### THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY - MAY 8

**2005** - A 16-0 loss to the Braves puts the Astros in last place in the NL Central Division with an 11-19 record...the loss ties the most lopsided defeat in team history...the Astros would go 78-54 the rest of the way en route to their first NL Pennant.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The defending World Series Champion Houston Astros continue their 6-game road trip thru Arizona (1-2) and Oakland (1-0) tonight with the 2nd of 3 games against the A's...**RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (4-1) will look to stretch his winning streak to 4 games in what will be his 2nd career start at Oakland Coliseum...**LHP Sean Manaea** (4-3) will start for the A's.

**ROAD 'STROS:** The Astros have gone 12-6 (.667) on the road this season...in their last 10 road games, the Astros have gone 8-2 while outscoring their opponents 75-15...the club recently posted a 7-game road winning streak, which was their longest since winning a franchise-record 11 straight road games from May 14-June 5, 2017...Houston leads the Majors in road OPS (.829) and ranks T-3rd in the AL in road win %.

**VS. OAK:** Last night's win snapped the Astros 4-game losing streak at Oakland Coliseum...Houston has gone 3-1 against the A's thus far in 2018...in their last 15 games in Oakland, the Astros have gone 11-4, which includes a 10-game winning streak from 2016-17 that was their longest winning streak at a road ballpark since winning a club-record 11 straight games at Great American Ball Park in Cincinnati from 2007-09.

**LIGHTS OUT LANCE:** RHP Lance McCullers Jr. has gone at least 6.0 innings in each of his last 4 starts, and at least 7.0 innings in 3 of those 4 starts...marks the 2nd time in his career that he has gone 6.0+ innings in 4 straight starts, also from May 1-17, 2017...during his current 4-start streak, has gone 3-0 with a 1.67 ERA (5ER/27IP), 5 walks and 26 strikeouts.

**LAST NIGHT'S WIN:** CF George Springer went 6x6, falling a triple shy of the cycle, and LHP Dallas Keuchel threw 8.0 innings of 1-run ball as the Astros clobbered the A's, 16-2, in the series opener at Oakland Coliseum...the Astros posted season highs for runs (16) and hits (20)...marked their most runs since scoring 16 on Aug. 4, 2017 vs. TOR, and their most hits since recording 22 on April 9, 2013 at SEA...LF-SS Marwin Gonzalez (3x6, HR, 5RBI) tied a career-high for RBI.

**HISTORICALLY GOOD:** Last night, OF George Springer became the 1st player in franchise history to record 6 hits in a 9.0-inning game...the only other player in club history to post 6 hits in a game was Hall of Famer Joe Morgan, who went 6x6 in a 12.0-inning contest on July 8, 1965 at MIL.

**SPRING TIME:** OF George Springer has homered in 3 straight games vs. the A's...in 4 games vs. the A's in 2018, he has hit .647 (11x17) with 6 RBI (1.902 OPS).

**LOGGING INNINGS:** LHP Dallas Keuchel posted his 2nd 8.0-inning outing of the season last night, and ranks 3rd in the American League in innings pitched (51IP) behind RHP Justin Verlander (53.2IP) and RHP Corey Kluber (52.1IP).

**SIMPLE MATH:** The Astros lead the Majors in run differential at +77, which is a franchise record thru 37 games...Houston has scored 182 runs (3rd in MLB) while allowing an MLB-low 105 runs...2 of the last 3 teams to post a run differential this high thru their first 37 games of a season eventually won the World Series.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** SS Carlos Correa (.412, 28x68) leads the AL and ranks 2nd in the Majors in batting average on the road while 2B Jose Altuve (.368, 28x76) ranks T-4th in the AL in road batting.

**THROWING LEATHER:** Despite making 2 errors last night, the Astros lead the Majors in fielding percentage (.991)...SS Carlos Correa (36g) and 2B Jose Altuve (35g) are the only double play combo in the Majors that has not committed an error this year...Correa has gone errorless in 46 consecutive games dating back to 2017, which is the longest streak of errorless games by an Astros shortstop since Adam Everett had a 53-game streak in 2006 (Elias)...Altuve has gone errorless in 67 consecutive games at 2nd base dating back to 2017.

