Over his last 11 outings (4/28-c), Nick Vincent is 2-1 with 3 holds and a 1.64 ERA (2 ER, 11.0 IP) with 11 strikeouts and 2 walks.

The Mariners and Athletics meet for the 8th (5-2) of 19 games this season...the Mariners are 13-3 in their last 16 games vs. the Athletics (7/9/17-c)...since 2015, the Mariners are 21-8 (.724) at the Oakland Coliseum:

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue a four-day, three-game road trip with the second (1-0) of three games against the Oakland Athletics...went 4-2 on a recently concluded 6-day, 6-game homestand vs. Texas (1-1) and Detroit (3-1)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...Seattle is 14-8 in its last 22 games, 19-11 over its last 30 games and 24-15 in its last 39 games...Seattle is 9-9 during the day and 19-10 at night...Seattle is 12-10 at Safeco Field, 16-9 on the road.

- **On a Roll** - the Mariners have won 4 straight games, equaling a season-high (also: 4/10-14)...in 2017, Seattle won 5 consecutive games twice (6/2-7 and 7/9-17) and won a season-best 6 consecutive games, June 18-23.
- **Find a Way** - Seattle has won back-to-back games when trailing after at least 6 innings (trailing after 6 innings last night and trailed after 8 innings on Sunday vs. Detroit)...the Mariners are now 7-13 when trailing after 6 innings, 3-15 when behind after 7 innings and 1-17 when trailing after 8 innings.
- **Extra, Extra** - each of the Mariners last 2 games has been decided in extra innings, with the Mariners winning both contests...Seattle's 4 extra-inning wins are T2nd-most in the Majors (also: Philadelphia, St. Louis and Texas), trailing only Toronto (5).
- **Jean, Jean the Hit Collector** - since May 9, Jean Segura is batting .407 (22x54) with 10 runs, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 9 RBI and 6 stolen bases in 12 games...during that span, he is tied for the Major League-lead in hits (also: Mookie Betts and Brandon Crawford), while also ranking 2nd in stolen bases and 4th in batting.
- **No Hits for You** - Edwin Díaz leads AL relievers with a .113 (9x80) opponents average against...his .200 opponents slugging percentage ranks T3rd-best among AL relievers (also: Aroldis Chapman-NYY).
- **Call it a Comeback** - Seattle's 13 comeback wins rank T2nd-most in the American League (also: Toronto), trailing only Boston (15).
- **Series Stuff** - the Mariners have won or tied 13 of their first 16 series, posting a series record of 10-3-3.
- **Four Score** - Seattle is 22-5 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but 6-14 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.

7TH HEAVEN...dating back to May 18, the Mariners have scored 11 of their last 18 runs in the 7th inning and later, including 6 consecutive runs in the 7th and later...in the 7th inning and later this season, Seattle is batting .270 (144x534) with 79 runs, 30 doubles, 1 triple, 23 home runs, 74 RBI, 53 walks, a .338 on-base percentage and a .459 slugging percentage (.797 OPS)...among all clubs in the 7th and later, the Mariners rank T1st in game-winning RBI (11), 2nd in home runs and slugging, 3rd in batting and OPS, T3rd in extra-base hits (54), T4th in hits, 6th in on-base percentage, 7th in runs, T8th in RBI and 9th in doubles.

DIABOLICAL DÍAZ...Edwin Díaz recorded his 3rd save in the Mariners last 8 games (5/14-c) with a 1-2-3 10th inning last night...overall this season, Díaz is 16-for-18 (88.9%) in save opportunities while posting a 1.85 ERA (5 ER, 24.1 IP)...he has recorded 42 strikeouts and 9 walks while limiting opponents to a .113 (9x80) opponents average against...he leads the American League in saves, while ranking 2nd in the Majors (Wade Davis-COL, 17)...Díaz leads AL relievers in strikeouts, opponents average against and WHIP (0.74/9 H, 9 BB, 24.1 IP), while ranking 4th in strikeouts-per-9.0-IP (15.53/42 K, 24.1 IP) and 11th in ERA...the Mariners are 23-1 when he appears in a game this season...Seattle has not lost a game this season in which Díaz inherited a lead.

