WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost three straight games, eight of their last nine and 10 of 12 as they conclude a scheduled seven-game trip this afternoon in Oakland.
- RHP Carson Fulmer takes the mound for the White Sox, who are off to their worst 14-game start since 1997 (also 4-10).
- The Sox are 0-3 on this trip to Minnesota (0-1, three postponements) and Oakland (0-2), including a 10-2 loss last night.
- Following today's game and a day off tomorrow, the Sox return home for six games vs. Houston (4/20-22) and Seattle (4/23-25).
- The White Sox went 1-5 on their last homestand vs. Detroit (0-3) and Tampa Bay (1-2), and 3-2 on their first trip to Kansas City (2-0) and Toronto (1-2).

TODAY'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox are looking to avoid their first three-game sweep at the Oakland Coliseum since 5/31-6/2/13.
- The Sox are 1-7 in their last eight games against Oakland.
- The White Sox are hitting .199 (51-256) with 15 runs scored over their last eight games ... they are 5-62 (.081) with RISP during that span, leaving 62 runners on base.
- Sox starting pitchers have issued 43 walks this season, the most in the American League and fourth-most in the majors.
- Chicago has hit 16 of its 19 home runs this season on the road, second-most in the AL.
- José Abreu is a career .303/.369/.596 hitter with nine home runs and 22 RBI in 28 games vs. Oakland.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Oakland scored five runs in the first inning and went on to hand the White Sox a 10-2 defeat in front of 46,028 fans.
- Miguel González suffered the loss, allowing eight runs on eight hits over 3.0 IP to fall to 0-3 with a 12.41 ERA (17 ER/12.1 IP) over three starts this season.
- Héctor Santiago (2.0 IP), Joakim Soria (1.0) and Nate Jones (1.0) each made scoreless relief appearances.
- Yoán Moncada reached base safely three times and broke up Oakland's shutout bid with a two-run homer (No. 2) off Ryan Dull in the eighth.
- The Sox went 2-10 with RISP, left eight runners on base and struck out a season-high tying 14 times.

PROGRAMMING NOTES

- The White Sox-Twins game scheduled for 4/13 will be made up on 6/5 as part of a straight doubleheader beginning at 3:10 p.m. CT ... both games will air on NBCSCH.
- Saturday's postponement has been rescheduled for 9/28 as part of a split doubleheader (1:10 p.m. and 7:10 p.m. starts) ... WGN will carry the opener and NBCSCH the nightcap.
- Sunday's postponement will be made up on 8/20 (previously a mutual off day) at 6:10 p.m., with NBCSCH carrying the game.
- According to Elias, Chicago and Minnesota's three straight postponements last weekend are the most in the major leagues since Seattle and Cleveland endured four in a row in April 2007.

ON THIS DATE ... 2007

- Mark Buehrle threw the 16th no-hitter in White Sox history in a 6-0 victory against the Texas Rangers at U.S. Cellular Field.
- Buehrle walked one, struck out eight and faced the minimum 27 batters in the Sox first no-hitter in Chicago since Joel Horlen on 9/10/67 vs. Detroit ... he retired the first 13 batters before issuing a walk to Sammy Sosa, who he then picked off first base.
- In addition to Sosa, the Rangers lineup featured Kenny Lofton, Ian Kinsler, Michael Young, Mark Teixeira and Nelson Cruz.
- Buehrle threw 106 pitches in a game that lasted 2:03 ... he later recorded the 18th perfect game in major-league history and second in White Sox history on 7/23/09 vs. Tampa Bay.

NO RISP, NO REWARD

- The White Sox rank 29th in the major leagues with a .1583 (19-120) average with runners in scoring position this season, ahead of only San Francisco (.1579).
- The Sox are 2-25 (.080) with RISP over the last four games and 5-62 (.081) over the last eight, leaving 62 runners on base in that span.

