BALTIMORE ORIOLES (41-101) at TAMPA BAY RAYS (77-64)

LHP Josh Rogers (1-1, 4.35) vs. RHP Ryne Stanek (2-3, 2.65)

**LEFT OUT:** On August 28, LHP Josh Rogers became the first left-handed pitcher to start a game for the Orioles this season (133<sup>rd</sup> game for Baltimore)...According to STATS, LLC., the last team to go an entire season without using a left-handed starting pitcher was the 2017 Philadelphia Phillies...The Cleveland Indians are the only team yet to start a left-handed pitcher this season...The last and only time in Orioles history (since 1954) that the club went an entire season without using a left-handed starting pitcher was the 2002 season...LHP Wade Miley, on September 29, 2017 at Tampa Bay, was the last left-handed pitcher to start for the Orioles, a stretch of 134 consecutive games started by right-handed pitchers...The 134 consecutive games started by right-handers was the second-longest active stretch in the majors, behind Cleveland (160)...The streak of 134 games was tied for the second-longest stretch in O's history (also September 21, 1998-August 26, 1999), trailing only a stretch of 225 consecutive games started by right-handed pitchers from July 25, 2001-March 31, 2003.

**FRESH FACES:** With his first appearance on Sept. 7 at Tampa Bay, RHP Luis Ortiz became the 13<sup>th</sup> Oriole to make his Major League debut this season, the most in a season since 1955 when 14 players made their debuts...The 13 debuts rank second-most in a season in Orioles history (since 1954)...According to STATS, LLC., the most O's to debut in a season came in 1955 (the club's second year in Baltimore) with 14.

**PLAYERS CLUB:** With his first appearance on Sept. 7 at Tampa Bay, RHP Luis Ortiz became the 54<sup>th</sup> player and 28<sup>th</sup> pitcher to appear in a game for the O's this season...The 54 players used is tied for the most in Orioles history (since 1954) matching the 54 players used during the 1955 season (2012 and 2013 clubs each used 52 players)...The 28 pitchers mark the most in O's history (2007, 2009, 2011, and 2016 teams each used 27 pitchers).

**WE SHALL NOT FORGET:** Major League Baseball announced plans for league-wide commemoration of September 11, 2001 with tributes at all games on Tuesday, September 11...This remembrance is part of Major League Baseball's ongoing effort to honor those whose lives were lost and affected on that tragic day 17 years ago...Clubs will recognize the day with a moment of silence and pregame ceremonies...A "We Shall Not Forget" silhouetted batter ribbon will be displayed throughout ballparks, on special lineup cards, and on base jewels...Players, coaches, and umpires will wear caps with a side patch of the ribbon during games...Major League Baseball will donate all royalties from the sales of the caps to the National September 11 Memorial & Museum, the Pentagon Memorial Fund, and the Flight 93 National Memorial.

**MINOR LEAGUE PLAYERS OF THE MONTH:** Class A-Advanced Frederick LHP Alex Wells was named the Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month for August...Wells went 3-1 with a 1.97 ERA (7 ER/32.0 IP) in five August starts...He struck out 29 batters, while issuing only four walks, and held opponents to a .188 (22-for-117) batting average...It was Wells' second career Orioles Pitcher of the Month award, also taking home the honors in July 2017...Short-Season A Aberdeen INF Adam Hall was named the Orioles Minor League Player of the Month for August...Hall hit .390 (32-for-82) with four doubles, two triples, a home run, 20 runs scored, 12 RBI, nine walks, and 15 stolen bases in 23 August games...He recorded a career-high 19-game hitting streak during the month (August 4-28), and hit safely in 20-of-23 games overall...Hall was also named Player of the Month for August for the New York-Penn League by Minor League Baseball...Hall led the league in average (.390), on-base percentage (.462), OPS (.987), and stolen bases (15)...He was second in runs scored (20) and third in slugging (.524)...Hall, 19, was selected in the second round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of A.B. Lucas Secondary School in London, Ontario, Canada...Hall will receive an award from Minor League Baseball in recognition of the honor.

**I CAN SEE FOR MILES AND MILES AND MILES AND MILES...:** The Orioles are currently on a three-city, nine-game road trip that includes stops at Kansas City (0-3), Seattle (1-2), and Tampa Bay (0-2)...If driving this trip, the journey would cover 7,058 miles between ballparks...The 7,058 total miles includes Oriole Park at Camden Yards to Kauffman Stadium (1,107 miles), Kauffman Stadium to Safeco Field (1,843 miles), Safeco Field to Tropicana Field (3,145 miles), and Tropicana Field to Oriole Park at Camden Yards (963 miles)...Again, if driving, the trip would traverse 22 states plus Washington, D.C.

