THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY - APRIL 27

1983 - At Olympic Stadium in Montreal, **Nolan Ryan** strikes out **Brad Mills** to set a new, all-time ML record for K's with 3,509. Despite being 36 years old, Ryan's fastball is clocked at 98 mph on this night. He would go on to strike out 5,714 batters in his HOF career, by far the most in MLB history.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The defending World Series Champion Houston Astros host the Oakland A's tonight in the 1st game of a 3-game set at Minute Maid Park... **LHP Dallas Keuchel** (1-3) will take on A's LHP Sean Manaea (3-2)...this marks the 1st meeting of the season between the Astros and the A's.

DALLAS & THE WEST: Since the start of the 2014 season, **LHP Dallas Keuchel** has posted a 29-15 record vs. the AL West Division with a 2.95 ERA...his 29 wins in that span vs. the West are tops in the Majors, just ahead of his teammate, **Collin McHugh**, who is T-2nd with a 27-8 mark.

HOME COOKIN: Tonight is the 4th game of a 10-game homestand for the Astros...they were 1-2 vs. LAA in what was the 1st series of this 'stand...after this 3-game set vs. OAK, HOU will host the Yankees for 4 games next week (Mon-Thu).

RECENT 'STROS: The Astros have won 7 of their last 9 games...Monday night's loss vs. LAA snapped a season-long 6-game win streak...it was their longest streak since winning 6 straight from Sept. 14-20, 2017...also, the recent 6-game streak is the Astros longest **road** winning streak of 2018, and their longest since a 6-game streak from Sept. 14-29, 2017.

OUT OF THE BLOCKS: At 17-9, the Astros own the 2nd-best record in the AL, behind BOS (17-6)...it is HOU's best record after 26 games since posting a club record 18-8 mark in 2015.

WEDNESDAY'S RECAP: The Astros topped the Angels on Wed. afternoon, 5-2, behind the strong pitching of **RHP Justin Verlander** (4-0)...Verlander went 7.0 innings, allowing just 2 runs on 4 hits and no walks with 9 K's to pick up the win...**Alex Bregman** had the big blow on offense, breaking a scoreless tie in the 4th inning with a 3-run double...**Jose Altuve** (solo HR) and **Jake Marisnick** (solo HR) also contributed on offense...**Ken Giles** hurled a perfect 9th inn. to earn his 2nd save.

STRETCH OF DOMINANCE: Since joining the Astros rotation on 9/5/2017, **RHP Justin Verlander** is now 9-0 in his 11 starts with a 1.22 ERA (10ER/73.2IP), allowing just 38 hits while punching out 91 batters...in that span, he has posted a .151 opp. avg. and a WHIP of 0.69...**in that span, he leads all ML pitchers in wins, ERA, WHIP and opp. avg.**

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: **RHP Justin Verlander** is a strong candidate for the AL Pitcher of the Month for March/April...he currently is T-1st in the AL in wins (4), is 2nd strikeouts (48), opp. avg. (.151) and WHIP (0.73) and 3rd in ERA (1.36).

IN THE DAYTIME: The Astros have gone 8-2 in their 10 day games this season, giving them the best winning percentage in day games in the AL (.800).

THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY: 35 years ago today, at Olympic Stadium in Montreal, **Nolan Ryan** struck out Brad Mills to set a new, all-time ML record for K's with 3,509, surpassing the legendary **Walter Johnson**... despite being 36 years old, Ryan's fastball was clocked at 98 mph on the night...he went on to strike out 5,714 batters in his HOF career, by far the most in MLB history.

CARLOS CALIENTE: Since 4/16, **Carlos Correa** has hit safely in 10 straight games at a sizzling .457 clip (16x35) with 2 HR, 7 RBI and a 1.258 OPS...he leads all AL hitters in batting in that span...**ROAD KILLER:** Correa also leads the Majors in road batting with a .462 clip (24x52) with 5 2B, 3 HR, 12 RBI and a 1.246 OPS...**Jose Altuve** is 2nd in road batting (.397).

KING COLE: Despite Monday night's loss, **RHP Gerrit Cole** continued his outstanding start to his Astros career...**his 8 strikeouts Monday night give him 49 on the season, which is T-5th best all-time for a pitcher in his 1st 5 starts with a team...his 49 K's are tops in the Majors while his 1.29 ERA ranks 6th.**

PITCHING IN: The Astros have posted a Major League-best 2.43 ERA in 25 games (63ER/233.2IP)... their starters have combined to post a 2.31 ERA (37ER/155.2IP), which is also tops in the Majors...

SMALL INHERITANCE: The Astros bullpen has combined to allow just one of 17 inherited runners to score in 2018...that is the best pct rate in the Majors (5.9%).

BAGGY IN THE BOOTH: On Saturday night, Astros Hall of Famer **Jeff Bagwell** will join the AT&T SportsNet broadcast crew in the booth for the first time in 2018... Bagwell is scheduled to appear monthly on the Astros telecasts throughout the season...in 2017, Bagwell became the 2nd player in history to enter the Baseball Hall of Fame as member of the Houston Astros, joining longtime teammate **Craig Biggio** (2015).

LAST START - 4/21 AT CWS: earned his 1st win of 2018, holding the White Sox to 1 run on 4 hits in 6.0 innings, walking 2 and striking out 6 in Houston's 10-1 win.

