LEADING OFF: 2018 represents the Angels' 58th season in the Majors and 53rd campaign in Anaheim...Halos are 30-27 overall, 18-16 at home and 12-11 on the road all-time on Opening Day...**Angels have dropped each of last four season openers (2014-17) after winning each of five previous openers (2009-13)**...Through 57 seasons, LAA holds an all-time record of 10 games over .500 at 4,557-4,547-3...**Today marks the 9,108th regular season game in team history**...A complete listing of the Club's Opening Day results and lineups can be found on page 352 of the Halo media guide.

BACK TO OAKTOWN: Today marks the sixth Opening Day meeting between the Angels and A's, tied for second-most openers vs. one opponent (CWS)...Halos have opened a club record 11 times vs. Seattle...**Angels open on the road in Oakland for second straight campaign – first time in Club annals with back to back road openers in same city**... Angels are 12-11 all-time opening on the road and 0-2 when opening in Oakland (1982 & 2017).

MARCH ON: 2018 marks the sixth time the Halos open a campaign in the month of March...Angels are 1-4 all-time in March season openers, last coming in 2014 (March 31; 10-3 loss at Seattle)...**March 29th marks the earliest Opening Day date in Club history.**

THE MANAGER: Mike Scioscia enters 2018 as the longest tenured manager in the Majors (19th season) and the only active manager to collect over 1,000 victories with current club...His current .538 (1,570-1,346) winning percentage and 1,570 wins are both tops in franchise history...**Scioscia is one of just four active managers with at least 1,500 career wins (Bochy, Baker & Showalter)**...**Scioscia ranks 22nd on the all-time managerial wins list (one victory behind Dick Williams for 21st).**

MAN ON THE MOUND: Angels have a different Opening Day starting pitcher for a fourth consecutive season (Ricky Nolasco in 2017, Garrett Richards in 2016 & Jered Weaver in 2015)...Last time Angels had different Opening Day starter in at least four straight years was 2006-09 (Bartolo Colon, John Lackey, Jered Weaver & Joe Saunders).

VS. OAKLAND: Halos claimed 2017 series 12-7 (5-5 on road) and have won five of last six meetings...LAA has won four consecutive season series vs. A's (2014-17)...Since 2013, **Mike Trout** is batting .327 (107/327) with 23 HR & 55 RBI in 86 games vs. Oakland.

START WITH A BANG: **Mike Trout** owns three career Opening Day home runs (2014-2015, 2017)...He is tied with **Joe Rudi** and **Tim Salmon** for the Angels franchise record with three career Opening Day HRs...**Ian Kinsler** ranks tied with **Bryce Harper** for most Opening Day HRs among actives with five (STATS LLC)...He has homered in each of last two seasons...**Albert Pujols** has homered four times in his career on Opening Day.

ONLY ONE: There have been 19,183 people to play Major League Baseball. Of those players, just one of them has 200 HR, 150 SB, and a .400 OBP through his first 7 seasons. His name is **Mike Trout**.

3000/600: **Albert Pujols** enters the 2018 season just 32 hits shy of 3,000...When he reaches the mark, he will become just the fourth player in MLB history with at least 3,000 knocks and 600 HRs joining **Hank Aaron, Willie Mays** and **Alex Rodriguez**.

MORE ALBERT: **Pujols** is vying to become the 32nd player all time with 3,000 hits, the sixth foreign born player to accomplish the feat and the second player to do so in an Angels' uniform (**Rod Carew** in 1985).

NEW HALOS: Angels Opening Day active roster features seven players new to the organization: **Luke Bard, Jim Johnson, Shohei Ohtani, Rene Rivera, Zack Cozart, Ian Kinsler** and **Chris Young**.

HOT SPRINGS: Several Halos posted strong numbers during Spring Training including **Zack Cozart** (.353, 4 HR, 9 RBI), **Kole Calhoun** (.353, 1 HR, 9 RBI), **Mike Trout** (.308, 3 HR, 8 RBI), **Justin Upton** (3 HR, 11 RBI), **Jose Alvarez** (1-0, 2.38), **Garrett Richards** (1-0, 2.84) and **Nick Tropeano** (2-0, 3.12)

MEMORABLE OPENING DAYS IN CLUB HISTORY:

April 6, 1973 – **Nolan Ryan** makes his first Opening Day start as an Angel, defeating Kansas City 3-2 in Anaheim with a CG and 12 strikeouts

April 6, 1977 – **Frank Tanana** hurls a complete game shutout in Angels' 7-0 win at Seattle.

