WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers lost to the Angels last night, 11-7, and team has a 3-2 record on this 6-game, 7-day homestand vs. ARI (1-1) and LAA (2-1)...Texas has won 2 of 3 and 9 of last 16 G, but has still dropped 4 of 7, 5 of 9, and 7 of last 13 G...team's 13-8 (.619) record since 7/27 is 5th-best in MLB...Rangers have lost 19 of 34 and 21 of last 37 G, the longer span beginning 7/6...team is 28-26 beginning 6/16.

• The Rangers are 9-7 (.563) in August, T4th-best record in the A.L. this month...the 9 August wins have already surpassed last month's total, as 8-17 (.320) record in July marked lowest win pct. in A.L. and 2nd-lowest in MLB (SD: 5-20, .200)...at 14-14 (.500) since the AS break, TEX is T5th-best record in the A.L., as 7 of the 15 teams in the league have a record at or above .500 in the 2nd 'half'.

• At 55-70 (.440), Rangers are 11th in the A.L. in winning percentage...the 55 wins are fewest for Texas after 125 G since 2014 (48-77) and 2nd-fewest for club since start of 2008.

TONIGHT: The 32-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 14th appearance/11th start of the season in the finale of this weekend series with the Halos... will be his 300th career start...his 7 wins since 6/23 are tied for most in the majors...will be working on regular 4-days' rest for the 1st time since 7/27 at HOU, as each of his last 3 starts have come on extended rest...had a 4-G win streak snapped in his last start, a 6-4 Texas loss to the Diamondbacks on Tuesday earlier on this homestand...has allowed 2 R-or-less in 3 of his last 5 starts...has gone 7-2 with a 5.33 ERA (32 ER/54.0 IP) in 10 starts with the Rangers this season... had contract purchased from Triple-A Round Rock prior to start on 6/17, where he went 2-1 with a 3.81 ERA (21 ER/49.2 IP) in 10 starts after signing with Texas as a minor league free agent on 4/13...signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on 12/21/17 and was released near the end of spring training on 3/26...signed with Cincinnati on 3/31 and was added to the Reds bullpen...allowed 8 R-ER over 2.1 IP with 6 of the 8 runs coming on 4/6 at PIT...was designated for assignment by Cincinnati on 4/10 and refused a minor league assignment on 4/12 to become a free agent...signed a minor league deal with Texas the following day...was the Rangers Opening Day starter in 2015, posting the lowest ERA of his career and starting Game 1 of the 2015 ALDS vs. Toronto...Rangers are 8-2 in his 10 starts.

WAY BACK TEXAS: The Fort Worth native had his contract purchased from Round Rock (AAA) prior to start on 6/17...he went 2-1 with a 3.81 ERA (21 ER/49.2 IP) in 10 starts for the Express after signing with Texas as a minor league free agent on 4/13...prior to joining the Texas organization, Gallardo had early season stints with Milwaukee and Cincinnati...the Fort Worth resident was a member of the rotation for the Rangers' 2015 division-winner in his lone season with the club...was the Rangers Opening Day starter in 2015, posting the lowest ERA of his career and starting Game 1 of the 2015 ALDS vs. Toronto.