**PITCHING IN:** The Astros lead the Majors in ERA (2.66), strikeouts (385), opp. batting avg. (.200), SO/9 (10.46), WHIP (1.01), opp. OPS (.596) and SO/BB (4.10).

**STRIKEOUT ARTISTS:** Astros starters have recorded 11 double-digit strikeout games, the most in the Majors and their most in a season since 1998 (15)...they had 9 double-digit strikeout games during the entire 2017 season...the breakdown for Houston: Gerrit Cole (5 games), Lance McCullers Jr. (2 games), Charlie Morton (2 games), Justin Verlander (2 games).

**GOING STREAKING:** C Brian McCann has reached base safely in all 15 of his career starts at Oakland Coliseum (T-3rd longest active streak in MLB)...IF Yuli Gurriel has hit in 9 straight games (.361, 13x36), which is tied for the 3rd-longest streak in MLB.

**YOU'RE THE BEST AROUND:** In 13 regular season starts with the Astros, RHP Justin Verlander has gone 9-1 with a 1.13 ERA (11ER/87.2IP), 113 strikeouts, 16 walks and 44 hits allowed...leads the Majors in ERA, opponent average (.148), innings pitched and opponent OPS (.462) in that span.

**MWL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:** Yesterday, IF Jonathan Arauz was named the Class A Midwest League Player of the Week and LHP Patrick Sandoval was named the Class A Midwest League Pitcher of the Week...during the week of April 30-May 6, Arauz hit .522 (12x23) with 3 HR and 11 RBI, while Sandoval posted a 1.80 ERA (2ER/10IP) with 14 strikeouts and no walks.

**LAST START - 5/3 VS. NYY:** worked 7.0 solid frames on Thursday in Houston, allowing 3 runs on 5 hits...left the game as the pitcher of record, but did not factor into the decision in the Astros 6-5 loss...has gone 7.0 innings in each of his last 2 starts and in 3 of his last 4...has gone 6.0-plus innings in 4 straight outings.

**THE DARK KNIGHT:** 2017 All-Star is in his 4th Major League campaign...known for his elite strikeout rate, McCullers has not disappointed this season, posting 49 strikeouts thru his first 7 starts and 41 innings.

- among AL pitchers, ranks T-4th in wins, 7th in strikeouts per 9 IP (10.76), 8th in FIP (3.05) and 10th in strikeouts.
- has gone at least 6.0 innings in each of his last 4 starts, going 3-0 with a 1.67 ERA (5ER/27IP), 5 walks and 26 strikeouts in those outings.

**IT'S ELECTRIC:** owns a career 10.22 strikeouts per 9.0 innings ratio (416SO/366.1IP), which ranks 5th in the AL since his debut season of 2015 (min. 350IP)...trails only strikeout artists **Chris Sale** (11.31), **Chris Archer** (10.66), **Danny Salazar** (10.60) and **Corey Kluber** (10.26).

- has 10 career double-digit strikeout games and is the 3rd pitcher in club history to record 10 double-digit strikeout games prior to turning 25 years old...also **Don Wilson** (16) and **Larry Dierker** (10).

**SNAP DRAGON:** no qualifying pitcher in the Majors has thrown his curveball at a higher rate than McCullers since pitch data was first tracked in 2007...44.1% of all pitches he has thrown in his career have been curves.

- the pitch has averaged 85.3 miles per hour over his career, the hardest curveball thrown by a starter since 2007...is averaging 87.2 mph on his curveball this season, up from 86.0 mph in 2017, with both numbers leading all Major League pitchers.
- recorded 108 strikeouts via the curve in 2017, which led all AL pitchers.

**GROUND AND POUND:** has become one of the game's elite groundball pitchers...posted a 4.00 groundball to flyball ratio in 2017, which ranked 2nd in the Majors behind **LHP Dallas Keuchel** (4.41) (min. 100IP).

- has improved his groundball rate in every season of his young career: 47.4% in 2015, 57.3% in 2016, 61.3% in 2017 and 62.4% this season.
- notably threw 24 straight curveballs to finish off Game 7 of the 2017 ALCS vs. NYY...was his 1st career save, and was the 7th save of at least 4.0 innings in MLB postseason history...became the 1st pitcher in MLB history to record at least 6 strikeouts in a postseason save.

