WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The White Sox have lost seven of their last eight games and nine of 11 as they continue a scheduled seven-game trip tonight in Oakland ... RHP Miguel González takes the mound for the Sox, who are 0-2 with three postponed games on the trip.
- Following three consecutive postponements last weekend at Minnesota, the White Sox resumed the road trip last night with an 8-1 loss to the A's.
- Following this three-game series at the Oakland Coliseum and an off day on Thursday, the Sox return home for six games vs. Houston (4/20-22) and Seattle (4/23-25).
- The White Sox went 1-5 on their last homestand vs. Detroit (0-3) and Tampa Bay (1-2), and 3-2 on their first trip to Kansas City (2-0) and Toronto (1-2).

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox and A's will wear 1968 uniforms to commemorate the 50th anniversary of Oakland's first home game.
- The Sox are 0-15 with RISP over the last three games and 3-52 (.058) over the last seven, leaving 54 runners on base in that span.
- White Sox starting pitchers have issued 41 walks this season, the most in the American League and tied with San Diego for second-most in the majors behind Colorado (44).
- Chicago ranks second in the AL with 15 home runs on the road (three at home).
- José Abreu is a career .305/.373/.610 hitter with nine home runs and 22 RBI in 27 games vs. Oakland.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- The White Sox suffered an 8-1 loss at Oakland in their first game in four days.
- Reynaldo López took the loss despite holding the A's to two runs on four hits with 10 strikeouts over 6.0 IP ... López made his third straight quality start to open the season and fanned 10-plus batters for the second time in his career (11 on 8/18/16 at Atlanta).
- Luis Avilán (0.0 IP) and Chris Volstad (0.1) each gave up three runs in relief.
- José Abreu ended Oakland's shutout bid with a solo homer (No. 4) off Daniel Mengden leading off the ninth inning.
- The White Sox committed a season-high four errors (three in the seventh) and were hitless (0-5) with RISP for the third consecutive game.

RYAN CORDELL UPDATE

- Class AAA Charlotte OF Ryan Cordell is expected to miss a minimum of eight weeks after suffering a fractured right clavicle during the third inning of last night's loss vs. Rochester.
- Cordell, who was acquired from Milwaukee on 7/26/17 in exchange for RHP Anthony Swarzak, will not require surgery.

ADOLFO HONORED

- Class A Winston-Salem OF Micker Adolfo has been named Carolina League Player of the Week for the period of 4/5-15.
- Adolfo, 21, hit .395 (17-43) with five doubles, two home runs and 10 RBI over 11 games to earn his first career weekly honor.
- Adolfo, the No. 10 prospect in the Sox organization according to MLB Pipeline, ranks among the CL leaders in average (.370), slugging percentage (.609), hits (T2nd, 17), doubles (T2nd, 5), OPS (3rd, 1.029) and RBI (T4th, 10).

ON THE FARM

- Class A Winston-Salem RHP Dane Dunning struck out seven batters over 6.0 IP last night at Down East to up his season total to a Carolina League-leading 23.
- Dunning, ranked by MLB Pipeline as the No. 6 prospect in the Sox organization, is 1-1 with a 2.60 ERA (5 ER/17.1 IP), two walks and 23 strikeouts over three starts this season ... he is averaging 11.9 strikeouts per 9.0 IP with an 11.5 SO/BB ratio.

SNOW DAYS

- According to Elias, Chicago and Minnesota's three straight postponements last weekend are the most in the major leagues since Seattle and Cleveland endured four in a row in April 2007.
- The Sox-Twins game scheduled for 4/13 will be made up on 6/5 as part of a straight doubleheader beginning at 3:10 p.m. CT ... Jackie Robinson Day, which was celebrated yesterday across the major leagues, has been moved to the opener of the twinbill on 6/5 ... both clubs will wear jerseys with the No. 42.
- Saturday's postponement has been rescheduled for 9/28 as part of a split doubleheader (1:10 p.m. and 7:10 p.m. starts) ... yesterday's postponement will be made up on 8/20 at 6:10 p.m., which previously was a mutual off day.

