BALTIMORE ORIOLES (8-23) at OAKLAND ATHLETICS (15-16)
RHP Andrew Cashner (1-4, 4.76) vs. RHP Daniel Mengden (2-3, 4.68)

YOU'RE LOOKING AT THE MAN-NY: SS Manny Machado has hit safely in 25-of-31 of games played this season...Machado currently ranks among league leaders in many offensive categories (see chart at right)...Additionally, his .435 on-base percentage is tied for third in the AL and is tied for seventh in the majors...His .658 slugging percentage ranks third in the AL and fourth in the majors...Machado was named the American League Co-Player of the Week, along with Oakland LHP Sean Manaea, for the week ending April 22...Machado posted a slash line of .500/.560/1.273 with seven runs scored, 11 hits, two doubles, five home runs, and eight RBI over six games played to earn his fourth career AL Player of the Week Award, last winning for the week ending August 20, 2017.

KEEPING UP WITH JONES: Tonight, OF Adam Jones will play in his 1,500th game with the Orioles...He will become the eighth player in Orioles history (since 1954) to reach the 1,500 games played mark...Jones will join Cal Ripken, Jr. (3,001 games), Brooks Robinson (2,896), Mark Belanger (1,962), Eddie Murray (1,884), Boog Powell (1,763), Brady Anderson (1,759), and Paul Blair (1,700) as players to appear in at least 1,500 games with the Orioles...According to STATS, LLC., Jones will become the seventh active player to reach 1,500 games with his current team (see chart at right)...Jones joined the Orioles on February 8, 2008 when he was acquired from the Seattle Mariners along with RHP Chris Tillman, LHP George Sherrill, RHP Kam Mickolio, and LHP Tony Butler in exchange for LHP Erik Bedard.

DOWN ON THE FARM: The Orioles minor league affiliates have a combined record of 55-48 entering play today...Class-A Delmarva leads the South Atlantic League Northern Division with a record of 19-8; their 19 wins are tied for the second-most in all of minor league baseball...Norfolk OF Joey Rickard extended his on-base streak to 18 games last night and has hit safely in seven-straight...LHP Tanner Scott has thrown 9.0 scoreless innings with 11 strikeouts for the Tides...Bowie INF Corban Joseph (brother of C Caleb Joseph) leads the Eastern League in doubles (11) and is third in hits (32)...Frederick OF Ryan McKenna ranks second in the Carolina League in runs (22) and tied for second in hits (32)...Delmarva's LHP Zac Lowther leads the South Atlantic League in strikeouts (39) and OF Zach Jarrett (son of NASCAR Hall of Famer Dale Jarrett) is tied for first in the league in runs (21) and second in home runs (7)...Earlier today, Lowther was named the organization's Pitcher of the Month...Jarrett and Norfolk C Andrew Susac were named Co-Players of the Month.

THE IGNITOR: OF Trey Mancini is hitting .301 (28-for-93) in 22 games when batting lead-off...Mancini ranks ninth in the majors and third in the AL when batting in the lead-off spot...His .359 on-base percentage from the lead-off spot ranks sixth in the AL and ranks 17th in the majors...He has hit safely in 17-of-22 games while batting lead-off.

QUALITY OVER QUANTITY: RHP Alex Cobb tossed the Orioles 12th Quality Start of the season on Tuesday...The Orioles 12 Quality Starts this season are tied for sixth in the American League...The Orioles fell to 5-7 in games in which their starter has recorded a Quality Start...RHP Dylan Bundy is tied for 12th in the AL with four Quality Starts this season...Orioles starters have received just 54 runs of support this season, which ranks fewest in the majors...Overall, Orioles pitchers have received just 110 runs of support this season, which is fewest in the AL and second-fewest in the majors (Miami Marlins, 98).

GRAND CENTRAL STATION: OF Adam Jones hit his 251st career home run as a center fielder on April 26...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, his 251 homers hit while playing center field rank 13th all-time in Major League history...He also ranks fifth all-time among American League hitters...Among AL hitters, he trails Mickey Mantle (432), Ken Griffey, Jr. (382), Fred Lynn (266), and Bernie Williams (261)...Willie Mays is the all-time leader with 640 home runs as a center fielder.

THE COMPANY YOU KEEP: SS Manny Machado hit two home runs on April 22 against the Indians for his third multi-home run game of the season and the 17th of his career...According to STATS, LLC., Machado is tied for sixth all-time in multi home run games by a right-handed batter 25-years-old and younger...He trails Jimmie Foxx (19), Bob Horner (19), Willie Mays (19), Alex Rodriguez (19), and Andruw Jones (18)...He is tied with Joe DiMaggio (17) and Ralph Kiner (17).