**VS OAK:** Is making his 2nd start of the season against the A's...has pitched in the Oakland Coliseum just once in his career, on 4/15/17 (5ER/4.1IP), an Astros 10-6 win.

- faced Oakland 2 starts ago on 4/28 in Houston, in which he fired 7.0 shutout innings, allowing just 2 hits with no walks and 7 strikeouts...pitched into the 6th inning with a perfect game before allowing a leadoff single

**HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE:** today will be his 5th road start of the season, as opposed to 3 home starts, where he has been dominant in his career.

- among pitchers with at least 175.0 innings pitched at MMP, McCullers has posted the lowest career ERA (2.39), immediately ahead of **Roger Clemens** (2.55) and **Roy Oswalt** (2.92).

**IN 2017:** posted career-best marks in walk rate (7.8%) and groundball rate (61.9) in the 2017 regular season...took his game to another level in the postseason, going 1-0 with 1 save, a 2.61 ERA (6ER/20.2IP) and 19 strikeouts in 5 games (3 starts).

**LAST START - 5/4 AT ARI:** was dominant in his start on Friday at ARI, fanning 16 in a complete game shutout and 1-hitter...was his first career shutout, and 2nd career complete game (also July 27, 2016 vs. SEA).

- was just the 10th time in MLB history that a pitcher recorded 16+ strikeouts while allowing 1 hit or fewer in a shutout, most recently by **Max Scherzer** (twice in 2015)...the only others to do it: **Brandon Morrow** (2010), **Curt Schilling** (2002), **Kerry Wood** (20-strikeout game nearly 20 years prior on May 6, 1998) and **Nolan Ryan** (4 times: 1991, 1990, 1973, 1972).
- the 16 strikeouts marked a career-high, and tied the 2nd-most by a pitcher in a single game in Astros history with **Randy Johnson** (Aug. 28, 1998 vs. PIT), **Nolan Ryan** (Sept. 9, 1987 vs. SF) and **Don Wilson** (Sept. 10, 1968 at CIN)...was 2 strikeouts shy of the club record of 18 set by Wilson on July 14, 1968 at CIN.

**ABOUT COLE:** six-year veteran starter was acquired by the Astros this offseason on Jan. 13, 2018, from the Pirates in exchange for **RHP Michael Feliz**, **OF Jason Martin**, **IF Colin Moran** and **RHP Joe Musgrove**.

- ranks 1st in the AL in strikeouts and in FIP (1.55) and 2nd in ERA, WHIP (0.69), K's per 9 IP (13.68) and in strikeout/walk ratio (8.56).

- went 2x6 with an RBI and 2 runs scored last night...tripled on his 28th birthday on Sunday, becoming the 7th player in club history to triple on his birthday and the first since **David Newhan** (2008).
  - is tied for the Major League lead in hits (48) and leads the AL in batting average with RISP (.464, 13x28)...ranks T-4th in the AL in road batting avg. (.368, 28x76).
  - recorded his 2nd 4-hit game of the season on 4/28 vs. OAK tying his single-game career high for hits (26th 4-hit game)...his 26 games with at least 4 hits ranks T-2nd in club history with **Jeff Bagwell**, behind **Craig Biggio** (34).
  - had 41 hits prior to May this year, the 2nd-most in club history prior to May of a single season behind **Derek Bell** and his 45 hits in 1998.
  - has 1,298 career hits which ranks 8th in franchise history...recently passed **Jimmy Wynn** (1,291) for sole possession of 8th place...he now immediately trails **Terry Puhl** (1,357).
  - recorded 1,272 career hits within his first 1,000 games, the 2nd-most by a foreign-born player in MLB history behind only **Ichiro Suzuki** and his 1,414 hits...only 25 players in Major League history recorded more hits within their first 1,000 games than Altuve, and 18 of the 25 are Hall of Famers...recorded more hits within his first 1,000 games than **Hank Aaron** (1,264), **Ted Williams** (1,251), **Tris Speaker** (1,247), **Pete Rose** (1,231), **Rod Carew** (1,226) and **Babe Ruth** (1,114) did in their first 1,000 games, among others.
  - 2017 AL MVP signed the longest contract in franchise history on March 19, a 7-year deal that will keep him in Houston through the 2024 season.
