# THE LATEST:

Last night, the Blue Jays lost their 3rd straight game to the Athletics, falling by a score of 5-4...Are now winless in six straight series (0-4-2) for the first time since Aug. 18-Sept. 6, 2017 (0-5-1)...Are now below .500 in series play overall (6-7-3) and have dropped to 2-5-1 in sets at home, having lost each of their last five series here...Need a win today to avoid being swept for the first time this season...Were last swept in a 3+ game series from Aug. 28-30, 2017 vs. BOS...Were last swept in a four-game set in 2015, from May 14-17 at HOU...Were last swept in a four-game series at home in 2001, from May 31-June 3 by Boston.

◆The Jays have lost seven of their last nine games...Have gone 5-12 over their last 17 contests and are 9-18 in their last 27, following a 12-3 stretch...Have fallen to 4th place, one game back of Tampa Bay...Had been tied for 3rd place or better in the AL East standings every day since April 1...Are now 9.0 games back of both the Red Sox and the Yankees for the division lead...Have not been further than 9.0 GB of the 1st in the division since the end of last season (17.0).

# THIS AND THAT:

- \*Yesterday's loss was the Jays' 1st this season when leading after 7.0 innings...Are now two games below .500 for the first time since holding an 0-2 record on March 30.
- ◆Blue Jay batters drew six walks yesterday....Have 16 games with 5+ BB this season, tied for 3rd most in the Majors (NYY-18, PHI-17)...Have taken 173 free passes, 4th most in MLB and 2nd most in the AL (NYY-188).

# SAM'S SCORELESS START:

Sam Gaviglio threw 5.1 scoreless innings in his 1st start for the Blue Jays...Marked the longest scoreless start of his career (5.0 IP on May 18, 2017 vs. CWS)...Matched a career high with six strikeouts (3rd time, last: July 6, 2017 vs. OAK) while issuing just one walk.

# GIO CASHING

A day after picking up his 1st RBI as a Blue Jay, Gio Urshela hit his 1st home run...Opened the scoring yesterday with a two-run blast in the 5th inning...Marked his 8th career homer (last: Sept. 22, 2017 at SEA)...Was his 1st career home run to opposite field (RF)...Became the 16th different Blue Jay to homer this season, the most by any MLB team.

# ON THE HOME FRONT:

- This afternoon marks the 4th contest of Toronto's seven-game, eight-day homestand (0-3)...Will take a day off tomorrow, before beginning a three-game series with the Angels (25-21) on Tuesday.
- ◆The Jays have lost five consecutive home games for the first time since Aug. 27-Sept. 8 last season...Last dropped six straight at home from July 19-24, 2013...Are now 11-14 at home and have lost 11 of their last 14 here...Have out-scored their opposition, 121-114, in games at Rogers Centre despite getting out-hit, 222-197...Toronto's 1.24 HR per home game is 6th highest in the AL...Have averaged 4.84 runs/game at home, 5th highest in the AL, while allowing 4.56 R/G (5th in the AL).

## **BLUE JAYS vs. THE ATHLETICS:**

All-Time: 195-220...All-Time, at Rogers Centre: 64-70...2018: 0-3

- The Blue Jays need a win today to avoid being swept by the A's for the first time since July 3-6, 2014 (4G)...Were last swept at home by Oakland from April 8-10, 2008...Have never been swept by them in a 4G series at home...Won their 2017 season series with the Athletics, 5-2...Won each of their last five meetings in 2017, including a fourgame sweep here from July 24-27...Went 12-1 at home vs. OAK from 2014-2017 for a .923 win% tied for the best home record by any team vs. a team in their own league (CHC: 12-1 vs. NYM).
- Kendrys Morales leads all current Blue Jays with 22 career HR and 61 RBI vs. OAK...Yangervis Solarte is 5-for-14 (.357) in this series, including 2-2B and 2-RBI.
- Justin Smoak went 8-for-25 (.320) against the Athletics last season, including four homers and seven RBI for a 1.233 OPS...Has a .309 AVG (17-for-55) over that last three seasons, with 1-2B, 5-HR, 10-RBI and 13-BB in 16 games for a .441 OBP and a 1.041 OPS.

## **BEFORE AND AFTER:**

Josh Donaldson has gone 23-for-81 (.284) in 22 games against the A's since they traded him to the Blue Jays...Has hit 7-2B and 4-HR with 16-RBI while drawing 19 walks (21K) for a .426 OBP and a .944 OPS.

- ◆Yangervis Solarte doubled twice and drove in a run...Was his 3rd multi-XBH game (did so twice in a doubleheader on May 3 at CLE)...Now leads the team with 27 RBI.
- Kendrys Morales doubled as part of a 1-for-4 afternoon...Also stole a base and has 2-SB in his last 14 games, after going 916 games without any.
- Kevin Pillar recorded his 20th RBI with a sac fly in the 5th inning...Has played 46 games this season...Reached the 20-RBI mark in his 80th game last year.

# **TODAY'S START:**

2018 HIGHLIGHTS:

Making his 4th start of the season, the 22nd of his career...In his last start on 5/13 vs BOS, threw 4.2 innings and allowed 4 runs (4ER, 4H, 1HR, 3BB, 3K).

# Has lost 7 consecutive decisions, dating back to last season, tied

- for his career long (6/27-9/27/27)...Looking for his 1st win since 7/26/17 vs. OAK and his 1st as a starter since 6/21/17 at TEX.
- Made his 1st start of the season on 4/17 vs. KC after being recalled from AAA Buffalo as the 26th man for the second game of the doubleheader after cancelling a game at the Rogers Centre on 4/16.
- Is 0-3 with a 4.57 ERA (11 ER/21.2 IP) in his 4 starts for the Bisons in 2018, allowing 8 walks and 1 home run with 13 strikeouts.

### 2017 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Made 18 starts and 7 after returning from the minors...In those 7 starts, went 0-5 with a 5.94 ERA (22 ER/33.1 IP) with a 1.59 WHIP...Overall, went 2-12 with a 5.73 ERA as a starter (1.48 WHIP) and 1-1 with a 4.26 ERA out of the bullpen (1.17 WHIP) in 2017...Lost his last 7 decisions as a starter and 12 out of his last 13.
- Faced one over the minimum through 4 innings on 9/23 vs. NYY, before giving up 3 runs in the 5th...Gave up just 3 hits but matched a season high with 4 walks (6/27 vs. BAL).
- Lasted only 1.1 innings on 9/17 at MIN...After a scoreless first had a 5-0 lead entering the 2nd, however would allow six runs (4ER) before being removed...Marked his 2nd time to not get out of the 2nd inning this season.
- Recorded his best start on 9/1 at BAL, holding the Orioles scoreless over seven innings...Did not get the decision as club would fall 1-0 in 13 innings...First time to not allow a run in a start since his first two career starts earlier in the season.
- Was optioned to Buffalo on 8/4 to develop as a starter... starts with the Bisons, posted a 1-1 record with a 3.12 ERA (6 ER/17.1 IP)...In fact, allowed just 2ER over his last two starts totalling 11.0 innings...Tossed 86 pitches over seven innings in his last outing on 8/22 at PAW.
- Nine of his last 10 appearances out of the bullpen in the Majors have been scoreless outings, holding the opponents to a .184 average (7-for-38) in the process