ON THE FARM

- C Kevan Smith (sprained left ankle) went 2-5 with two RBI last night in his second injury rehab game with Class AAA Charlotte.
- Class A Winston-Salem OF Luis Basabe is hitting .353/.411/.627 (18-51) with four doubles, two triples, two home runs, 10 RBI and eight runs scored in 12 games this season.
- Basabe, the No. 14 prospect in the Sox organization per MLB Pipeline, is 16-40 (.400) over his last nine contests.

WHITE SOX VS. OAKLAND

- The A's lead the season series, 2-0.
- The White Sox are batting .215/.261/.323 (14-65) with a 9.00 ERA (16 ER/16.0 IP) and have been outscored, 18-3.
- The Sox were 1-5 in 2017 (0-3 at home and 1-2 on the road) for their first losing record against Oakland since 2013.
- The White Sox are 287-309 all-time, going 149-146 at home (61-64 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 138-163 on the road.

WILD WILD WEST

- The White Sox are 0-2 vs. the American League West in 2018 ... they went 15-18 last season (7-10 on the road), winning nine of their last 14 games after losing 13 of their first 19.
- The Sox are 178-156 vs. the AL West since 2008, including a 76-90 record on the road.

QUALITY IS JOB ONE

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,321 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, four more than the Mets and 47 more than Oakland, the next-closest American League team.
- The Sox are tied for sixth in the American League with six quality starts in 2017.

ABREU IN ELITE COMPANY

- José Abreu is one of three players in major-league history to begin his career with at least four consecutive seasons of 25-plus homers and 100-plus RBI, joining Hall-of-Famer Joe DiMaggio (1936-41) and Albert Pujols.
- Abreu also has joined Al Simmons (11, 1924-34), Pujols (10, 2001-10), Ted Williams (1939-42, '46-49) and DiMaggio (1936-42) as the only players in history to record 100 or more RBI in each of his first four seasons.
- He led the American League with 343 total bases in 2017, joining Albert Belle (399 in 1998), Minnie Miñoso (304 in 1951) and Joe Jackson (293 in 1916) as the only players in Sox history to accomplish that feat.

AT THE HELM

- Rick Renteria is in his second season after being named the 40th manager in White Sox history on 10/3/16.
- Renteria was the only Latino manager in the major leagues in 2017 but has been joined by Boston's Alex Cora and Washington's Dave Martinez in 2018.

HAWK'S FAREWELL

- Ken "Hawk" Harrelson, who is in his 33rd and final season in the White Sox television booth in 2018, will work primarily Sunday home games this season as well as select other contests.
- Harrelson will serve the organization as a team ambassador throughout the 2019 season, which will mark the beginning of his eighth decade in baseball.

CALL TO THE HALL

- Jim Thome, who played for the White Sox from 2006-09 and serves as a special assistant to the general manager, will be inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame on 7/29/18.
- Thome, who ranks eighth in major-league history with 612 home runs, received 89.8 percent of the votes to become the fifth former Sox player inducted on the first ballot.
- He will join Chipper Jones, Vladimir Guerrero, Trevor Hoffman, Jack Morris and Alan Trammell in the Class of 2018.

PROSPECT PROWESS

- The White Sox minor-league system is rated by *Baseball America* as the fourth-best in baseball.
- The Sox organization features five of *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects: OF Eloy Jiménez (No. 4), RHP Michael Kopech (No. 11), RHP Alec Hansen (No. 57), OF Luis Robert (No. 58) and RHP Dane Dunning (No. 82) ... Jiménez (No. 4), Kopech (No. 10), Robert (No. 28), Hansen (No. 54), RHP Dylan Cease (No. 71), Dunning (No. 92) and OF Blake Rutherford (No. 99) are ranked in MLB.com's Top 100.

ON DECK: HOUSTON ASTROS

- The White Sox open a six-game homestand on Friday night against the defending World Champion Houston Astros.
- RHP James Shields (1-0, 4.15) is scheduled to start the series opener ... Shields is 2-2 with a 2.11 ERA (10 ER/42.2 IP) and 51 strikeouts in six career starts against the Astros.
- The Sox went 4-2 in 2017 (3-0 at home) to improve to 12-6 against Houston over the last three seasons.
- The White Sox swept the Astros in the 2005 World Series for their first championship in 88 years.