April 8, 1986 – **Bobby Grich** homers on the first pitch of the season at Seattle.

April 1, 2013 – In the first interleague Opening Day game in Major League history, the Angels topped the Cincinnati Reds 3-1 in 13 innings at Great American Ball Park.

EXTRA NOTE: LAA has played extra innings on Opening Day four times in franchise history: 2013 at CIN (W, 3-1), 1986 at SEA (L, 4-8), 1982 at OAK (L, 2-3) & 1966 at CWS (L, 2-3).

LEFT FIELD TURNOVER: The 2018 season marks the seventh consecutive year the Angels have a new Opening Day starting left fielder (franchise record for LF). **Upton (2018), Maybin (2017), Nava (2016), Joyce (2015), Hamilton (2014), Trumbo (2013), Wells (2012).**

ANOTHER RECORD FOR TROUT: With a start in center field today, **Mike Trout** (2013-18) will become the first player in Angels' history to make six Opening Day starts in CF...**Club record for consecutive Opening Day starts at any position is held by Tim Salmon who made 11 consecutive starts in right field for the Halos from 1993-2003.**

OHTANI = BASEBALL RARITY: The last time a player started as a pitcher and a non-pitcher in the first 10 games of a season was 1920, when both **Joe Bush** (Red Sox) and **Clarence Mitchell** (Dodgers) started as pitchers and outfielders...Last player to start as a pitcher and a non-pitcher within the same season was **Rick Rhoden** (Yankees) in 1988 (30 starts as pitcher, one as DH). (STATS LLC).

- OPENING DAY STARTER:** Today marks second career Opening Day start...Previously got the nod on Opening Day in 2016 against the Chicago Cubs at Angel Stadium (L; 5 IP, 6 H, 3 ER, 3 BB, 7 SO)...Last year in Oakland, **Ricky Nolasco** made the start for the Angels...Prior to Richards' first Opening Day start, **Jered Weaver** made a franchise record six consecutive Opening Day starts on the mound from 2010-15.
- 2017 SPRING TRAINING:** In four Cactus League starts, went 1-0 with a 2.84 ERA (12.2 IP – 4 ER) with seven walks and 14 strikeouts...Held opposing hitters to a .190 (8/42) batting average against...Final two Spring appearances came in minor league games (March 18 & 23).
- STREAKING:** Has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in each of his last 16 starts, dating back to Sept. 19, 2015...The streak is the longest of his career (previous was 10 straight starts, Aug. 4, 2014 – May 17, 2015)...**Longest by any Angels pitcher since Mike Witt had a 21 game streak in 1981-82** (Witt and Nolan Ryan are tied for franchise record with 21).
- LOW AVERAGE:** Is tied for American League lead with a .219 (350/1601) batting average against since the start of 2014 with **Chris Sale** and **Corey Kluber**.
- ROAD WARRIOR:** In seven road starts across the last two seasons, has pitched to a 2.12 ERA (34 IP – 8 ER)...Has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in five of the seven starts.
- DIVISIONAL PLAY:** Since 2013, owns a 19-16 record and 3.32 ERA (293 IP – 108 ER) in 55 games (46 starts) vs. A.L. West opponents...The 19 wins are seventh most in the Majors in that span.
- BRINGING THE HEAT:** According to Fangraphs, ranks third among all Major Leaguers with an average fastball velocity of 96.5 MPH since the start of the 2014 season (min. 400 IP).
- VS. OAKLAND:** In 16 career games (12 starts) against the A's, is 2-4 with a 4.12 ERA (67.1 IP – 31 ER)...In two starts vs. Oakland last season, went 0-0 with a 1.12 ERA (8 IP – 1 ER)...Suffered right biceps strain in first start of year vs. A's and also made return from DL in September vs. A's...until today's return...As a starter, is 2-4 with a 4.43 ERA (63 IP – 31 ER) against the Athletics...**In last six starts vs. A's, is 2-1 with a 1.64 ERA (33 IP – 6 ER).**
- AT OAKLAND COLISEUM:** In 10 career games (eight starts) at the Coliseum, is 1-3 with a 4.08 ERA (39.2 IP – 18 ER)...Earned only win in Oakland on April 30, 2015...In two starts in Oakland last year, went 0-0 with a 1.12 ERA (8 IP – 1 ER)...Yielded 12 of his 18 career earned runs at the Coliseum in two games (7 ER on April 30, 2013 and 5 ER on May 30, 2014); Has pitched to a 1.62 ERA (33.1 IP – 6 ER) in his seven other starts at the ballpark.
- 2017 SEASON:** Exited first start of year (Apr. 5, 2017 at OAK) after five scoreless innings with right biceps strain...Missed 135 games on disabled list...Returned to Angels on Sept. 5, 2017 at OAK...Made five September starts and pitched to a 2.74 ERA (23 IP – 7 ER) for the month...Allowed one-or-fewer runs in four of six starts on the season.
- CAREER TOTALS:** In 154 career games (99 starts), is 40-34 with a 3.53 ERA (668.1 IP – 262 ER) and 558 strikeouts across seven seasons with the Angels...Since 2014, is 29-21 with a 3.06 ERA (438.1 IP – 149 ER).

