### CHICAGO WHITE SOX (4-8) at OAKLAND A'S (6-10)

#### WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost six of their last seven games and eight of 10 as they continue a scheduled seven-game trip tonight in Oakland ... RHP Reynaldo López, who leads the American League with a 0.69 ERA, takes the mound for the White Sox.
- The Sox have not played since opening the trip with a 4-0 loss at Minnesota on Thursday ... each of their scheduled games last weekend at Target Field were postponed by snow (see below).
- Following this three-game series at the Oakland Coliseum and an off day on Thursday, the White Sox return home for six games vs. Houston (4/20-22) and Seattle (4/23-25).
- The Sox went 1-5 on their last homestand vs. Detroit (0-3) and Tampa Bay (1-2) and 3-2 on their first trip to Kansas City (2-0) and Toronto (1-2).

#### TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- According to Elias, the White Sox have been postponed in three consecutive games for the first time since 9/12-13/08 (one was a makeup game).
- The Sox are 8-3 in their last 11 games in Oakland after losing their previous seven.
- Chicago ranks second in the American League with 14 home runs on the road (three at home).
- The White Sox are 3-47 (.064) with RISP over the last six games, leaving 49 runners on base in that span.
- José Abreu is a career .307/.377/.594 hitter with eight home runs and 21 RBI in 26 games vs. Oakland.

#### SMITH ON REHAB

- The White Sox have sent C Kevan Smith to Class AAA Charlotte on an injury rehab assignment.
- Smith, 28, was placed on the 10-day disabled list on 3/28 (retro to 3/26) with a sprained left ankle ... he batted .283 (78-286) with four home runs and 30 RBI over 87 games with the Sox in 2017.

#### SNOW DAYS

- According to Elias, Chicago and Minnesota's three straight postponements over the weekend are the most in the major leagues since Seattle and Cleveland endured four in a row in April 2007.
- The Sox-Twins game scheduled for 4/13 will be made up on 6/5 as part of a straight doubleheader beginning at 3:10 p.m. CT ... Jackie Robinson Day, which was celebrated yesterday across the major leagues, has been moved to the opener of the twinbill on 6/5 ... both clubs will wear jerseys with the No. 42.
- Saturday's postponement has been rescheduled for 9/28 as part of a split doubleheader (1:10 p.m. and 7:10 p.m. starts) ... yesterday's postponement will be made up on 8/20 at 6:10 p.m., which previously was a mutual off day.

#### THURSDAY'S RECAP

- The White Sox were limited to three hits and struck out 13 times in a 4-0 loss at Minnesota.
- Lucas Giolito suffered the loss, allowing four runs (three earned) on five hits and a career-high five walks over 6.1 IP.
- Only one Sox baserunner (José Abreu in the ninth inning) reached second base.

#### LÓPEZ MAKES SOX HISTORY

- RHP Reynaldo López has become the first pitcher in White Sox history to throw 6.0-plus IP with two or fewer hits allowed and one or no earned runs allowed in each of his first two starts of a season (Elias).
- López matched his career high with 7.0 IP in his last start on 4/8 vs. Tampa Bay, giving one unearned run to lower his season ERA to a major-league leading 0.69 (1 ER/13.0 IP).
- He became the first Sox starting pitcher since at least 1908 to lose a game in which he threw 7.0-plus IP while allowing two or less hits and one run which was unearned (sources: Baseball Reference and STATS LLC).
- López, who was acquired from Washington on 12/7/16 with RHPs Dane Dunning and Lucas Giolito, has thrown at least 6.0 IP in each of his last eight starts dating back to last season.

#### YESTERDAY ON THE FARM

- LHP Ian Clarkin threw a complete-game, five-hitter (7.0 IP) to lead Class AA Birmingham to a 2-1 victory vs. Montgomery in game one of a doubleheader.
- Clarkin, rated by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in the White Sox system, improved to 2-0 with a 0.73 ERA (1 ER/12.1 IP) over two starts this season.
- Clarkin, 23, was acquired from the Yankees on 7/18/17 as part of a seven-player deal.

#### WHITE SOX VS. OAKLAND

- The White Sox were 1-5 in 2017 (0-3 at home and 1-2 on the road) for their first losing record against Oakland since 2013.
- The A's three-game sweep on 6/23-25 was their first at Guaranteed Rate Field since 2005.
- The Sox batted .234 (47-201) with a 5.33 ERA (31 ER/52.1 IP) and were outscored, 34-22.
- Chicago has won eight of the last 11 games in Oakland.
- The White Sox are 287-307 all-time, going 149-146 at home (61-64 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 138-161 on the road.