JAMES PAZOS IS GOOD...James Pazos ranks among the top-10 American League relievers in ERA, WHIP and strikeout-to-walk ratio...in 18 relief appearances, he is 1-1 with a 1.47 ERA (3 ER, 18.1 IP) with 19 strikeouts and 1 walk...his 0.76 WHIP (13 H, 1 BB, 18.1 IP) is 2nd-lowest among AL relievers, behind only teammate Edwin Díaz (0.74/9 H, 9 BB, 24.1 IP)...Pazos also ranks 7th among AL relievers in ERA and 3rd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (19.00/19 K, 1 BB)...the only two relievers in the Majors who rank ahead Pazos in K/BB ratio (Ken Giles-HOU and Kelvin Herrera-KC) have not yet walked a batter this season...Pazos has been unscored upon in 15 of his last 16 outings (4/10-c), posting a 0.55 ERA (1 ER, 16.1 IP).

AS THE STARTING PITCHING GOES...since April 24, the Mariners are 17-9 (.654), the 2nd-best winning percentage in the American League during that span...trail only the Yankees (.792/19-5)...during that same span (4/24-c), Mariners starters are 9-4 with a 3.42 ERA (60 ER, 158.0 IP) with 144 strikeouts and 37 walks in 26 games...Seattle starters rank 3rd in the AL in ERA during that span, trailing Houston (2.40/44 ER, 165.1 IP) and Los Angeles-AL (2.76/44 ER, 143.1 IP)...the 158.0 innings pitched by Mariners starters are 4th-most in the AL since April 24, behind the Indians (168.2 IP), Astros (165.1 IP) and Red Sox (160.2 IP)...Mariners starters are averaging 6.1 innings pitched per start since April 24.

HIGH WATER MARK...the Mariners are a season-high 9 games over .500 at 28-19...with a win tonight, Seattle would be 10 games over .500 for the first time since finishing the 2016 season 10 games over .500 at 86-76 (.531).

WHAT A RELIEF...since May 10, Mariners relievers have combined for the 2nd-lowest bullpen ERA in the Major Leagues...during this span, Seattle's bullpen has posted a 2.00 ERA (8 ER, 36.0 IP), which ranks just behind Houston (1.13/3 ER, 24.0 IP)...since May 10, Mariners relievers are 5-3 with 3 saves and 4 holds...they have combined for 38 strikeouts and 10 walks while limiting opponents to a .205 (27x132) average against...they also rank 3rd in WHIP (1.03/10 BB, 27 H, 36.0 IP), 5th in opponents average against and 6th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.80/38 K, 10 BB) since May 10.

AT HOME ON THE ROAD...the Mariners have posted a .640 (16-9) road winning percentage this season, the 7th-best road winning percentage in the Majors...trail only Los Angeles-AL (.737/14-5), Houston (.696/16-7), Boston (.692/18-8), Atlanta (.667/18-9), New York-AL (.650/13-7) and Milwaukee (.643/18-10)...the Mariners are averaging 5.12 runs-per-game (128 R, 25 G) on the road, 6th-most in the Majors...trail the Angels (5.84/111 R, 19 G), Astros (5.43/125 R, 23 G), Cubs (5.22/120 R, 23 G), Athletics (5.19/140 R, 27 G) and Yankees (5.14/108/21).

AS YOU KNOW...the Mariners rank 2nd in the Major Leagues with 23 home runs in the 7th inning and later this season...AND AS YOU MAY KNOW...8 of those 23 home runs in the 7th inning and later have tied the game or given Seattle the lead...BUT DID YOU KNOW?...that the Mariners 8 game-tying or go-ahead home runs in the 7th inning and later are tied for the most in the Majors this season?...the Mariners share the top spot with Toronto, while ranking ahead of Oakland (7) and 6 clubs with 6 such home runs.