CATCH THIS: On April 21, C Chance Sisco threw out three Cleveland baserunners attempting to steal...He caught LF Michael Brantley attempting to steal second base in the sixth inning, SS Francisco Lindor at second base in the seventh inning, and PR Rajai Davis at third in the ninth inning...Sisco has caught 8-of-15 would-be base stealers this season...It marked the first time an Orioles catcher had three catcher-caught-stealing in a game since C Matt Wieters caught three baserunners on August 25, 2012 vs. Toronto.

MAKE MINE A DOUBLE: In the 12th inning on April 8 at New York-AL, the Orioles turned a 1-2-5 double play when a bases-loaded ground-er to RHP Brad Brach was thrown to C Caleb Joseph and was completed with a throw by Joseph to 3B Tim Beckham...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the 1-2-5 double play was the first of its kind in the majors since September 7, 2012 when the Houston Astros (RHP Lucas Harrell, C Chris Snyder, 3B Matt Dominguez) did so against the Cincinnati Reds...Also, according to the Elias Sports Bureau, Sunday's 12th-inning two-out play marked the first 1-2-5 double play in Orioles history.

SIX PACK: Since the beginning of the 2012 season, Orioles hitters lead the majors with 1,371 home runs hit and also lead the majors in fewest number of errors committed with 519...Several current hitters rank among Major League leaders in home runs since 2012...Chris Davis ranks second with 225, Adam Jones ranks seventh with 180, and Mark Trumbo is tied for 13th with 172 home runs.

VS. OAKLAND: The Orioles and Athletics play the first game of six matchups between the two clubs this season...The A's will visit Baltimore, September 11-13...The Orioles won the 2017 season series, 4-3...Baltimore leads Oakland (since 1968) in the all-time series, 265-263, with the Orioles going 128-129 at home and 135-133 in Oakland...From 1954-67, the Orioles owned a 161-116 record against the Philadelphia/Kansas City Athletics.

THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY: On this date in 1960, C Gus Triandos set an American League record with three passed balls in one inning and had four total in the game, as knuckleballer RHP Hoyt Wilhelm went 7.0 innings and got credit for a 6-4 win over the Chicago White Sox...Triandos allowed three passed balls in the sixth inning...Six days later his backup, C Joe Ginsburg, tied the mark with three passed balls from Wilhelm in the second inning (four PB total) of a 10-0 loss to the Kansas City Athletics.

DISABLED LIST: Five Orioles are currently on the disabled list...OF Colby Rasmus (left hip flexor strain, since 4/7), 2B Jonathan Schoop (right oblique strain, since 4/14), and INF Tim Beckham (left groin strain, retroactive to 4/24) are on the 10-day disabled list...LHP Zach Britton (right Achilles surgery, since 2/15) and RHP Gabriel Ynoa (right shoulder inflammation, retroactive to 3/26) are on the 60-day DL.

FEEL THE DRAFT: The Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft will be held from Monday, June 4 through Wednesday, June 6 at MLB Network's Studio 42 in Secaucus, NJ...Rounds one and two and both competitive balance rounds will take place on Monday, with rounds 3-10 on Tuesday, and rounds 11-40 on Wednesday...The draft will air on MLB Network and MLB.com...The Orioles own four picks in the top 115 of the 2018 Draft; the No. 11, 37, 87, and 115 overall selections.

COACHING STAFF: The O's welcomed back each member of the coaching staff from 2017...2018 marks the second season for Howie Clark (assistant hitting), Roger McDowell (pitching), and Alan Mills (bullpen); the fourth for Scott Coolbaugh (hitting); and sixth season for Bobby Dickerson (third base) and Einar Diaz (coach); while Wayne Kirby (first base) and John Russell (bench) return for their eighth years on the staff.

THE SKIPPER: A three-time Manager of the Year (1994, 2004, 2014), Buck Showalter is in his ninth season as Orioles manager...He has managed the Yankees (313-268, 1992-95), Diamondbacks (250-236, 1998-2000), Rangers (319-329, 2003-06), and Orioles (630-592, Aug. 2010-current)...Showalter's 1,512 career wins rank 23rd all-time and are third among active managers behind Bruce Bochy and Mike Scioscia...His 630 wins as O's manager are second-most in club history behind only Earl Weaver (1,480).