KING KEUCHEL: 30-year-old and 2015 AL Cy Young Award winner was an AL All-Star for the 2nd time in his career last season and was also named the Astros Co-Pitcher of the Year by the Houston Chapter of the BBWAA... finished 5th in the AL in winning percentage (14-5, .737) and T-9th in wins (14)...posted the 2nd-lowest ERA of his career (2.90), behind only his 2015 Cy Young season (2.48).

UP THE CHARTS: surpassed a couple milestones this season, his 7th in the Majors with the Astros.

- became the 16th pitcher in franchise history to reach 1,000 innings (4/16 at SEA) in an Astros uniform and the 5th left-hander...with 1.1 innings pitched tonight, will tie **Turk Farrell** for 15th in franchise history in innings pitched.
- recorded his 800th career strikeout on 4/10 at MIN...is the 13th hurler in Astros history to record 800 strikeouts...currently ranks 12th in strikeouts in franchise history, immediately trailing **Bob Knepper** (946) on that list.

FAST STARTER: has been excellent in April in his career, posting a 13-6 record with a 2.42 ERA (48ER/178.1IP) and 2 complete games in 29 games (25 starts) in the month during his career...is his best ERA of any month... his 13 wins in April since 2014 are 2nd in the AL in that span behind **Rick Porcello** (14)...his 2.36 April ERA in that span is also 2nd in the AL behind **Chris Sale** (2.33).

has been named the AL April Pitcher of the Month twice in his career: 2017 and 2015...went 5-0 with a 1.21 ERA (6ER/44.2IP) and a complete game in 6 April starts in 2017...went 3-0 with a 0.73 ERA (3ER/37IP) in 5 April starts in 2015.

went 9-0 over his first 11 starts in 2017, joining **Roger Clemens** (2004) as the only pitchers in club history to begin a season with a 9-0 record.

VS. OAK: is facing the A's for the 19th time in his career in what will be his 17th career start opposite Oakland...went 3-0 in his 1st 3 starts opposite the A's in 2017 before being handed the loss in his most recent start opposite them in September (9/10 at OAK).

dating back to the 2014 season, the Astros have gone 10-3 in Keuchel's 13 starts opposite the A's...Keuchel is 5-2 with a 1.93 ERA (20ER/93.1IP) in those starts.

2017 SEASON: bounced back to his Cy Young form in 2017 with 14-5 record and a 2.90 ERA, posting career highs in groundball rate (67.3%) and groundball to flyball ratio (4.41) while leading the Majors in both categories (min. 140IP).

ranked 3rd in the AL in ERA behind **Corey Kluber** (2.25) and **Chris Sale** (2.90) among pitchers with at least 140.0 innings pitched...served 2 DL stints last year due to neck-related injuries, so ultimately fell 14.1 innings shy of qualifying for the ERA title.

2017 POSTSEASON: had an excellent postseason, going 2-2 with a 3.58 ERA (11ER/27.2IP) and 32 strikeouts in 5 starts...became the Astros franchise leader in postseason strikeouts (46), while tying the club record for most postseason wins (4) with **Roger Clemens**, **Roy Oswalt** and **Justin Verlander**.

started Game 2 of the ALDS vs. BOS (1ER/5.2IP), Game 1 of the ALCS vs. NYY (0ER/7IP), Game 5 of the ALCS at NYY (4ER/4.2IP), Game 1 of the World Series at LAD (3ER/6.2IP) and Game 5 of the World Series vs. LAD (3ER/3.2IP).

- walked and hit his first homer of the season Wed. vs. LAA...was his 1st regular season homer since Sept. 19, 2017 vs. CWS, a span of 35 games (longest homerless streak since 47 games from May 23-July 19, 2014)...his HR went 441 feet, marking the longest HR at Minute Maid Park this season and the 2nd-longest by an Astro regardless of the venue (**Springer**, 455-foot HR on April 16 at SEA).
- ranks T-2nd in the Majors in hits (34) with **Manny Machado**, behind only **Jed Lowrie** (37)...leads the AL in batting with runners in scoring position (.529, 9x17).
- has played in 499 career games at Minute Maid Park...will become the 4th player in Astros history to reach 500 career games at the venue: also **Lance Berkman** (779), **Craig Biggio** (590) and **Brad Ausmus** (501).
- played in his 1,000th career game on April 17 at SEA, becoming the 20th player in club history to reach 1,000 games with the Astros...currently ranks 9th in Astros history in hits (1,281) and is 10 hits shy of tying **Jimmy Wynn** for 8th place.
- recorded 1,272 career hits within his first 1,000 games, the 2nd-most by a foreign-born player in MLB history behind only **Ichiro Suzuki** and his 1,414 hits.
- only 25 players in Major League history recorded more hits within their first 1,000 games than Altuve, and 18 of the 25 are Hall of Famers...recorded more hits within his first 1,000 games than **Hank Aaron** (1,264), **Ted Williams** (1,251), **Tris Speaker** (1,247), **Pete Rose** (1,231), **Rod Carew** (1,226) and **Babe Ruth** (1,114) did in their first 1,000 games, among others.
- 2017 AL MVP signed the longest contract in franchise history on March 19, a 7-year deal that will keep him in Houston through the 2024 season.