**LEADING MAN-CINI:** Trey Mancini hit a lead-off home run in the eighth inning on Sept. 1, his 21<sup>st</sup> homer of the season...He is hitting .327 (50-for-153) when leading off an inning...In 45 games since the All-Star break, he is hitting .288 (51-for-177) with nine home runs and 25 RBI.

**BREAKING NEWS:** The Orioles rank among league leaders in several major offensive categories since the All-Star break, including ranking first in the AL and second in the majors in batting average at .266 (413-for-1552)...They have recorded 413 hits in 45 games since the All-Star break, ranking third in the AL and are tied for eighth in the majors...The Orioles have hit 61 home runs since the break to rank fifth in the AL and tied for eighth in the majors...The O's .427 slugging percentage ranks seventh in the AL and 12<sup>th</sup> in the majors since the break.

**QUALITY OVER QUANTITY:** RHP Alex Cobb tossed the Orioles 59<sup>th</sup> Quality Start of the season on Tuesday...The O's 59 Quality Starts this season are tied for seventh in the AL and tied for 17<sup>th</sup> in the majors...Cobb leads the club with 15 Quality Starts...O's starters have received 327 runs of support this season, which ranks second-fewest in the majors...Overall, O's pitchers have received 551 runs of support this season, which ranks fourth-fewest in the majors and ranks second-fewest in the AL.

**CEDRIC THE ENTERTAINER:** OF Cedric Mullins went 1-for-4 on Saturday...Since making his Major League debut on August 10, he is batting .270 (24-for-89) and 10 of his 24 hits are extra-base hits...Since his debut, Mullins' .270 batting average ranks seventh among AL rookies and ranks 11<sup>th</sup> in the majors among rookies...His seven doubles since August 10 are tied for fourth in the majors among rookies.

**VS. TAMPA BAY:** The Orioles and Rays play the final game of 19 matchups between the two clubs this season...The Rays lead the season series, 10-8...The Rays won the 2017 season series, 11-8...Baltimore leads Tampa Bay in the all-time series, 187-184, with the Orioles going 99-84 at home and 88-100 at Tropicana Field.

**TRADE WINDS:** On July 31, the Orioles acquired RHP Evan Phillips, INF Jean Carlos Encarnación, C Brett Cumberland, LHP Bruce Zimmermann, and International Signing Bonus Slot Money from the Atlanta Braves in exchange for RHP Kevin Gausman and RHP Darren O'Day...Also on July 31, the Orioles acquired INF Jonathan Villar, RHP Luis Ortiz, and INF Jean Carmona from the Milwaukee Brewers in exchange for INF Jonathan Schoop...On July 29, the Orioles traded RHP Brad Brach to the Atlanta Braves in exchange for International Signing Bonus Slot Money...On July 24, the Orioles acquired RHP Dillon Tate, LHP Josh Rogers, and RHP Cody Carroll from the New York Yankees in exchange for LHP Zach Britton...On July 18, the Orioles acquired OF Yusniel Díaz, INF Rylan Bannon, INF Breyvic Valera, RHP Dean Kremer, and RHP Zach Pop from the Los Angeles Dodgers in exchange for INF Manny Machado.

**THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY:** On this date in 1954, RHP Joe Coleman tossed a one-hitter against Casey Stengel's New York Yankees...The lone hit off Coleman was an eighth-inning single by RF Enos Slaughter...The Orioles won, 1-0, at Memorial Stadium in a game that took just 1:55 to play.

**DISABLED LIST:** Five O's are currently on the DL...RHP Pedro Araujo (right elbow strain, since 6/11), INF Steve Wilkerson (left oblique strain, retroactive to 7/2), and OF/DH Mark Trumbo (right knee inflammation, since 8/20) are on the 10-day DL...RHP Gabriel Ynoa (right shoulder inflammation, retroactive to 3/26) and LHP Richard Bleier (left shoulder latissimus strain, retroactive to 6/14) are on the 60-day DL.