#### WILD WILD WEST

- The White Sox went 15-18 against the American League West in 2018 (7-10 on the road), winning nine of their last 14 games after losing 13 of their first 19.
- The Sox are 178-154 vs. the AL West since 2008, including a 76-89 record on the road.

#### ABREU IN ELITE COMPANY

- José Abreu is one of three players in major-league history to begin his career with at least four consecutive seasons of 25-plus homers and 100-plus RBI, joining Hall-of-Famer Joe DiMaggio (1936-41) and Albert Pujols.
- Abreu also has joined Al Simmons (11, 1924-34), Pujols (10, 2001-10), Ted Williams (1939-42, '46-49) and DiMaggio (1936-42) as the only players in history to record 100 or more RBI in each of his first four seasons.
- He led the American League with 343 total bases in 2017, joining Albert Belle (399 in 1998), Minnie Miñoso (304 in 1951) and Joe Jackson (293 in 1916) as the only players in Sox history to accomplish that feat.

#### AT THE HELM

- Rick Renteria is in his second season after being named the 40th manager in White Sox history on 10/3/16.
- Renteria was the only Latino manager in the major leagues in 2017 but has been joined by Boston's Alex Cora and Washington's Dave Martinez in 2018.
- He was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (20th overall) of the 1980 draft ... Cleveland manager Terry Francona (22nd), Oakland executive vice president of baseball operations Billy Beane (23rd) and Toronto manager John Gibbons (24th) were selected in succession later in the first round of that draft.

#### QUALITY IS JOB ONE

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,320 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, five more than the Mets and 48 more than Oakland, the next-closest American League team.

#### ROSTER QUICK FACTS

- The Sox 25-man roster includes 13 pitchers (two LHP), two catchers, six infielders and four outfielders ... LHP Aaron Bummer, OF Nicky Delmonico, OF Adam Engel, RHP Carson Fulmer, RHP Lucas Giolito, RHP Reynaldo López and INF Yoán Moncada made their first career Opening Day roster.

#### HAWK'S FAREWELL

- Ken "Hawk" Harrelson, who is in his 33rd and final season in the White Sox television booth in 2018, will work primarily Sunday home games this season as well as select other contests.
- Harrelson will serve the organization as a team ambassador throughout the 2019 season, which will mark the beginning of his eighth decade in baseball.

#### CALL TO THE HALL

- Jim Thome, who played for the White Sox from 2006-09 and serves as a special assistant to the general manager, will be inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame on 7/29/18.
- Thome, who ranks eighth in major-league history with 612 home runs, received 89.8 percent of the votes to become the fifth former Sox player inducted on the first ballot.
- He will join Chipper Jones, Vladimir Guerrero, Trevor Hoffman, Jack Morris and Alan Trammell in the Class of 2018.

#### PROSPECT PROWESS

- The White Sox minor-league system is rated by *Baseball America* as the fourth-best in baseball.
- The Sox organization features five of *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects: OF Eloy Jiménez (No. 4), RHP Michael Kopech (No. 11), RHP Alec Hansen (No. 57), OF Luis Robert (No. 58) and RHP Dane Dunning (No. 82) ... Jiménez (No. 4), Kopech (No. 10), Robert (No. 28), Hansen (No. 54), RHP Dylan Cease (No. 71), Dunning (No. 92) and OF Blake Rutherford (No. 99) are ranked in MLB.com's Top 100.

#### ON THIS DATE ... 2005

In a game that lasted just 1:39, the White Sox defeated Seattle, 2-1, behind a complete-game effort from LHP Mark Buehrle and a pair of solo home runs from Paul Konerko ... Buehrle allowed three hits and struck out a career-high 12 in what was the fastest game in the majors since 9/30/84 when Atlanta beat San Diego at home (also 1:39).

### LÓPEZ AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his third start of the 2018 season and first career against the Oakland Athletics.
- Went 3-0 with a 4.62 ERA (13 ER/25.1 IP) over his final four starts of 2017 ... made his White Sox debut on 8/11/17 vs. Kansas City, receiving a no decision after allowing two runs with six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Was named the White Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July after posting a 2.10 ERA (7 ER/30.0 IP) with 38 strikeouts and a .183 (20-109) opponents average over five starts.
- Was acquired from Washington with RHPs Dane Dunning and Lucas Giolito in exchange for OF Adam Eaton on 12/7/16 ... originally was signed by the Nationals as a non-drafted free agent on 6/21/12.