ABOUT GONZALES...

- 26-year-old left-hander is making his 20th Mariners appearance, 17th Mariners start, 10th start of season...tonight is his 32nd career appearance, 24th career start and his 3rd career appearance (2nd start) vs. Oakland.
- Acquired by Seattle from St. Louis in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill on July 21, 2017.
- Native of Fort Collins, CO...attended Gonzaga University for 3 seasons (2011-13).
- Originally selected by Colorado in the 29th round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Rocky Mountain High School (Fort Collins, CO) but did not sign...drafted and signed by the Cardinals with the 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University...became the highest draft pick in the history of the Gonzaga baseball program.
- Made his MLB debut with Cardinals June 25, 2014 at Colorado.
- Went 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (3 ER, 6.0 IP) with 4 strikeouts and 2 walks with St. Louis in the 2014 postseason...earned 2 wins in the NLDS vs. Los Angeles, becoming the 4th rookie in postseason history to win 2 games in the Division Series (also: Dave Righetti-NYY, 1981, Jaret Wright-CLE, 1997 and Francisco Rodriguez-LAA, 2002).

LAST OUTING... allowed just 1 unearned run on 5 hits and 1 walk while striking out 2 across 5.2 innings in the Mariners 2-3 loss to Detroit on May 17...held the Tigers scoreless through 5 innings...with 2 outs in the 6th inning, issued a walk and a single before a throwing error (E5) on a ground ball allowed one runner to score...left with 2-1 lead.

GAS IN THE TANK... has pitched 6.0-or-more innings in 4 of his last 5 starts and 5 of his 9 starts overall this season...is 3-1 with a 3.86 ERA (13 ER, 30.1 IP) with 5 walks and 24 strikeouts in the 5 outings...prior to 2018, Gonzales had only reached the 6.0 inning mark in 1 start, on Aug. 30, 2014 vs. Chicago-NL with St. Louis (6.0,3,1,1,2,5).

NO FREE PASSES... has issued just 9 walks across 46.1 innings pitched this season, posting a 1.75 walks-per-9.0-innings ratio, the 7th-best mark in the American League (11th in MLB), and a 4.78 strikeouts-to-walks ratio, 10th-best in the American League (19th in MLB).

AT HOME ON THE ROAD... in 5 road starts this season, is 3-2 with a 4.39 ERA (13 ER, 26.2 IP) with 21 strikeouts and 5 walks...in 3 starts at Safeco Field, is 0-1 with a 5.03 ERA (11 ER, 19.2 IP) with 22 strikeouts and 4 walks.

2017 SEASON RECAP... went 1-1 with a 6.08 ERA (27 ER, 40.0 IP) with 32 strikeouts and 11 walks in 11 games (8 starts)...was acquired from STL on 7/21/17 in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill...posted a 5.40 ERA (22 ER, 36.2 IP) with 30 strikeouts and 11 walks in 10 games (7 starts) with Seattle.

AAA RECAP... combined for 13 AAA starts last season, 11 with AAA Memphis in the Cardinals organization and 2 with AAA Tacoma after being acquired by the Mariners...was 8-4 with a 3.14 ERA (28 ER, 80.1 IP) with 66 strikeouts and 22 walks in 13 combined starts...went 6-4 with a 2.90 ERA (22 ER, 68.1 IP) with 57 strikeouts and 17 walks in 11 starts with Memphis...was 2-0 with a 4.50 ERA (6 ER, 12.0 IP) with 9 strikeouts and 5 walks in 2 starts with Tacoma.

BULLDOG ROOTS... played 3 seasons (2011-13) with the Gonzaga Bulldogs, compiling a career record of 26-7 with a 2.34 ERA while recording 9 complete games and 4 shutouts...tallied 278 strikeouts over 303.2 innings of work...became the highest draft pick in the history of the Gonzaga baseball program when he was selected 19th overall by St. Louis in 2013...shared West Coast Conference Player of the Year honors with the Cubs' Kris Bryant (University of San Diego) as a freshman in 2011 and as a junior in 2013...in 2013, earned John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year honors as well as WCC Co-Player of the Year for the 2nd time in his career.