QUICK HITS: Cashner will be making his seventh start of 2018...Spent the entire 2017 season with Texas, posting a record of 11-11 with a 3.40 ERA (63 ER/166.2 IP) in 28 starts... His 11 wins marked a career-high, and his 3.40 ERA was the ninth-lowest in the American League...Tossed 18 Quality Starts, which tied for 11th-most in the AL...Signed by the Orioles as a free agent on February 15, 2018.

LAST START: Cashner suffered his third-straight loss, and fourth of the season on April 28 vs. Detroit...He tossed 4.0 innings, allowing seven runs, six earned, on seven hits, one home run, with three walks, and four strikeouts...The six earned runs were a season-high and the most in a start since September 12, 2016 at Atlanta when he allowed seven...The 4.0 innings were a season-low and fewest he's worked since September 25, 2017 vs. Houston (3.2 IP)...Falls to 1-2 in his career against Detroit (three starts), and 1-11 (15 games, 13 starts) in his career against the AL Central... Threw 87 pitches, 54 strikes.

CAREER VS. OAKLAND: Cashner will be making his first start of the season against Oakland, his fourth career start (fifth appearance)...He is a career 1-0 with a 3.93 ERA (8 ER/18.1 IP), and two Quality Starts against the Athletics...His lone win came in his last start against them on September 30, 2017 at home when he tossed 6.0 innings allowing two runs on five hits with two walks and two strikeouts; the Rangers won 8-4...This will be Cashner's first start and appearance at Oakland Coliseum.

VS. AL WEST: This will be Cashner's 21st career start (17th career appearance), and first this season against an AL West opponent...He has gone 5-10 with a 4.02 ERA (58 ER/130.0 IP) in his previous 26 games against the division...He has gone 3-4 with a 3.97 ERA (25 ER/56.2 IP) in his previous 10 road appearances against the division...In 16 home games against the AL West, he is 2-6 with a 4.05 ERA (33 ER/73.1 IP).

CRACKING DOWN: Cashner has allowed seven hits with runners in scoring position through his first six starts of the season, all hits coming in his two most recent starts; opposing batters are 7-for-40 (.175) with RISP against him this year...During the 2017 season, opponents batted .170 (24-for-141) with runners in scoring position against Cashner, which was the lowest figure in the majors...Opposing hitters went 3-for-59 with runners in scoring position and two outs (.051) in 2017.

RUNS WANTED: Cashner has received zero runs of support in three of his six starts this season...He has made 29 career starts in which he did not receive any run support...He has gone 35-10 in 60 career starts when receiving three-or-more runs of support, as opposed to being 3-49 in 83 career starts in which he received two-or-fewer runs of support...Cashner's 5.40 run support average in 2017 marked a career-high, as his 3.50 run support average from 2013-16 was the lowest in the majors over that span.

SHUT'EM DOWN EARLY: Cashner has allowed three hits and two runs in the first inning; opponents are hitting .143 (3-for-21) in the first inning...The first time through the lineup, opponents are hitting .239 (11-for-46)...Second time through, .220 (11-for-50)...Then the third and fourth times through, .344 (11-for-32) and .333 (1-for-3) respectively.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Cashner will be making his third start on the road this season...In his previous two starts, he is 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA (4 ER/12.0 IP)...He has made 73 career road starts (121 appearances), going 16-35 with a 4.72 ERA (239 ER/455.1 IP)...Last season he went 6-6 with a 4.07 ERA (38 ER/84.0 IP) in 14 road starts.

AT HOME: Cashner has made four starts at home this season; he is 0-3 with a 5.73 ERA (14 ER/22.0 IP) in his first four starts at Oriole Park...Cashner went 5-5 with a 2.72 ERA (25 ER/82.2 IP) in 14 starts at Globe Life Park for Texas in 2017, the fifth-lowest home ERA in the AL...Limited opponents to two-or-fewer runs in 10 of his 14 home games with nine Quality Starts...Cashner has posted a 2.98 ERA (156 ER/471.2 IP) in 115 career home games (70 starts)...**Since 2013, Cashner has posted a 2.80 ERA (129 ER/414.2 IP) in 70 home games (67 starts), the 10th-best home ERA in the majors in that span.**

NIGHT AND DAY: Cashner has gone 1-3 with a 4.50 ERA (14 ER/28.0 IP) in five night starts this season...He's made only one day start and is 0-1 with a 6.00 ERA (4 ER/6.0 IP)...For his career, he has gone 39-48 with a 3.85 ERA (297 ER/693.2 IP) in 165 night games (109 starts) compared to going 4-20 with a 3.78 ERA (98 ER/233.1 IP) in 71 day games (34 starts).