LHP TYLER SKAGGS (0-0, --- ERA)

Entering sixth Major League season and fourth with Angels...Makes Opening Day roster for third time in career (also, 2014 & 2017)...In four Spring Training starts, went 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (11 IP – 11 ER) with eight walks and 13 strikeouts...Made 16 starts for Angels in 2017, going 2-6 with a 4.55 ERA (85 IP – 43 ER) with 76 strikeouts...In five career starts vs. A's, is 0-4 with a 6.26 ERA (27.1 IP – 19 ER) with 26 strikeouts.

IN THE 'PEN

#48 JOSE ALVAREZ (LHP) AGE: 28

- Entering sixth Major League season and fifth with the Angels...Makes Opening Day roster for fourth straight year.
- During Spring Training, appeared in 10 games and boasted a 2.38 ERA (11.1 IP – 3 ER)...Recorded 12 strikeouts and did not allow a home run.
- Appeared in 64 games for the Angels in 2017 going 0-3 with a 3.88 ERA (48.2 IP – 21 ER)...Set new career high with streak of 15 consecutive scoreless appearances (15.1 IP)...Stranded 29 of 35 inherited runners on the season...Stranded rate ranked sixth in the Majors among southpaws.
- Last Outing:** 3/26 @ LAD (1 IP, 1 H, 2 SO) Holds: - Saves/Opps: -

#65 LUKE BARD (RHP) AGE: 27

- First appearance will mark Major League debut...Last Angels pitcher to make MLB debut on Opening Day was **Darren O'Day** in 2008.
- Acquired from Minnesota in the Rule 5 Draft in December 2017.
- Opened 2017 season with Double-A Chattanooga and finished with Triple-A Rochester...Appeared in 41 total games...Posted combined ERA of 2.76 (65.1 IP – 20 ER)
- Last Outing:** 3/27 @ LAD (0.1 IP, 1 SO) Holds: - Saves/Opps: -

#32 CAM BEDROSIAN (RHP) AGE: 26

- Begins fifth Major League season with Angels...Earns Opening Day roster spot for third straight season.
- Pitched to an ERA of 3.52 (7.2 IP – 3 ER) in eight Spring Training games...Surrendered seven hits, two home runs, four walks and struck out 12.
- Appeared in 48 games last season, going 6-5 with a 4.43 ERA (44.2 IP – 22 ER) and six saves...Set career highs in wins, saves, games, innings pitched and strikeouts (53).
- Last Outing:** 3/26 @ LAD (1 IP, 1 H, 1 SO) Holds: - Saves/Opps: -

#33 JIM JOHNSON (RHP) AGE: 34

- Begins 13th Major League season and first with Angels...Makes his 10th Opening Day roster...Acquired from Braves in November for minor league LHP Justin Kelly.
- Was unscored upon in six of 10 Spring Training appearances.
- Appeared in 61 games for Atlanta last season, going 6-2 and ranked 9th in N.L. with 22 saves...Fourth career 20+ save season.
- Last Outing:** 3/25 vs. LAD (1 IP, 2 H, 2 ER, 1 BB) Holds: - Saves/Opps: -

