### THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY - JUNE 13

**1999** - Astros manager **Larry Dierker** collapses in the dugout due to a seizure during the 8th inning vs. SD...the game is suspended with Houston leading, 4-0...Dierker misses only 27 games despite undergoing brain surgery.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The defending World Series Champion Houston Astros will match up with the division-rival Athletics tonight in the middle game of this three-game series...**RHP Gerrit Cole** (7-1) will start for the Astros opposite **RHP Paul Blackburn** (1-0) and the A's.

**ALL-STAR UPDATE:** Major League Baseball announced the first American League balloting update yesterday, which included **Jose Altuve** (701,236) as leading all American League second basemen...Altuve is a five-time All-Star (2012, 2014-17), including starts in each of the last three years (2015-17).

**#ALLSTROSGAME:** The 2018 MLB All-Star Ballot is open to fans and exclusively online at [Astros.com/Vote](http://Astros.com/Vote)...fans can vote up to five times per day and 35 times throughout the voting period, which ends on July 5...the 89th MLB All-Star Game airs live on July 17 on FOX.

**ABOUT THE RECORD:** The Astros are off to their second-best start in franchise history with a 43-25 record...their best 68-game start came last season, as the eventual World Series champs started 45-23.

**WINNING WAYS:** The Astros have won six straight games, which ties their season-long streak, and have moved to a season-high 18 games above .500 with a 43-25 record...Houston posted two winning streaks longer than six games last season, an 11-game run from May 25-June 5 and a seven-game streak from Aug. 31-Sept. 6.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Astros own the best road record in the Major Leagues at 24-11 (.686), besting the Red Sox (23-11, .676)...Houston averages a Major League high 5.77 runs per game on the road, has posted the best team road batting average (.277) and ranks second in road team ERA (2.77).

**DUBS IN OAKLAND:** The Astros have gone 6-1 against the A's this season, which includes a three-game series sweep in Oakland from May 7-9...the Astros have gone 14-4 in their last 18 games at The Coliseum, including a 10-game winning streak at the venue from 2016-17.

**IN THE SPRING TIME:** **OF George Springer** has been at his best against the A's this season, hitting safely in all seven games with a .517 (15x29) batting average, two doubles, three home runs and eight RBI...on May 7 at OAK, Springer became the first player in franchise history to record six hits in a 9.0-inning game.

**LAST NIGHT'S WIN:** The Astros won their sixth straight game last night, downing the A's by a score of 6-3...**RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (2ER/7IP) recorded his eighth win of the season, a new single-season career high...**RHP Ken Giles** earned the save and is now 11-for-11 in save chances this season...**DH Evan Gattis** went 2x4 with a homer and five RBI, a new career high.

**BACK IN HOUSTON:** A limited number of tickets are still available for **An Evening with the Eagles** concert tour, featuring special guest **Chris Stapleton**, set for this Friday, June 15 at Minute Maid Park...tickets are available for purchase at [Astros.com/Eagles](http://Astros.com/Eagles).

**BETTER LATE THAN NEVER:** The Astros have scored 124 runs in the 7th inning or later this season, which ranks second in the Major Leagues, trailing the Cubs (127).

**HIT MACHINE:** **2B Jose Altuve** has 30 hits in his last 17 games, dating back to May 25, posting a .423 (30x71) batting average in that timespan...he leads all Major League players in hits (93) this season and is on pace for his fifth straight 200-hit season (2014-17).

**ROAD RAGE:** **2B Jose Altuve** is hitting .399 (59x148) in road games this season, the best road batting average in the Majors...he also led the Majors in that category last season (.381) and has posted a .386 (251x651) batting average in his last 162 road games.

**FRANCHISE LEADERBOARDS:** **2B Jose Altuve**, who has played the last seven years with the Astros (2011-17) and is signed on for another seven (2018-24) is steadily moving up the franchise leaderboards and will reach significant milestones in the coming weeks...below are the Astros franchise rankings for runs and hits:

**ALL GOOD THINGS MUST END:** **SS Carlos Correa** committed his first error of the season last night, snapping a streak of 70 consecutive errorless games, which is a franchise record for a shortstop...this marked the second-longest active streak among MLB shortstops, behind an 87-game streak by Tampa Bay **SS Adeiny Hechavarria** (currently on the 10-day DL).

