WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers fell to the Athletics, 3-2, last night, and team is 1-4 on this 6-game, 6-day homestand against SEA (1-2) and OAK (0-2)...club has lost 4 of 5, 6 of 8, and 11 of club's last 15 games...Texas has reached season-low at 9-under .500...team has gone 7-13 since a 1-4 start...club had season-long 5-G losing streak from 4/8-13... longest win streak is 2 G (4/14-15 at HOU) and team is 2-11 in last 13 9-inning games (2-0 in extras in that span).

- At 8-17 (.320), the Rangers have the 4th-lowest winning percentage in the A.L. and 6th-lowest in MLB...Rangers' 17 losses are tied for most in the A.L. (also BAL) and T2nd-most in MLB (18-CIN; 17-BAL/MIA/TEX)...the 8 wins are T2nd-fewest through 25 games in Rangers history (also 1985 and 2008), as club opened 7-18 in 1982...slowest starts after 26 G came in 1982 (7-19) and 1984/1985/1973/2008 (9-17)...team was 11-15 after 26 games in 2017.
- Team has been in 5th place in the A.L. West for the last 16 days...club has gained ground in the division twice since 4/17, but current 8.5-G is largest of 2018...Texas has been in either 4th or 5th place for 26 of the 27 days this season (T2nd following win on 3/30)...Rangers have gained ground in the division standings on just 5 days in 2018.

SERIES STUFF: Texas is 1-6-1 in series this season, including 0-5-0 in 5 series in Arlington...is the most consecutive home series losses to begin a season (series of 2+ G) in Texas history...club had opened season with 4 straight home series losses in both 1982 and 2015...Rangers are 3-4 in series finales, including a 1-3 mark at home...team has won 2 of last 3 series finales.

AT HOME: The Rangers are 3-12 in Arlington this season, losing 8 of 9 and 11 of last 13...lost 6 straight at home before win on Sun. vs. SEA...club's .200 home win pct. is 3rd-lowest in MLB, ahead of only KC (1-8, .111) and CWS (2-9, .182)... the 3-12 mark is slowest 15-G start at home in club history (previous low was 4-11 in 1982, 1984, and 1985), and previous low for wins after 16 G in Arlington were 4-12 records in 1984 and 1985.

VS. OAKLAND: The Rangers are 2-4 vs. the Athletics in 2018, splitting a 4-game series in the Bay Area, 4/2-5, ahead of losses in the 1st 2 G of this series...Texas has lost 5 of 7, 12 of 16, 14 of 21, and 18 of last 30 vs. A's...Rangers have gone 20-20 vs. OAK beginning 6/14/16...Texas was 8-11 against Oakland in 2017, and Rangers have lost season series vs. A's in 4 of last 6 seasons...Rangers went 7-3 vs. the A's at home last season, and have won 11 of last 18 meetings in Arlington...Texas leads all-time series 363-356, and holds leads of 191-168 in Arlington and 103-101 at Globe Life Park...the clubs do not meet again until 2-G series, 6/5-6 here in Arlington.

FAMILIAR FOES: Concluding with this week's series with Oakland, the Rangers are scheduled to face the A.L. West in 20 of their 1st 26 games...club has gone 6-13 vs. division rivals, including a 2-10 mark in Arlington...since 9/12/17, Rangers have gone 12-26 in intradivision contests, including 4-18 vs. West in Arlington since that date.

<u>CLOSE LOSSES:</u> The Rangers suffered a one-run defeat last night, falling to 1-2 in those contests this season...the club's 3 one-run games are tied for 2nd-fewest in the majors with the Chicago Cubs (0-3)...the New York Yankees (1-1) have played just 2 games decided by one-run.

DOUG FISTER returns from the disabled list for tonight's start vs. OAK, his 2nd start vs. the A's this season (took the loss on 4/4 at OAK)...Fister has lost his last 2 starts vs. OAK, but has gone 8-9 with a 3.33 ERA (41 ER/110.2 IP) over 19 career starts vs. the A's, the 7th-lowest ERA among active pitchers (min. 13 starts).

HERE WITHOUT YOU: With Beltré's placement on the disabled list today, the Rangers will have a lineup that doesn't include either Beltré or Elvis Andrus for just the 7th time since the start of the 2011 season...including the postseason, the Rangers lineup has included either Beltré or Andrus in 1180 of 1186 games beg. Opening Day 2011.

SMALL BALL: Delino DeShields recorded his 1st bunt hit of the season last night, the 2nd by a Ranger in 2018 (also Drew Robinson)...since the start of last season, DeShields' 12 bunt hits are tied for 2nd-most in the majors with PHI's Cesar Hernandez (12) behind MIA/SEA's Dee Gordon (18)... since the stat was 1st tracked in 1974, DeShields' 27 career bunt hits are 5th-most in Texas history, 2 shy of Bump Wills for 4th place.

