#### THE LATEST:

Last night, the Blue Jays lost their second straight game to the Athletics, falling by a score of 3-1...Lost back-to-back home games to the A's for the first time since Aug. 11-12, 2013...Can at best earn a split of this series and are now winless in their last six sets (0-3-2 so far)...Last went winless in six consecutive series from Aug. 18-Sept. 6, 2017 (0-5-1).

♦The Jays have dropped six of their last eight games...Have gone 5-11 over their last 16 contests and are 9-17 in their last 26, following a 12-3 stretch...Are now tied for 3rd place with Tampa Bay...Had been in sole possession of 3rd place or better in the AL East standings every day since April 1...Are now 8.0 games back of both the Red Sox and the Yankees for the division lead...Have not been further than 8.0 GB of the 1st in the division since the end of last season (17.0).

## THIS AND THAT:

- The Jays are below .500 for the first time since holding a 1-2 record on March 31...Need a win today to get back to .500...Have gone 1-1 when needing a victory to reach a .500 record...Went 0-9 in such games last season...Are now a -1 in run differential...Were last in negative numbers on April 1 (-2).
- ♥Blue Jay batters struck out 15 times last night, their most in a nine-inning game this season...Their previous high was 12, done five times...Their only higher K total this season came in a 12-inning affair on May 11 vs. BOS (19K)...Have now recorded 19 games with 10+ strikeouts, doing so seven times in their last eight contests...Their 19 double-digit strikeout games are 5th most among AL clubs...Their 11 wins in such games are tied with PHI for 2nd most in the Majors, one back of NYY.

#### STILL HAULING:

Luke Maile doubled in the 5th inning last night and came around to score Toronto's only run...Has hit .319 (23-for-72) this season with 5-2B, 1-3B, 2-HR and 14-RBI in 21 games...Needs just one RBI, one home run, two doubles and four hits to tie his career highs from 2016...His 14 runs scored and nine walks this season are already personal bests.

Gio Urshela picked up his 1st RBI as a Blue Jay with a 5th-inning... Marked his first RBI since Sept. 22, 2017 at SEA

## ON THE HOME FRONT:

- This afternoon marks the 3rd contest of Toronto's seven-game, eightday homestand (0-2)...After this four-game set with Oakland, will take a day off on Monday before a three-game series with the Angels (25-20).
- ◆The Jays are currently 11-13 at home and have lost 10 of their last 13 here...Have out-scored their opposition, 117-109, in games at Rogers Centre despite getting out-hit, 212-191...Toronto's 1.25 HR per home game is 6th highest in the AL...Have averaged 4.88 runs/game at home, 5th highest in the AL, while allowing 4.54 R/G (5th in the AL).

### **BLUE JAYS vs. THE ATHLETICS:**

- ♣The Blue Jays won their 2017 season series with the Athletics, 5-2.. Won each of their last five meetings in 2017, including a four-game sweep here at Rogers Centre from July 24-27...Went 12-1 at home vs. OAK from 2014-2017 for a .923 win% - tied for the best home record by any team vs. a team in their own league (CHC: 12-1 vs. NYM).
- Kendrys Morales leads all current Blue Jays with 22 career HR and 61 RBI vs. OAK...Has a three-game RBI streak vs. the A's since last year, with 3-HR and 4-RBI in those games.
- Justin Smoak went 8-for-25 (.320) against the Athletics last season, including four homers and seven RBI for a 1.233 OPS...Has a .288 AVG (15-for-52) over that last three seasons, with 1-2B, 5-HR, 10-RBI and 11-BB in 15 games for a .413 OBP and a 1.009 OPS.

#### **BEFORE AND AFTER:**

Josh Donaldson has gone 23-for-77 (.299) in 21 games against the A's since they traded him to the Blue Jays...Has hit 7-2B and 4-HR with 16-RBI while drawing 18 walks (20K) for a .438 OBP and a .983 OPS.

- Marco Estrada allowed three runs over 6.2 innings for his 4th quality start...Struck out seven batters to match a season high (also April 6 at TEX)...The 6.2 IP were his most since his first start of the year, March 31 vs. NYY (7.0)...Threw a season-high 108 pitches (79 strikes)...Was his first start without a walk since Sept. 11, 2017 vs. BAL (5.0 IP).
- Yangervis Solarte went 2-for-4 for his 12th multi-hit game.
- ◆Curtis Granderson singled in his 1st at-bat and now holds a .447 OBP when batting 1st in the order, tied with Mookie Betts for tops in the AL.

### **TODAY'S START:**

Making his 1st start of the season and his 1st as a Blue Jay...Is 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA over 2 relief appearances this season (4.1 IP, 2H, 1ER, 1BB, 6K).

#### 2018 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Recalled from AAA Buffalo on 5/11 and earned the win in his Blue Jays debut that night vs. BOS...Threw 3.0 innings, his longest career outing as a reliever (1H, 3K).
- Allowed a run over 1.1 innings of relief on 5/13 vs. BOS while recording 3 strikeouts.
- Was assigned to AAA Buffalo to start the season...Posted a 1.86 ERA over 5 starts for the Bisons (29.0 IP, 21H, 6ER, 4BB, 29K).
- Was aquired from the Royals in exchange for a Player To Be Named Later on 3/21.

#### 2017 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 4-5 with a 4.36 ERA (36 ER in 74.1 IP) in 16 appearances (13 starts) between Seattle and Kansas City.
- Made his MLB debut with Seattle on 5/11 at TOR, allowing a solo home run (J. Smoak) in 2.0 innings of relief.
- ♦ Made his 1st big-league start on 5/18 vs. CWS, allowing 3 hits and 1 walk in 5.0 scoreless innings.
- Went 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA (8 ER in 27.0 IP) in his first 5 big-league starts, recording at least 5.0 innings and allowing no more than one earned run in all but one of those starts.
- Went 1-3 with a 5.93 ERA (18 ER in 27.1 IP) over his next 5 starts, before being optioned to Tacoma on 7/6.
- Was selected off waivers by Kansas City on 9/1.
- ♦ Went 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA (4 ER in 12.0 IP) in 4 games (2 starts) with the Royals in September.
- Allowed 1 run on 4 hits and 3 walks in 5.0 innings in his Royals debut on 9/7 vs. MIN.
- Earned his 1st win as a Royal on 9/12 vs. CWS, allowing just 2 runs on 7 hits in 5.0 innings.

### **OTHER HIGHLIGHTS:**
