THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY - MAY 7

1971 - Joe Morgan tallies 4 hits, steals 2 bases, scores 3 times and drives in 2 to lead the Astros over the Phillies, 8-1, in their first game at Veterans Stadium...**Don Wilson** earns the win.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The defending World Series Champion Houston Astros continue their 6-game road trip thru Arizona (1-2) and Oakland (Mon.-Wed.) tonight with the series opener against the A's at Oakland Coliseum... **LHP Dallas Keuchel** (1-5) takes the mound for Houston opposite **LHP Brett Anderson** (0-0) and the A's.

ROAD 'STROS: Before losing their last 2 games in Arizona, the Astros posted a 7-game road winning streak, which was their longest since winning a franchise-record 11 straight road games from May 14-June 5, 2017...Houston has gone 7-2 in their last 9 road games, outscoring their opponents 59-13.

VS. OAK: This marks the 2nd series of the season between the Astros and A's, with the Astros taking 2 of 3 games from April 27-29 in Houston...the Astros have lost 4 straight at Oakland Coliseum, as they were swept from Sept. 8-10, 2017...prior to that sweep, the Astros had won 10 consecutive games at the venue... was their longest winning streak at a road ballpark since winning a club-record 11 straight games at Great American Ball Park in Cincinnati from 2007-09.

JET SETTERS: The Astros have gone 11-6 (.647) on the road this season...Houston leads the Majors in road ERA (2.24), ranks 2nd in runs per game on the road (5.47), and 3rd in road OPS (.796)

ABOUT YESTERDAY: The Astros lost the rubber match against the Diamondbacks, 3-1...**RHP Justin Verlander** (1ER/6IP) had another strong outing, but took his first loss of the season...**3B Alex Bregman** (1x4) drove in the Astros lone run with a solo homer in the 2nd inning...**A.J. Pollock** (2x3, 2RBI) scored what proved to be the game-winning run on a controversial defensive interference call in the 6th inning.

IT WAS A GOOD RUN: **RHP Justin Verlander** had his 11-game regular season winning streak snapped yesterday, which was the longest active streak in the Majors...his streak dated back to his final 3 starts as a member of the Tigers (Aug. 20, 2017) and was 1 win shy of his career long, a 12-game run from July 21-Sept. 18, 2011.

YOU'RE THE BEST AROUND: In 13 regular season starts with the Astros, **RHP Justin Verlander** has gone 9-1 with a 1.13 ERA (11ER/87.2IP), 113 strikeouts, 16 walks and 44 hits allowed...leads the Majors in ERA, opponent average (.148), innings pitched and opponent OPS (.462) in that span.

BIRTHDAY BOY: **2B Jose Altuve** hit a triple yesterday on his 28th birthday...became the 7th player in club history to triple on his birthday, and the first since **David Newhan** (2008)...only 29 players in MLB history recorded more hits prior to turning 28 years old, and only 2 second basemen: **Roberto Alomar** (1,329) and **Rogers Hornsby** (1,504)

ROAD WARRIORS: **SS Carlos Correa** (.415, 27x65) leads MLB in batting average on the road while **2B Jose Altuve** (.371, 26x70) ranks 5th in the AL in road batting.

SIMPLE MATH: The Astros own the 2nd-best run differential in the Majors at +63, behind Boston (+67)...Houston has scored 166 runs (7th in MLB) while allowing an MLB-low 103 runs.

GETTING IT DONE ON BOTH SIDES: **SS Carlos Correa** has hit .291 while leading the Astros in OPS (.881), RBI (25) and doubles (12, T-3rd in AL), and is 1 of 4 MLB shortstops who have not committed an error this season...has gone errorless in 35 starts this season and 45 straight starts dating back to 2017...marks the longest streak of errorless starts by an Astros shortstop since **Adam Everett** had a 53-start streak in 2006 (Elias).

PITCHING IN: The Astros lead the Majors in ERA (2.68), strikeouts (380), opp. batting avg. (.199), SO/9 (10.61), WHIP (1.01), opp. OPS (.596) and SO/BB (4.13).

COLE WORLD: **RHP Gerrit Cole** produced one of the greatest pitching performances in Astros history with his 16-strikeout, 1-hit shutout on Fri....notes on Cole:

- was his first career shutout, and 2nd career complete game (also July 27, 2016 vs. SEA).
- 16 strikeouts marked a career-high, and tied the 2nd-most by a pitcher in a single game in Astros history with **Randy Johnson** (Aug. 28, 1998 vs. PIT), **Nolan Ryan** (Sept. 9, 1987 vs. SF) and **Don Wilson** (Sept. 10, 1968 at CIN)...was 2 strikeouts shy of the club record of 18 set by **Wilson** on July 14, 1968 at CIN.
- was 10th time in MLB history that a pitcher recorded 16+ strikeouts while allowing 1 hit or fewer in a shutout, most recently by **Max Scherzer** (twice in 2015)...only others to do it: **Brandon Morrow** (2010), **Curt Schilling** (2002), **Kerry Wood** (20 K game nearly 20 years prior on May 6, 1998) and **Nolan Ryan** (1991, 1990, 1973, 1972).

REDDICK HONORED: A's GM David Forst will present Astros **OF Josh Reddick** with his A's 50th Anniversary Team jersey on the field prior to tonight's game at 6:51 p.m...Reddick, who helped lead the A's to 3 playoff appearances during 5 seasons with the club (2012-16), was voted to the 50th Anniversary Team by A's fans.