EXTRA CREDIT: Each of Chirinos' last 6 hits have gone for extra-bases (3 2B, 3 HR) and his 8 extra-base hits overall are 4th-most on the club...Chirinos' 8 extra-base hits are 2nd-most among ML catchers, trailing only STL's Yadier Molina (9), CHC's Willson Contreras (9), NYY's Gary Sanchez (9), and LAD's Yasmani Grandal (9).

NOTHING TO SHOW: Cole Hamels now has 2 starts of 6.0+ IP and 2-or-fewer-runs this season, but has not posted the victory in either outing...Hamels is one of just 7 A.L. starters to have multiple such outings and no wins in those starts, joining (CWS' Reynaldo Lopez (3), DET's Matthew Boyd (3), and Michael Fulmer (2), KC's Jason Hammel (2), BAL's Kevin Gausman (2), and teammate Bartolo Colon (2)...last night, Hamels became the 1st Texas starter to suffer a tough loss this season (defined by baseball-reference.com as a loss in a quality start).

ROAD WELL TRAVELLED: After tonight, the Rangers are slated to play their next 6 games on the road, where the team has gone 5-5 in its 1st 2 road trips...while the Texas offense has produced on a similar level both at home and on the road, the pitching staff's road ERA (3.10) is 5th-lowest in the A.L. and nearly 3 runs lower than the staff's home figure (5.87)... the bullpen has allowed just 2 R-1 ER over 20.2 IP in their last 7 road games and have compiled a 1.16 road ERA overall.

TORONTO NEXT: The Rangers fly to Toronto on the off day tomorrow and open at 3-game series with the Blue Jays at Rogers Centre on Friday night...Texas dropped 2 of 3 vs. the Jays here in Arlington, 4/6-8...Texas has dropped 7 of its last 10 regular season games in Toronto since the start of 2015...this weekend will be the final scheduled regular season meetings between the teams in 2018.

SHORTS: The Rangers have won 5 straight games started by Juan Centeno, and are 5-1 in his 6 starts overall...Texas has endured a pair of rain delays this season, totaling 2 hours and one minute...Globe Life Park saw just one 10 minute delay in April 2017...Texas pitchers hit 4 batters in a game for the 4th time in club history last night and now lead the majors with 20 hit batsmen this season...the Rangers are 2-for-15 with the bases loaded, but their 4 sacrifice flies with the bases full are tied with Houston for the ML lead...Delino DeShields is 4-for-7 in his career vs. Kendall Graveman.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#38 Doug Fister, RHP (1-2, 3.95)

TONIGHT: The 34-year-old right-hander is scheduled to be activated from the 10-day disabled list tonight to start in the finale of this 3-game series with the Athletics...was placed on the 10-day DL on 4/10 with a right hip strain...threw a bullpen earlier this week, but did not go on an injury rehab assignment...will be making first start since 4/9 vs. LAA (5.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R-ER, 0 BB, 5 SO, 1 HR, 81 pitches/52 strikes)...opponents have a .309/.381/.455/.835 slash line through his 1st 3 starts...has 5 BB and 13 SO in 13.2 IP...his 48.8 ground ball percentage through 3 starts in slightly below his 2017 figure of 51.3...is 6-6, 4.35 (38 ER/78.2 IP) in his last 14 starts dating back to 7/31/17...his teams have an 8-6 record over that span...6-foot-8 right-hander owns 5 seasons of 10-or-more wins, including career-high 16 victories with WAS in 2014, finishing 8th in N.L. Cy Young Award voting...has made 9 career posteason starts with 3 different teams that included World Series outing with DET in 2012...Fister signed a one-year contract with an option for 2019 on 11/28/17...the 9-year ML veteran spent the final 3 months of 2017 with BOS, making 15 regular season starts for the A.L. East Division champs.

LAST START: Suffered the loss in the Rangers' 8-3 defeat on 4/9 vs. LAA (5.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R-ER, 0 BB, 5 SO, 1 HR, 81 pitches/52 strikes)...allowed his first home run of the season in the 4th, a solo shot by Albert Pujols...Angles batters were 6-for-21 with one HBP...had 8 ground outs compared to 3 air outs.