**RISPY BUSINESS:** **1B Yuli Gurriel** leads the AL with a .444 (20x45) batting average with runners in scoring position, while teammate **2B Jose Altuve** (.389, 21x54) ranks second...Gurriel is hitting .588 (10x17) in those situations dating back to May 24.

**50-50 SHOT:** **OF George Springer** has posted a .500 OBP this month, reaching base in 23 of his 46 plate appearances (14 hits, 8 walks, 1 HBP)...he leads the AL in that category in 10 June games (min. 45 PA).

**LEADING ROLE:** **OF George Springer** leads the Major Leagues with five leadoff homers in 2018...Springer has 23 career leadoff home runs, which ranks second in club history behind **Craig Biggio** (53), and ranks tied for 15th in American League history, along with **Alfonso Soriano**, **Shannon Stewart** and **Lou Whitaker**.

**HOUSTON TRAFFIC:** **3B Alex Bregman** has an active 10-game hitting streak and has reached base safely in 24 consecutive games, posting a .369 OBP and a .895 OPS in those contests...his streak is the second-longest active streak in the Majors, trailing only a 27-game streak by the Rangers **OF Shin-Soo Choo**.

**LUMBERJACKIN!:** **DH Evan Gattis** has mashed seven home runs with 20 RBI in his last 14 games...this ministreak fits in with a strong turnaround over the last month, as Gattis is hitting .286 (28x98) with a .966 OPS in his last 28 games, dating back to May 7.

**LAST START - 6/7 AT TEX:** won his 5th consecutive decision, leading Houston to a 5-2 win over **Cole Hamels** and the Rangers...allowed 1 runs on 3 hits in 6.0 innings, walking 3 with 8 strikeouts.

**COLE TRAIN:** 27-year-old and **2015 NL All-Star** is making his 13th start of the season...has been dominant in his outings, combining to strike out an AL-best 116 hitters thru his first 12 starts (81.2IP).

- was acquired from the Pirates on Jan. 13, 2018 in exchange for 4 young players: **RHP Michael Feliz**, **OF Jason Martin**, **IF Colin Moran** and **RHP Joe Musgrove**...former #1 overall selection by Pittsburgh in 2011, was the Pirates 2017 Opening Day starter.
- became the first pitcher in club history to start his career with the Astros with 8 straight quality starts.

**AMONG THE LEADERS:** has shown well with his new club as he currently leads the American League in strikeouts and strikeouts per 9 IP (12.73)...also ranks 4th in ERA, 2nd in WHIP (0.84), 2nd in opponent batting average (.169), 2nd in opponent OPS (.534), 4th in FIP (2.50), 5th in strikeout/walk ratio (5.39), and T-8th in innings pitched.

- over parts of his first 3 starts this season, posted a scoreless inning streak of 19.0 innings, the 4th-longest scoreless streak in the AL this season.

**STRIKEOUTS APLENTY:** despite there being over a month of games left prior to the All-Star Break, Cole's 124 strikeouts are the most by an Astros pitcher prior to the All-Star Break since 1996, when **Darryl Kile** fanned 128 batters in 19 games (18 starts) prior to the break...the franchise record for 1st-half strikeouts is 167, set by **Mike Scott** in 1986.

- became the 6th pitcher in AL history to record 109 strikeouts prior to June of a single season...the others to do it: **Chris Sale** (110 for BOS in 2017), **Pedro Martinez** (121 in 2001; 117 in 1999; both for BOS), **Roger Clemens** (116 for BOS in 1988), **Nolan Ryan** (113 in 1977; 117 in 1973; both for CAL) and **Sam McDowell** (111 in 1970; 109 in 1968; both for CLE).

- has 5 double-digit strikeout games this season...struck out at least 11 batters in each of those 5 games...prior to this year, had 2 games with 11+ strikeouts in 127 career starts.

- set an AL record for K's in the month of April this season with 61.

**THE ARSENAL:** has virtually scrapped his sinker this season, as 4.8% of his pitches have been sinkers (career-low)...has thrown his curve at a career-high rate (19.5%) and has increased his 4-seam fastball usage from last year (50% this year, up from 41.9% last year).

- his 4-seam fastball has been almost unhittable, as he has allowed a .138 average (20x145) against the pitch...has recorded 58 strikeouts on his 4-seamer.
- has struck out 43.4% of all the left-handed hitters he has faced, which is the top mark among all MLB starting pitchers.