FULMER AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old makes his third start of the season and first career start against Oakland.
- Is 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA (8 ER/27.0 IP) and a .192 (19-99) opponents average over his last six starts.
- Made his first career Opening Day roster.
- Was drafted by the White Sox in the first round (eighth overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University.
- Led Vanderbilt to the 2014 College World Series Title ... started the deciding Game 3 of the finals against Virginia on three days rest, allowing two runs (one earned) on five hits over 5.1 IP of a no decision.
- Bio is on pages 81-82 of the 2018 White Sox media guide.

LAST START

- Suffered his first loss of the season on 4/10 vs. Tampa Bay ... allowed three runs on five hits with six walks and four strikeouts over 4.2 IP ... became the first White Sox pitcher to walk at least six batters since Mike Pelfrey on 9/27/17 at Cleveland (also six)
- Left the game with the White Sox trailing, 4-1, in the fifth inning after throwing 92 pitches (51 strikes) ... the Sox lost, 6-5

SCORING CHANGE ON APRIL 4 AT TORONTO

- In the bottom of the fourth inning Justin Smoak reached on what was originally scored a double ... MLB has changed the scoring decision to an error by center fielder Adam Engel, resulting in an unearned run for Carson Fulmer.

BETTER ON THE ROAD

- Is making his fifth career start on the road ... has gone 1-0 with a 2.20 ERA (4 ER/16.1 IP) and a .183 (11-60) opponents average and 12 strikeouts in four road starts.
- Has made six career relief appearances on the road, going 0-1 with a 8.31 ERA (8 ER/8.2 IP).

2017 REVIEW

- Spent most of the season with Class AAA Charlotte before finishing the season in the White Sox rotation.
- Went 2-1 with a 4.34 ERA (9 ER/18.2 IP), .200 opponents average (14-70) and 16 strikeouts over five starts with the Sox ... also made two relief appearances (1-0; 1.93 ERA).
- Earned his first career win as a starter on 9/10 vs. San Francisco, allowing just one run on three hits with a career-high nine strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Made his second straight quality start on 9/15 at Detroit but received a no decision (1 ER/6.0 IP).
- Finished the season ranked by MLB.com as the No.9 Prospect in the White Sox system.
- Went 2-0 with a 1.56 ERA (3 ER/17.1 IP), 16 strikeouts, a 1.04 WHIP and .146 (10-61) opponents average over his final four starts of 2017.

MINOR-LEAGUE CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Went 13-19 with a 4.96 ERA (139 ER/252.0 IP) and 226 strikeouts in 55 starts over three minor-league seasons in the White Sox organization.
- Earned his first career win on 4/23/16 at Chattanooga (6.0 scoreless IP) ... struck out 10 batters on 6/9/16 vs. Mobile and again on 7/6/16 at Chattanooga.
- Entering the 2016 season, was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 2 Prospect and Possessing the Best Curveball in the White Sox system ... was also tabbed by MLB.com as the No. 2 Prospect in the Sox system, the No. 42 in baseball and No. 9 among right-handers.

- Is making his first career appearance against the Oakland Athletics.

FRIDAY'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- RHP James Shields (1-0, 4.15) is scheduled to make his fourth start of the season and sixth career vs. the Houston Astros.
- Did not receive a decision in his last start on 4/11 vs. Tampa Bay ... allowed one run on four hits with five walks and six strikeouts over 6.1 IP.
- Is 26-22 with a 3.74 ERA (199 ER/ 478.2 IP) in his career against the American League West (71 starts)
- Owns a 23-12 record with a 2.91 ERA (124 ER/ 383.0 IP) and .225 (322-1,440) opponents average in 57 career April starts ... the 2.91 ERA and .225 opponents average are career monthly lows.
- Is scheduled to make his sixth career start vs. the Astros and first at Guaranteed Rate Field ... has gone 2-2 with a 2.21 ERA (10 ER/42.2 IP) against the Astros lifetime ... suffered the loss in his last start on 9/20/17 at Houston (3 ER/5.2 IP).