**THE SKIPPER:** A three-time Manager of the Year (1994, 2004, 2014), Buck Showalter is in his ninth season as Orioles manager...He has managed the Yankees (313-268-1, 1992-95), Diamondbacks (250-236, 1998-2000), Rangers (319-329, 2003-06), and Orioles (663-670, Aug. 2010-current)...Showalter's 1,545 career wins rank 24<sup>th</sup> all-time and are third among active managers behind Bruce Bochy, Mike Scioscia, and Terry Francona...His 663 wins as O's manager are second-most in club history behind only Earl Weaver (1,480).

**QUICK HITS:** Making his third Major League start and appearance after having his contract selected from Triple-A Norfolk on 8/28...Was acquired by Baltimore from New York-AL in exchange for LHP Zach Britton on July 24 of this season...Was originally selected by the Yankees in the 11<sup>th</sup> round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft...Has previously spent time in five levels of the Yankees organization (Short-Season A Staten Island, Class-A Charleston, Class A-Advanced Tampa, Double-A Trenton, and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre), and with Triple-A Norfolk, making a total of 68 appearances (63 starts) going 30-20 with a 3.07 ERA (30 ER/381.0 IP)...Attended University of Louisville (KY) where he played two seasons of baseball; he was selected to the 2015 All-ACC Second Team...Underwent "Tommy John" surgery in the spring of 2013.

**LAST START:** Suffered the loss his last time out on September 3 at Seattle after he allowed two runs on four hits with two walks and four strikeouts over 5.1 innings of work...Are the fewest runs and hits he's allowed in the majors...Has thrown at least 5.0 innings in each of his seven starts (between the majors and Triple-A) since joining the Orioles...Threw 80 pitches, 50 strikes.

**VS. AL EAST:** This will be Rogers' first career start against the Tampa Bay Rays, and his second career start against a divisional opponent...Made his MLB debut on August 28 against Toronto; he earned the win after tossing 5.0 innings, allowing three runs on seven hits, one home run, with one walk, and two strikeouts...This will be Rogers' first start on the road against the division.

**MLB DEBUT:** Made his Major League debut on August 28 vs. Toronto, tossing 5.0 innings, allowing three runs on seven hits, one home run, with one walk and two strikeouts...Earned the win after leaving the game with the Orioles leading 9-3...Allowed his first career home run to Justin Smoak, a two-run homer in the fifth inning...Went three up and three down in the first inning...Struck out Kevin Pillar looking in the second inning for his first career strikeout...Left-handers went 0-for-2 against him, while righties were 7-for-20...Threw 85 pitches, 54 strikes.

**LEFT-HANDER NOTES:** Rogers became the first left-hander to start for the Orioles this season when he made his debut on 8/28...Before his start, the Orioles and Cleveland Indians were the only two teams in the majors yet to start a left-hander this season...His start snapped a streak of 134 games started by right-handed pitchers for the Orioles; it ranks as the second-longest streak in the majors (Cleveland - 160), and tied for second-longest in franchise history (225 from 2001-03).

**WELCOME TO BIRDLAND:** Rogers made his organizational debut on July 28 vs. Toledo, earning the win after allowing three hits and three walks over seven shutout innings with two strikeouts...Was acquired from the New York Yankees, along with RHP Dillon Tate and RHP Cody Caroll on July 24 in exchange for LHP Zach Britton.

**TRIPLE-A NOTES:** Has made five starts for Triple-A Norfolk, going 2-1 with a 2.08 ERA (130 ER/381.0 IP), seven walks and 18 strikeouts...Made his first 19 starts of the season with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, going 6-8 with a 3.95 ERA (48 ER/109.1 IP), 36 walks and 101 strikeouts in 19 starts including one complete game and one shutout...His 24 starts were tied for third-most in the International League at the time of his promotion; also ranked fourth in innings pitched (139.2), and ninth with a 3.54 ERA (55 ER/139.2 IP).

**2017 NOTES:** Split the year between Single-A Tampa and Double-A Trenton to go 8-5 with a 3.24 ERA (33 ER/91.2 IP) across 15 starts...Made his first eight starts at Tampa, posting a 4-3 record and 2.22 ERA (13 ER/ 52.2 IP)...Was named Florida State League "Pitcher of the Week" for 4/24-30 after tossing 7.0 innings, allowing one unearned run on three hits with one walk and eight strikeouts in a win on 4/29 vs. Daytona...Was promoted to Trenton on 5/26 and was 4-2 with a 4.62 ERA (20 ER/39.0 IP over seven starts...Permitted two runs-or-fewer in nine-of-15 turns.
