### THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY - MAY 9

**2007** - In a 3-2 victory in Cincinnati, **Craig Biggio** leads off the game with a double, the 646th of his career to tie **Carl Yastrzemski** for 7th all time...Biggio would finish his career with 668 career doubles, good for 5th in MLB history.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The defending World Series Champion Houston Astros conclude their 6-game road trip thru Arizona (1-2) and Oakland (2-0) today with the series finale against the A's... **RHP Gerrit Cole** (3-1) will start for the Astros fresh off a 16-strikeout, 1-hit shutout on Friday at ARI...**RHP Daniel Mengden** (2-3), who gave up 5 runs on 6 hits to the Astros on April 28 in Houston, will start for the A's today.

**VS. OAK:** The Astros have gone 4-1 against the A's this season...a win today would give the Astros their 4th sweep at Oakland Coliseum since 2016...the Astros have gone 12-4 in their last 16 games at the venue, which includes a 10-game winning streak from 2016-17 that was their longest winning streak at a road ballpark since winning a club-record 11 straight games at Great American Ball Park in Cincinnati from 2007-09.

**ROAD 'STROS:** The Astros have gone 13-6 (.684) on the road this season, which is the 3rd-best road record in the AL...they also lead the Majors in runs per game on the road (5.95) and road OPS (.830)...in their last 11 road games, the Astros have gone 9-2 while outscoring their opponents 79-17...the club recently posted a 7-game road winning streak (April 17-May 4), which was their longest since winning a franchise-record 11 straight road games from May 14-June 5, 2017.

**LAST NIGHT'S WIN:** The Astros secured a series victory with a 4-2 win over the A's...**RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (2ER/5IP) improved to 5-1 on the season, tying him for the most wins the AL...**CF George Springer** (2x4, 2RBI) continued his offensive tear with a 2-run double...**LF Marwin Gonzalez** (2x4, RBI) drove in a run and made a big impact defensively by nabbing **C Bruce Maxwell** at 3rd base for his 1st outfield assist...**RHP Ken Giles** (0ER/1IP) got the save.

**SPRING TIME: OF George Springer** has recorded an RBI in 4 straight games vs. the A's and has homered in 3 of those 4 games...in 5 total games vs. the A's in 2018, he has hit .619 (13x21) with 8 RBI (1.795 OPS).

**GOING STREAKING: IF Yuli Gurriel** extended his hitting streak to 10 games last night (.366, 15x41), which is tied for the 3rd-longest streak in the Majors...**C Brian McCann** has reached base safely in all 16 of his career starts at Oakland Coliseum, which is tied for the longest active streak at the venue.

**HISTORICALLY GOOD:** Mon. night, **OF George Springer** became the 1st player in franchise history to record 6 hits in a 9.0-inning game...the only other player in club history to post 6 hits in a game was Hall of Famer **Joe Morgan**, who went 6x6 in a 12.0-inning contest on July 8, 1965 at MIL.

**COLE WORLD:** **RHP Gerrit Cole** leads the AL with 77 strikeouts and ranks 2nd in ERA (1.42)...in his last start on Fri. at ARI, he produced one of the greatest pitching performances in Astros history with his 16-strikeout, 1-hit shutout...notes on Cole:

- was his first career shutout, and 2nd career complete game (also July 27, 2016 vs. SEA).
- 16 strikeouts marked a career-high, and tied the 2nd-most by a pitcher in a single game in Astros history with **Randy Johnson** (Aug. 28, 1998 vs. PIT), **Nolan Ryan** (Sept. 9, 1987 vs. SF) and **Don Wilson** (Sept. 10, 1968 at CIN)...was 2 strikeouts shy of the club record of 18 set by **Wilson** on July 14, 1968 at CIN.
- was 10th time in MLB history that a pitcher recorded 16+ strikeouts while allowing 1 hit or fewer in a shutout, most recently by **Max Scherzer** (twice in 2015)...only others to do it: **Brandon Morrow** (2010), **Curt Schilling** (2002), **Kerry Wood** (20 K game nearly 20 years prior on May 6, 1998) and **Nolan Ryan** (1991, 1990, 1973, 1972).
- 77 strikeouts are the most by a pitcher within his first 7 starts with a team in MLB history.
- was his 5th double-digit strikeout game of the season in what was his 7th start...has struck out at least 11 batters in each of those 5 games (had 2 games with 11+ strikeouts in 127 career starts prior to joining Houston).
- became the first Astros pitcher to record at least 12 strikeouts in consecutive games since **J.R. Richard** did so from Sept. 21-25, 1979.