PLAYERS OF THE MONTH: The Astros named Double A **IF Taylor Jones** their April Minor League Player of the Month, and Double A **RHP Josh James** their April Minor League Pitcher of the Month...Jones hit .354 with 10 doubles, 3 HR and a 1.109 OPS for Corpus Christi in April, while James posted a 1.80 ERA and 34 strikeouts (T-1st in Texas League) in 20.0 April innings.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Astros minor league affiliates have combined to go 70-49 (.588), which is the top overall organizational record in the Majors...Triple A Fresno (19-12) and Class A Adv. Buies Creek (18-12) are both in first place while Class A Quad Cities (16-12) is T-1st.

LAST START - 5/2 VS. NYY: was handed the loss on Wednesday despite a quality start in which he allowed 3 runs on 6 hits in 7.0 innings...marked his 2nd consecutive 7.0+ inning start and his 3rd in his last 4 outings.

ABOUT DK: 30-year-old and 2015 AL Cy Young Award winner was an AL All-Star for the 2nd time in his career last season and was also named the Astros Co-Pitcher of the Year by the Houston Chapter of the BBWAA... finished 5th in the AL in winning percentage (14-5, .737) and T-9th in wins (14)...posted the 2nd-lowest ERA of his career (2.90), behind only his 2015 Cy Young season (2.48).

TOUGH LUCK: has been pitching better than his record this season, as he's inducing his normal soft contact and high ground ball rate...among AL pitchers, has the 3rd-lowest hard-contact percentage (24.4%), ranks 4th in soft contact percentage (28.2%) and 4th in ground ball perc. (56%).

- has received the lowest run support among Astros starters at 3.14 runs per 9.0, which ranks as the 10th-lowest mark in the AL...the Astros have scored 1-or-fewer runs in 5 of his 7 starts...his RSA average is low for the season, but is also skewed up with a 10-1 win on 4/21 at CWS.

VS. OAK: will be facing the A's for the 2nd time this season and is looking to rebound on the results from that start on 4/27 in Houston...allowed 6 runs on 3 home runs in 7.0 innings in the loss...his line looked a lot worse than his performance, as he retired the first 13 batters he faced, carrying a perfect game into the 5th inning.

UP THE CHARTS: surpassed a couple milestones this season, his 7th in the Majors with the Astros.

- became the 16th pitcher in franchise history to reach 1,000 innings (4/16 at SEA) in an Astros uniform and the 5th left-hander...moved into 15th-place in franchise history in innings pitched (1020.0) on 4/21 at CWS, surpassing **Turk Farrell** (1015.0).

- recorded his 800th career strikeout on 4/10 at MIN...is the 13th hurler in Astros history to record 800 strikeouts...currently ranks 12th in strikeouts in franchise history, immediately trailing **Bob Knepper** (946) on that list.

2017 SEASON: bounced back to his Cy Young form in 2017 with 14-5 record and a 2.90 ERA, posting career highs in groundball rate (67.3%) and groundball to flyball ratio (4.41) while leading the Majors in both categories (min. 140IP).

- ranked 3rd in the AL in ERA behind **Corey Kluber** (2.25) and **Chris Sale** (2.90) among pitchers with at least 140.0 innings pitched...served 2 DL stints last year due to neck-related injuries, so ultimately fell 14.1 innings shy of qualifying for the ERA title.

2017 POSTSEASON: had an excellent postseason, going 2-2 with a 3.58 ERA (11ER/27.2IP) and 32 strikeouts in 5 starts...became the Astros franchise leader in postseason strikeouts (46), while tying the club record for most postseason wins (4) with **Roger Clemens**, **Roy Oswalt** and **Justin Verlander**.

- started Game 2 of the ALDS vs. BOS (1ER/5.2IP), Game 1 of the ALCS vs. NYY (0ER/7IP), Game 5 of the ALCS at NYY (4ER/4.2IP), Game 1 of the World Series at LAD (3ER/6.2IP) and Game 5 of the World Series vs. LAD (3ER/3.2IP).

THE DARK KNIGHT: 2017 All-Star is in his 4th Major League season...is off to a strong start, as he currently ranks T-4th in the AL in wins, 7th in strikeouts per 9 IP (10.76), 8th in FIP (3.03) and 10th in strikeouts.

- ranks T-2nd in the Majors in hits (46) and ranks 10th in the AL in batting average... leads the AL in batting with runners in scoring position (.480, 12x25)...ranks 8th in MLB in road batting average (.371, 26x70).
- recorded his 2nd 4-hit game of the season on 4/28 vs. OAK tying his single-game career high for hits (26th 4-hit game)...his 26 games with at least 4 hits ranks T-2nd in club history with **Jeff Bagwell**, behind **Craig Biggio** (34).
- had 41 hits prior to May this year, the 2nd-most in club history prior to May of a single season behind **Derek Bell** and his 45 hits in 1998.
- has 1,296 career hits which ranks 8th in franchise history...surpassed **Jimmy Wynn** (1,291) last Tuesday for sole possession of 8th place...he now immediately trails **Terry Puhl** (1,357).
- recorded 1,272 career hits within his first 1,000 games, the 2nd-most by a foreign-born player in MLB history behind only **Ichiro Suzuki** and his 1,414 hits...only 25 players in Major League history recorded more hits within their first 1,000 games than Altuve, and 18 of the 25 are Hall of Famers...recorded more hits within his first 1,000 games than **Hank Aaron** (1,264), **Ted Williams** (1,251), **Tris Speaker** (1,247), **Pete Rose** (1,231), **Rod Carew** (1,226) and **Babe Ruth** (1,114) did in their first 1,000 games, among others.
- 2017 AL MVP signed the longest contract in franchise history on March 19, a 7-year deal that will keep him in Houston through the 2024 season.