#39 KEYNAN MIDDLETON (RHP) AGE: 24

- Enters second Major League season (first full) with the Angels...Makes his first career Opening Day roster.
- Six of 10 Cactus League appearances were scoreless.
- Pitched in 64 games for Angels last season, going 6-1 with three saves and a 3.86 ERA (58.1 IP – 25 ER) while striking out 63 and walking 18 in his rookie campaign.
- Last Outing:** 3/26 @ LAD (1 IP) Holds: - Saves/Opps: -

#53 BLAKE PARKER (RHP) AGE: 32

- Entering sixth Major League season and second with Angels...Makes an Opening Day roster for second time in career (also, last season with Angels).
- Recorded 11 strikeouts in 8.2 innings this Spring across nine games for Angels.
- Led Angels staff and ranked sixth in A.L. in appearances (71) last season.
- In 2017, posted a 3-3 record and eight saves with a 2.54 ERA (67.1 IP – 19 ER)...Led all Halos pitchers with an 11.5 SO/9 inning rate...His 86 strikeouts were second among Angels relievers (Yusmeiro Petit – 96).
- Last Outing:** 3/26 @ LAD (1 IP, 1 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 2 SO) Holds: - Saves/Opps: -

#25 NOÉ RAMIREZ (RHP) AGE: 28

- Enters fourth Major League season and second campaign with Angels (first full)...Makes an Opening Day roster for second time (also, 2016 with Boston).
- Appeared in 11 Spring Training games and recorded 14 strikeouts in 12.1 innings.
- Between Red Sox and Angels in 2017, appeared in 12 total games and earned a 2.77 ERA (13.0 IP – 4 ER)...Only allowed six hits and recorded 14 strikeouts...Pitched to a 2.16 ERA (8.1 IP – 2 ER) in his 10 September outings for Angels after being claimed off waivers from Boston on Aug. 18, 2017.
- Last Outing:** 3/25 vs. LAD (1 IP, 1 H) Holds: - Saves/Opps: -

#46 BLAKE WOOD (RHP) AGE: 32

- Enters seventh Major League season and second with Angels (first full).
- Made 10 Spring appearances and allowed seven earned runs in 9.1 innings.
- Between Reds and Angels last season, appeared in 72 games, going 3-4 with a 5.45 ERA (74.1 IP – 45 ER) while striking out 84 batters.
- Was not charged with a run in 13 of 17 appearances for Angels last season after being acquired from Cincinnati on Aug. 25, 2017.

AGE: 29

- Makes fifth Opening Day Roster and fifth Opening Day start in right field...Is the first Angel right fielder to make five consecutive Opening Day starts since Vladimir Guerrero (2004-08)...The last Angel to make more consecutive Opening Day starts in right field was Tim Salmon (1993-03)...In 2014, became the club's first home grown Opening Day right fielder since Tim Salmon in 2003.
- Hits in four of five career Opening Day outings (2017, 2016 & 2014).
- **Posted a .353 (18/51) average with a home run and nine RBI in 20 spring games.**
- Hit .303 (24/79) with three doubles, two triples and eight RBI against Oakland in 2017...Made Major League debut in Oakland May 22, 2012.
- In 2017, appeared in 155 games for the third consecutive year...Drew a career-high 71 walks while 19 home runs marked second most of career.

#7 ZACK COZART (INF)

AGE: 32

- Entering eighth big league season (seventh full) and first as an Angel...Spent first seven big league seasons with the Cincinnati Reds...Signed as a free agent Dec. 15, 2017.
- Owns a .273 (6/22) average in Opening Day games, including a 4-for-8 showing with two doubles over the last two season openers (both vs. Philadelphia).
- **During seven-year big league career, has only defensively appeared at shortstop (721 games)...**With an Opening Day start at third, would become the eighth different third baseman to start for the Halos on Opening Day since 2009 (Escobar, Freese, Callaspo, Trumbo, Izturis, Wood, Figgins).
- **Hit .353 (18/51) with a team leading four home runs and nine RBI in 20 spring games.**
