LEADING OFF: 2018 represents the Angels' 58th MLB season and 53rd campaign in Anaheim...Halos are now 30-28 overall, 18-16 at home and 12-12 on the road all-time on Opening Day...Angels have now dropped each of last five season openers (2014-18) after winning each of five previous openers (2009-13)...LAA looking to avoid an 0-2 start for the third time in five seasons (0-2 in 2016 and 0-3 in 2014)...Angels were 1-1 after two games to start season last year in Oakland...LAA holds an all-time record of nine games over .500 at 4,557-4,548-3...Tonight marks the 9,109th regular season game in team history.

FOR OPENERS:

- Shohei Ohtani joins Hideki Matsui, Kaz Matsui, Tsuyoshi Shinjo and Kosuke Fukudome as Japanese-born players with a hit on Opening Day in their first MLB at-bat.
- LAA had three players (Calhoun, Cozart & Maldonado) post three hits apiece on Opening Day for first time in Club history...Angels also matched a team record with 3 HRs on Opening Day (Pujols, Cozart, Calhoun) - 6th time.
- Albert Pujols hit his 5th career Opening Day HR to tie lan Kinsler & Bryce Harper for MLB lead among actives.
- LAA has now played extra innings on Opening Day five times: 2018 at OAK (L, 5-6), 2013 at CIN (W, 3-1), 1986 at SEA (L, 4-8), 1982 at OAK (L, 2-3) & 1966 at CWS (L, 2-3).
- Kole Calhoun joins Dave Parker (1991) as only Angels with a triple and a home run on Opening Day.
- Zack Cozart is first Angel to homer in his Halo debut on Opening Day since Hideki Matsui in 2010.

BACK TO OAKTOWN: Yesterday marked the sixth Opening Day meeting between the Angels and A's, tied for secondmost openers vs. one opponent (CWS)...Halos have opened a club record 11 times vs. Seattle... Angels open on the road in Oakland for second straight campaign - first time in Club annals with back to back road openers in same city...Angels are 12-12 all-time opening on the road and now 0-3 when opening in Oakland (1982 & 2017-18).

MARCH ON: 2018 marks the sixth time the Halos open a campaign in the month of March...Angels are 1-5 all-time in March season openers, last coming in 2014 (March 31; 10-3 loss at Seattle)...March 29th marks the earliest Opening Day date in Club history...Tonight marks the first time in Club history to play a second regular season game in the month of March.

THE MANAGER: Mike Scioscia is the longest tenured manager in the Majors (19th season) and the only active manager to collect over 1,000 victories with current club...His current .538 (1,570-1,347) winning percentage and 1,570 wins are both tops in franchise history... Scioscia is one of just four active managers with at least 1,500 career wins (Bochy, Baker & Showalter)... Scioscia ranks 22ndon the all-time managerial wins list (one victory behind Dick Williams for 21st).

VS. OAKLAND: Halos claimed 2017 series 12-7 (5-5 on road) and have won five of last seven meetings...LAA has won four consecutive season series vs. A's (2014-17)...Since 2013, Mike Trout is batting .321 (107/333) with 23 HR & 55 RBI in 87 games vs. Oakland.

ONLY ONE: There have been 19,183 people to play Maior League Baseball. Of those players, just one of them has 200 HR, 150 SB, and a .400 OBP through his first seven seasons. His name is Mike Trout.

3000/600: Albert Pujols is 30 hits shy of 3,000...When he reaches the mark, he will become just the fourth player in MLB history with at least 3,000 knocks and 600 HRs joining Hank Aaron, Willie Mays and Alex Rodriguez.

MORE ALBERT: Pujols is vying to become the 32nd player all time with 3,000 hits, the sixth foreign born player to accomplish the feat and the second player to do so in an Angels' uniform (Rod Carew in 1985).

<u>NEW HALOS:</u> Angels Opening Day active roster features seven players new to the organization: Luke Bard, Jim Johnson, Shohei Ohtani, Rene Rivera, Zack Cozart, Ian Kinsler and Chris Young.

HOT SPRINGS: Several Halos posted strong numbers during Spring Training including **Zack Cozart** (.353, 4 HR, 9 RBI), **Kole** Calhoun (.353, 1 HR, 9 RBI), Mike Trout (.308, 3 HR, 8 RBI), Justin Upton (3 HR, 11 RBI), Jose Alvarez (1-0, 2.38), Garrett Richards (1-0, 2.84) and Nick Tropeano (2-0, 3.12)

LEFT FIELD TURNOVER: The 2018 season marks the seventh consecutive year the Angels have a new Opening Day starting left fielder (franchise record for LF). Upton (2018), Maybin (2017), Nava (2016), Joyce (2015), Hamilton (2014), Trumbo (2013), Wells (2012).

ANOTHER RECORD FOR TROUT: With a start in center field yesterday, Mike Trout (2013-18) is the first player in Angels' history to make six Opening Day starts in CF...Club record for consecutive Opening Day starts at any position is held by Tim Salmon who made 11 consecutive starts in right field for the Halos from 1993-2003.

OHTANI = BASEBALL RARITY: The last time a player started as a pitcher and a non-pitcher in the first 10 games of a season was 1920, when both Joe Bush (Red Sox) and Clarence Mitchell (Dodgers) started as pitchers and outfielders...Last player to start as a pitcher and a non-pitcher within the same season was Rick Rhoden (Yankees) in 1988 (30 starts as pitcher, one as DH). - EARLY SUCCESS: In 10 career regular season starts during March/April, is 3-1 with a 3.64 ERA (64.1 IP 26 ER) and 51 strikeouts...The 3.64 ERA is his best ERA for any month.
- VS. OAKLAND: In five career starts against the Athletics, is 0-4 with a 6.26 ERA (27.1 IP 19 ER)...In his three starts against the A's last season, was 0-3 with a 6.26 ERA (27.1 IP - 11 ER).
- AT OAKLAND COLISEUM: In three career starts at the Coliseum, is 0-3 with a 6.23 ERA (17.1 IP 12 ER)...Last year went 0-2 with a 6.35 ERA (11.1 IP - 8 ER) in his two starts in Oakland.
- **COMMUNITY SPOTLIGHT**: During the offseason, represented Angels at the annual Kids Holiday Party event for the Angels Baseball Foundation at the ESPN Zone in Downtown Disney.