WHITE SOX VS. OAKLAND

- The A's lead the season series, 1-0.
- The White Sox were 1-5 in 2017 (0-3 at home and 1-2 on the road) for their first losing record against Oakland since 2013.
- The Sox batted .234 (47-201) with a 5.33 ERA (31 ER/52.1 IP) and were outscored, 34-22.
- Chicago has won eight of the last 12 games in Oakland.
- The White Sox are 287-308 all-time, going 149-146 at home (61-64 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 138-162 on the road.

WILD WILD WEST

- The White Sox went 15-18 against the American League West in 2018 (7-10 on the road), winning nine of their last 14 games after losing 13 of their first 19.
- The Sox are 178-155 vs. the AL West since 2008, including a 76-90 record on the road.

SMITH ON REHAB

- C Kevan Smith went 2-4 with a double last night vs. Rochester in his first game with Class AAA Charlotte on an injury rehab assignment ... Smith, 28, has been on the 10-day disabled list since 3/28 (retro to 3/26) with a sprained left ankle.

QUALITY IS JOB ONE

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,321 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, five more than the Mets and 48 more than Oakland, the next-closest American League team.

ABREU IN ELITE COMPANY

- José Abreu is one of three players in major-league history to begin his career with at least four consecutive seasons of 25-plus homers and 100-plus RBI, joining Hall-of-Famer Joe DiMaggio (1936-41) and Albert Pujols.
- Abreu also has joined Al Simmons (11, 1924-34), Pujols (10, 2001-10), Ted Williams (1939-42, '46-49) and DiMaggio (1936-42) as the only players in history to record 100 or more RBI in each of his first four seasons.
- He led the American League with 343 total bases in 2017, joining Albert Belle (399 in 1998), Minnie Miñoso (304 in 1951) and Joe Jackson (293 in 1916) as the only players in Sox history to accomplish that feat.

AT THE HELM

- Rick Renteria is in his second season after being named the 40th manager in White Sox history on 10/3/16.
- Renteria was the only Latino manager in the major leagues in 2017 but has been joined by Boston's Alex Cora and Washington's Dave Martinez in 2018.

ROSTER QUICK FACTS

- The Sox 25-man roster includes 13 pitchers (two LHP), two catchers, six infielders and four outfielders ... LHP Aaron Bummer, OF Nicky Delmonico, OF Adam Engel, RHP Carson Fulmer, RHP Lucas Giolito, RHP Reynaldo López and INF Yoán Moncada made their first career Opening Day roster.

HAWK'S FAREWELL

- Ken "Hawk" Harrelson, who is in his 33rd and final season in the White Sox television booth in 2018, will work primarily Sunday home games this season as well as select other contests.
- Harrelson will serve the organization as a team ambassador throughout the 2019 season, which will mark the beginning of his eighth decade in baseball.

CALL TO THE HALL

- Jim Thome, who played for the White Sox from 2006-09 and serves as a special assistant to the general manager, will be inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame on 7/29/18.
- Thome, who ranks eighth in major-league history with 612 home runs, received 89.8 percent of the votes to become the fifth former Sox player inducted on the first ballot.
- He will join Chipper Jones, Vladimir Guerrero, Trevor Hoffman Jack Morris and Alan Trammell in the Class of 2018.

PROSPECT PROWESS

- The White Sox minor-league system is rated by *Baseball America* as the fourth-best in baseball.
- The Sox organization features five of *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects: OF Eloy Jiménez (No. 4), RHP Michael Kopech (No. 11), RHP Alec Hansen (No. 57), OF Luis Robert (No. 58) and RHP Dane Dunning (No. 82) ... Jiménez (No. 4), Kopech (No. 10), Robert (No. 28), Hansen (No. 54), RHP Dylan Cease (No. 71), Dunning (No. 92) and OF Blake Rutherford (No. 99) are ranked in MLB.com's Top 100.

Luis Aparicio makes his major-league debut with the White Sox, going 1-3 vs. Cleveland ... Aparicio goes on to win AL Rookie of the Year honors and is inducted in the Baseball Hall of Fame in 1984 ... Don Drysdale (Dodgers) and Frank Robinson (Orioles) also make their debuts that day, marking the first time that three future Hall-of-Famers have played their first MLB game on the same day.