### LAST START

- Suffered his first loss of the season after allowing one run on two hits with five walks and five strikeouts over 7.0 IP.
- Surrendered the lone run off a RBI single by Miguel Cabrera in the first ... departed with the Sox trailing 1-0 after tossing 91 pitches (55 strikes) ... the Sox lost 1-0.

### MAKING HISTORY

- Is the first White Sox pitcher with 6.0-plus IP, two-or-fewer hits allowed, and one-or-fewer runs allowed in each of his first two starts of the season (source: Elias).
- Became the first White Sox starting pitcher since at least 1908 to lose a game in which he thre 7.0-plus IP while allowing two or less hits and one run which was unearned (source: Baseball Reference and STATS LLC) ... the last five pitchers to accomplish this feat:

### SPRING 2018 RECAP

- Started five games in the Cactus League, going 1-2 with a 3.86 ERA (8 ER/18.2 IP).
- Went 1-0 with a 0.96 ERA (1 ER/9.1 IP) over his first three starts, compared to a 0-2 with a 6.75 ERA (7 ER/9.1 IP) in his last two starts.

### 2017 REVIEW

- Made eight starts with the White Sox in his first season with the organization ... went 1-2 with a 3.56 ERA (12 ER/30.0 IP) in five starts at home and 2-1 with a 6.75 mark (13 ER/17.1 IP) over three road starts.
- Five of his seven starts were quality ... went 2-2 with a 3.15 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts in those outings.
- Worked a career-high tying 7.0 IP (four runs) in a win on 9/16 at Detroit ... allowed three runs in the second inning before limiting the Tigers to one run on five hits over his final 5.0 IP.
- Suffered his first loss with the White Sox on 8/17 at Texas, allowing six runs on five hits over 4.1 IP before exiting game with soreness on his right side.
- Was placed on the disabled list on 8/19 (retro to 8/18) with a back strain ... reinstated on 9/1, made the start that night vs. Tampa Bay (L; 3 ER/6.0 IP).
- Made 22 starts with Class AAA Charlotte, going 6-7 with a 3.79 ERA (51 ER/121.0 IP) and 131 strikeouts ... allowed two earned runs or less in seven of his final eight starts from 6/29-8/6 before being promoted.
- Entered the season ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 3 Prospect in the White Sox organization and No. 31 in baseball ... was rated by MLB.com as the No. 4 Prospect in the Sox system, No. 38 in baseball and the No. 9 right-handed pitching prospect.

### MINOR-LEAGUE CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Was named the White Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July 2017 after posting a 2.10 ERA (7 ER/30.0 IP) with 38 strikeouts and a .183 (20-109) opponents average over five starts.
- Has gone 25-26 with a 3.72 ERA (159 ER/428.2 IP) and 434 strikeouts in 83 games (78 starts) over six minor-league seasons between the White Sox and Nationals organizations.
- Struck out 10-plus batters on four occasions in 2017: 4/11 at Durham (10 SO/5.1 IP), 6/29 vs. Columbus (11 SO/6.2 IP), 7/16 vs. Gwinnett (12 SO/7.0 IP) and 7/26 vs. Columbus (10 SO/5.0 IP).
- Named 2015 Carolina League Pitcher of the Week for 8/10-16 after striking out 11 over 7.0 scoreless IP on 8/12 vs. Winston-Salem ... in 2014 was named the New York-Penn League Pitcher of the Week from 6/23-29 after throwing 5.2 scoreless IP with eight strikeouts on 6/23 vs. Batavia.

### PERSONAL NOTES

- His grandfather sold two cows in the Dominican Republic to buy him a used glove, a pair of cleats and an aluminum bat when he started playing baseball.

### ON THE ROAD AGAIN

- Is making his ninth career start on the road ... has gone 4-3 with a 5.03 ERA (27 ER/48.1 IP), 43 strikeouts and a .258 (48-186) opponents average in eight starts.

### VS. AMERICAN LEAGUE WEST

- Is making his first career start against the American League West.

### TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- RHP Miguel González (0-2, 8.68 ERA) is scheduled to make his third start of the season and first against the Oakland Athletics.
- Suffered his second loss of the season on 4/9 vs. Tampa Bay ... surrendered four runs on eight hits, and two walks over 4.1 IP.
- Combined to go 8-13 with a 4.62 ERA (80 ER/156.0 IP) and 100 strikeouts in 27 starts between the White Sox and the Rangers in the 2017 season.
- Is scheduled to make his sixth career start against Oakland and fourth at Oakland Coliseum ... is 0-3 with a 4.11 ERA (14 ER/ 30.2 IP) and 24 strikeouts lifetime and 0-2 with a 4.32 ERA (8 ER/16.2 IP) at Oakland Coliseum.