POSTSEASON GLORY... added to the Cardinals roster for the 2014 National League Division Series vs. Los Angeles-NL...made 3 appearances in the NLDS, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 3.0 IP) with 2 strikeouts and 1 walk...picked up the wins in Game 1 and Game 4 vs. the Dodgers...became the 4th rookie in postseason history to win 2 games in the Division Series (also: Dave Righetti-NYY, 1981, Jaret Wright-CLE, 1997 and Francisco Rodriguez-LAA, 2002)...in the 2014 NLCS vs. San Francisco, went 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (3 ER, 3.0 IP) with 2 strikeouts and 1 walk in 3 appearances.

ML CAREER... in parts of 4 Major League seasons with St. Louis (2014-15, 2017) and Seattle (2017-c), is 8-6 with a 5.17 ERA (71 ER, 123.2 IP) with 107 strikeouts and 42 walks in 31 games (23 starts)...originally selected by Colorado in the 29th round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Rocky Mountain High School (Fort Collins, CO) but did not sign...drafted and signed by the Cardinals with the 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER: RHP FÉLIX HERNÁNDEZ (5-3, 5.53 ERA)

32-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 386th Major League start tomorrow at Oakland...did not factor into the decision in the Mariners 5-4 come-from-behind win vs. DET on 5/18 (6.0,6,4,3,3,4)...has tossed 5.0+ innings and allowed 3 or fewer earned runs in 7 of his 10 starts this season...W#1 on Opening Day, a 2-1 Mariners win, on March 29 vs. CLE (5.1,2,0,0,2,4); was 11th Opening Day start, building on Mariners record...**SPRING TRAINING:** in 2 Cactus League starts, compiled a record of 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA (2 ER, 5.0 IP) with 5 strikeouts and 1 walk...Félix exited his first spring start after 1.1 inning on 2/26 at CHC after being hit by a line drive on right forearm (1.1,1,1,1,0,2)...allowed 1 R over 3.0 innings in MiL game on 3/19 at SD-AAA (3.0,3,1,1,0,5)...threw 3.2 innings on 3/24 vs. CHC, allowing a leadoff home run before retiring 10 of the last 14 batters he faced (3.2,4,1,1,1,3)...**2017:** Went 6-5 with a 4.36 ERA (42 ER, 86.2 IP) with 78 strikeouts and 26 walks in 16 starts...placed on the 10-day DL on April 26 with right shoulder inflammation...activated on June 23 after making three rehab starts (6/6, 6/11, 6/17 w/AAA Tacoma)...spent a second stint on the 10-day DL on Aug. 5 (retro to Aug. 2) with right shoulder bursitis...activated on Sept. 14...**CAREER:** Signed as a non-drafted free agent July 4, 2002...has played his entire 14-year career with Seattle, going 165-117 with a 3.25 ERA (924 ER, 2557.2 IP)...is Seattle's all-time leader in wins (165), innings (2557.2), strikeouts (2391) and starts (385)...has 4th-lowest career ERA among qualified active starters (Kershaw- 2.37, Bumgarner- 3.01, Scherzer- 3.25)...6-time All-Star (2009, 2011-15), 2-time AL ERA champ (2010-2.27, 2014-2.14)...**vs. OAK:** Will be making his 49th career start against the Athletics...has gone 1-1 with a 3.65 ERA (5 ER, 12.1 IP) in 2 starts vs. Oakland this season...is 26-10 with a 2.64 ERA (95 ER, 323.2 IP) with 302 strikeouts and 82 walks in 48 career starts vs. the Athletics...his 2.64 ERA vs. Oakland is 2nd-lowest among all active starters.
