) and nine quality starts...with 7.0 innings pitched on Sunday, Keuchel surpassed **Mike Hampton** (1138) for the 3rd-most innings pitched by a left-handed pitcher in Astros history and now trails only **Bob Knepper** (1738) and **Wandy Rodriguez** (1306.2).

UNHITTABLE: **RHP Collin McHugh** has posted a 0.98 ERA (6ER/55IP) this season, which ranks second among all MLB relievers...**LHP Tony Sipp** has not allowed a run in 28 of his last 29 outings, dating back to May 11, posting a 0.39 ERA (1ER/23.1IP) in that time frame.

LEGENDS WEEKEND HOME RUN DERBY: On Sunday, the Astros held the first Legends Weekend Home Run Derby at Minute Maid Park, with former Astro **Luke Scott** edging out Hall-of-Famer **Craig Biggio** in the Championship round...those two were joined in the field by Astros TV broadcaster **Geoff Blum** and AT&T SportsNet analyst **Preston Wilson**.

MEDIA WALL OF HONOR: The Astros have opened up a call for nominations for the 2018 inductee to the Houston Baseball Media Wall of Honor...nominations can be made by season-credentialed media only and are due by Friday, Aug. 17...following the nomination process, a formal ballot will be distributed to the media.

ADOPT-A-FIRE STATION: Earlier today, the **Astros Foundation** and **Gardner Denver** welcomed **Houston Fire Department Station 38**, located at 1120 Silber Road, into the **Adopt-A-Fire Station** program, which seeks to support local first responders and the work they do in the Houston community...the program connects Houston fire stations and Astros players...in a ceremony today, Astros pitcher **Joe Smith** presented a framed jersey and visited with Houston Fire Department Station 38 first responders.