**DAYDREAMING:** The Astros have gone 9-4 (.692) in day games this season.

**SIMPLE MATH:** The Astros lead the Majors in run differential at +79, which is a franchise record thru 38 games...Houston has scored 186 runs (3rd in MLB) while allowing an MLB-low 107 runs...over the last 15 years, only 2 other teams have posted a run differential this high thru their first 38 games of a season.

**ROAD WARRIORS: SS Carlos Correa** (.397, 29x73) ranks 2nd in the AL in batting average on the road while **2B Jose Altuve** (.363, 29x80) ranks 5th.

**THROWING LEATHER:** The Astros have made 3 errors over the last 2 games but still lead the AL in fielding % (.991)...**SS Carlos Correa** has not made an error in 37 games this year, and has gone errorless in 47 consecutive games dating back to 2017, the longest streak of errorless games by an Astros shortstop since **Adam Everett** had a 53-game streak in 2006 (Elias).

**PITCHING IN:** The Astros lead the Majors in ERA (2.64), strikeouts (392), opp. batting avg. (.200), WHIP (1.01), opp. OPS (.596) and SO/BB (4.00).

**LAST START - 5/4 AT ARI:** was dominant in his start on Friday at ARI, fanning 16 in a complete game shutout and 1-hitter...was his first career shutout, and 2nd career complete game (also July 27, 2016 vs. SEA).

- was just the 10th time in MLB history that a pitcher recorded 16+ strikeouts while allowing 1 hit or fewer in a shutout, most recently by **Max Scherzer** (twice in 2015)...the only others to do it: **Brandon Morrow** (2010), **Curt Schilling** (2002), **Kerry Wood** (20-strikeout game nearly 20 years prior on May 6, 1998) and **Nolan Ryan** (4 times: 1991, 1990, 1973, 1972).
- the 16 strikeouts marked a career-high, and tied the 2nd-most by a pitcher in a single game in Astros history with **Randy Johnson** (Aug. 28, 1998 vs. PIT), **Nolan Ryan** (Sept. 9, 1987 vs. SF) and **Don Wilson** (Sept. 10, 1968 at CIN)...was 2 strikeouts shy of the club record of 18 set by Wilson on July 14, 1968 at CIN.

**COLE TRAIN:** 27-year-old and **2015 NL All-Star** is making his 8th start of the season...has been dominant in his outings, combining to strike out 77 hitters thru his first 7 starts (50.2IP).

- was acquired from the Pirates on Jan. 13, 2018 in exchange for 4 young players: **RHP Michael Feliz**, **OF Jason Martin**, **IF Colin Moran** and **RHP Joe Musgrove**...former #1 overall selection by Pittsburgh in 2011, was the Pirates 2017 Opening Day starter.

**AMONG THE LEADERS:** has shown well with his new club as he currently ranks 1st in the AL in strikeouts, WHIP (0.69), strikeouts per 9 IP (13.68), opponent OPS (.452) and in FIP (1.54), 2nd in ERA, 2nd in opponent batting average (.151), 2nd in strikeout/walk ratio (8.56), 6th in innings pitched and 6th in WAR for pitchers (2.0).

- over parts of his 1st 3 starts this season, posted a scoreless inning streak of 19.0 innings, the longest scoreless streak in the Majors this season.

**STRIKEOUTS APLENTY:** per the Elias Sports Bureau, Cole's 77 strikeouts on the year are the most strikeouts ever recorded by any Major League pitcher his first 7 starts with any club.

- has recorded 12 and 16 strikeouts over his last 2 starts, becoming the 1st Astros pitcher to post consecutive starts with 12+ strikeouts since J.R. Richard did so from Sept. 21-25, 1979.
- has 5 double-digit strikeout games this season and struck out at least 11 batters in each of those 5 games...prior to this year, had 2 games with 11+ strikeouts in 127 career starts.

**GOIN' DEEP:** has gone at least 6.2 innings in all 7 of his starts this season...over the last 10 years (2009-18), only Cole and **Dallas Keuchel** have posted such streaks, Keuchel posting two 9-game streaks from 2014-15 and 2016-17.

- began his Astros career with 5 consecutive 7.0-inning starts, allowing 2-or-fewer runs in each outing, becoming the 1st pitcher in franchise history to do so out of the gate with Houston.