VS. OAKLAND: Will be making second start of the season against the Athletics...made first start against the A's at the Coliseum on 4/4 (3.2 IP, 7 H, 5 R-2 ER, 2 BB, 5 SO) suffering the loss in a 6-2 Rangers defeat...his 3.2 IP was the shortest outing in his career against OAK...has gone 8-9 with a 3.33 ERA (41 ER/110.2 IP) over 19 career starts vs. the Athletics...his teams are 8-11 in those games...has 10 quality starts, 6 of which came when facing the A's at home... has allowed a .271/.319/.381/.700 slash line against OAK in his career...among active pitchers with at least 15 career starts vs. the Athletics, Fister owns the 8th-lowest ERA...he has allowed 3 R-or-less in 14 of 19 career starts vs. OAK.

GLOBE LIFE PARK: Is slated to make his 3rd home start of the season...defeated the Astros on 3/30 in his Texas debut (5.0 IP, 1 ER)...is 2-6 with a 7.53 ERA (36 ER/43.0 IP) in 9 career starts at Globe Life Park...still owns the 10th-highest ERA at Globe Life Park among pitchers with at least 35.0 innings at this facility.

2018: Texas is 1-2 in his 3 starts...Robinson Chirinos has caught each of his 3 starts...batters have fared better vs. Fister following a 1st-pitch strike (.385 BA/.967 OPS) than after a 1st-pitch ball (.273/.847)...batters leading off an inning are hitting .462 (6-13) with a 1.346 OPS...opposition has hit just .158 (3-19) with RISP...opponents by PA in game: 1st - .240 (6-25), 2nd- .455 (10-22), 3rd - .125 (1-8).

A HEIGHT ADVANTAGE: At 6'8", would tie for the 2nd tallest pitcher in Rangers' history: 6'10—Chris Young (2004-05); 6'8"—Mike Smithson (1982-83), Kameron Loe (2004-08), Dustin Nippert (2008-10)...2018 free agent signee Chris Martin is also listed at 6'8".

2017: Signed a major league contract with LAA on 5/20 and was optioned to Salt Lake (AAA)...made 3 starts for the Bees (1-0, 4.02), issuing one run in each of 1st 2 outings before allowing 5 R in 5.0 IP on 6/16 vs. Reno...was claimed on release waivers by BOS on 6/23 and added to big league club the following day... was 5-7, 4.71 (44 ER/84.0 IP) in 15 starts and 0-2, 7.11 (5 ER/6.1 IP) in 3 relief appearances for the Red Sox the rest of the season...ranked 4th on the staff in wins, starts, and innings (90.1) beginning 6/24...opponents batted .254, including career low .208 vs. RHB.

FRIDAY'S SCHEDULED STARTER — LHP MIKE MINOR (1-1, 3.86 ERA in 4 games/starts)

The 30-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 5th start of the season in Friday's road trip opener in Toronto...has allowed 2-or-fewer runs in 3 of his 1st 4 starts with Texas, holding opponents to a .23/.294/.440/.734 slash line with a 1.048 WHIP...Friday will be his 1st start outside of the State of Texas this season, as he has 3 starts in Arlington and one in Houston...is in his 1st season as a starting pitcher since 2014 (w/ ATL)...will pitch on 6 days' rest after taking a ND in Rangers' 6-2 loss on Fri. vs. SEA, game in which he exited trailing 0-1 (5.1 IP, 6 H, 1 R-ER, 1 BB, 6 SO, 102 pitches/69 strikes)...the 102 pitches were a season high...lone run allowed scored in the 1st inning after a leadoff double by Dee Gordon followed by an RBI FC from Robinson Cano...permitted each of 1st 4 Mariners leading off innings to reach base (3 2B, 1 HBP)...faced Jays in his 2nd start with Texas on 4/7 in Arlington, earning his lone win of the season (6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R-ER, 2 BB, 7 SO, 1 HR)...only run allowed in the 6th inning via a Steve Pearce solo home run...held Toronto without a hit through 4.1 IP...first victory as a starter since 8/28/14 with ATL...has gone 3-0, 1.64 (4 ER/22.0 IP) in 5 G/3 GS in his career against Toronto with a save in relief outing on 9/21/17 at TOR (1.0 IP, 1 SO), his only career appearance at Rogers Centre...Minor is in his first season with the Rangers after signing a 3-year contract on 12/6/17...in his lone season with KC, led staff in relief wins (6), was 2nd in appearances (65) and saves (6) and placed 3rd in holds (17) and games finished (13)...did not make ML appearance in 2015-16 following surgery for a torn labrum in his left shoulder on 5/13/15...was 38-36, 4.10 in 111 games/110 starts for ATL from 2010-14...from the 2012 All-Star break through 2014 season, ranked 11th in N.L. with a 3.52 ERA (min. 70 starts)...was selected by the Braves as the 7th overall selection in the 2009 June draft out of Vanderbilt University.