**VS. OAK:** will be making his Oakland Coliseum debut today...faced the A's once this season on 4/29 in Houston (3ER/6.2IP) and got no decision.

**APRIL SHOWERS:** Cole's 61 strikeouts in his 1st 6 starts (all in April) set an American League record for a single March/April...the previous record holder was **Roger Clemens**, who posted 60 strikeouts in 6 starts for the Red Sox in April of 1988.

- the 61 strikeouts also set a franchise record for the month of April...only 3 other Astros pitchers have ever posted 61-or-more strikeouts in a single month: **Randy Johnson** (61 in Aug. 1998), **J.R. Richard** (69 in Sept. 1979, 62 in Aug. 1979) and **Mike Scott** (64 in May 1986).

- Last Gm:** 1x4 **OAK Series:** .300, 3x10, RBI **Road Trip:** .273, 6x22, 2RBI  
**Current Streak:** 3, .286, 4x14, 5/6 **Long Streak:** 8, .438, 14x32, 3/30-4/7
- went 1x4 with a walk last night...tripled on his 28th birthday on Sunday, becoming the 7th player in club history to triple on his birthday (last, **David Newhan** in 2008).
  - is tied for the Major League lead in hits (49) and leads the AL in batting average with RISP (.448, 13x29)...ranks 5th in the AL in road batting avg. (.363, 29x80).
  - recorded his 2nd 4-hit game of the season on 4/28 vs. OAK tying his single-game career high for hits (26th 4-hit game)...his 26 games with at least 4 hits ranks T-2nd in club history with **Jeff Bagwell**, behind **Craig Biggio** (34).
  - had 41 hits prior to May this year, the 2nd-most in club history prior to May of a single season behind **Derek Bell** and his 45 hits in 1998.
  - has 1,299 career hits which ranks 8th in franchise history...recently passed **Jimmy Wynn** (1,291) for 8th place and now immediately trails **Terry Puhl** (1,357).
  - recorded 1,272 career hits within his first 1,000 games, the 2nd-most by a foreign-born player in MLB history behind only **Ichiro Suzuki** and his 1,414 hits...only 25 players in Major League history recorded more hits within their first 1,000 games than Altuve, and 18 of the 25 are Hall of Famers...recorded more hits within his first 1,000 games than **Hank Aaron** (1,264), **Ted Williams** (1,251), **Tris Speaker** (1,247), **Pete Rose** (1,231), **Rod Carew** (1,226) and **Babe Ruth** (1,114) did in their first 1,000 games, among others.
  - 2017 AL MVP signed the longest contract in franchise history on March 19, a 7-year deal that will keep him in Houston through the 2024 season.

- went 1x4 with a solo HR last night...has hit safely in 7 games, his longest streak of the season...has also recorded a hit in 10 straight road games (.366, 15x41).
  - 11 doubles rank T-6th in the AL.
  - is hitting .304 (21x69) with 8 doubles, 12 RBI, 12 walks and a .422 OBP in his last 19 games dating back to 4/19.
  - leads the club with 23 walks (4th in the AL) against 20 strikeouts...ranks 4th in the AL in walk/strikeout ratio (1.15).
  - leads AL 3rd basemen in OBP (.372)...has started 38 of the Astros 39 games at 3rd base.

- went 1x5 last night...has hit safely in 16 of his 19 road games this season and has recorded multiple hits in 10 of his last 16 road games.
  - ranks 2nd in the AL in road batting average (.397, 29x73) and ranks 3rd in road OBP (.460 OBP).
  - hit a 446-foot solo home run off **Chad Green** last Thursday vs. NYY, the longest HR at Minute Maid Park this season.
  - leads the Majors in sac flies (5) and ranks T-3rd in the AL doubles (12).
  - posted the longest hitting streak by an Astro this season, a 12-game run from April 16-28...hit .419 with 2 HR, 8 RBI, 10 walks and a .509 OBP during his streak.
  - recorded his first multi-HR game of the season on April 20 at CWS, hitting a 2-run HR, a solo HR and a single in a 3-hit game...was the 7th multi-HR game of his career (last, Sept. 27, 2017 at TEX)...became the 2nd shortstop in MLB history to have 7 multi-HR games prior to turning 24 years old (also **Alex Rodriguez**, 10)...is the only player in Astros history with 7 multi-HR games prior to turning 24, regardless of position (previous record was 4 by **Cesar Cedeño**).
