HOME, HOME ON THE BEACH: The Padres return to Petco Park after a 10-game roadtrip in which they went 5-5 and won two of the three series...San Diego claimed just one game in the four-game set vs. Atlanta, snapping their five-series winning streak (their longest since the 2010 season)...the Friars have won 12 of their last 19 contests, but they look to improve on the first game of the series, having gone 5-18 on the season and 1-11 in series openers at home.

LAST TIME OUT: On Sunday's roadtrip finale in Atlanta, the Padres fell 4-1, with reliever **José Castillo** receiving his first-career loss...after **Matt Strahm** started the pitching duel with 2.2 innings of scoreless ball, Castillo relented two runs (his first of his career)...**Cory Spangenberg** and **Freddy Galvis** also contributed two hits apiece.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Friars host the Oakland Athletics for this two-game set before heading to San Francisco (four games, June 21-24) and Texas (three games, June 25-27)...by the end of the upcoming trip, San Diego will have played 17 road games since June 8 (and just the two home games vs. OAK).

NOT SO GLOOMY: In the month of June, starter **Eric Lauer** has a 3.45 ERA, in comparison to his 7.67 ERA this season prior to June 1st...his -4.22 ERA difference between those times is the third-largest difference of any pitcher (min. 25 IP pre-June and min. 10 IP in June).

RISP/2 OUT: The Padres lead the majors with a .287 average with RISP/2 outs, and the A's rank second with a .266 mark...in their last two games, however, the Padres have gone 0-for-13 with RISP.

GIVE HIM A HAND: **Brad Hand** has a .156 opponent average this season and 22 strikeouts with two outs, both of which rank first the majors (min. 50 batters based with two outs, all in relief)...he hasn't allowed an earned run in 28 of his 33 games.

YOU'RE A HEART BREAKER, DREAM MAKER, RUN SAVER: **Eric Hosmer** leads all first basemen with six defensive runs saved (DRS, which indicates how many runs a player saved or hurt his team in the field compared to the average player at his position)...his .998 fielding percentage this season ties for the highest of all first basemen, and his .995 fielding percentage at 1B since 2011 is the 10th-highest of anyone at the position in that time.

¡FELIZ CUMPLEAÑOS! Join the Padres in wishing 3B **Christian Villanueva** a happy birthday...the native of Guadalajara, Mexico turns 27 today.

ERRORS ON RECORD: In games the Padres have made at least one error this season, they have an 8-24 record...they're 26-16 when they don't make an error in a game...their 10 outfield errors are the third-most of any club, and their two errors by Padres catchers are tied for the third-fewest of any team.

PADRES ON DECK: Tonight, 10 Padres prospects will participate in two Single-A All-Star Games...OFs **Buddy Reed** and **Edward Olivares**, 3B **Hudson Potts**, LHP **Adrian Morejon** and RHPs **Reggie Lawson** and **Elliott Ashbeck** will represent Lake Elsinore (A) on the South Team in the California League All-Star Game in Lancaster...RHP **Chris Paddack** was also selected to the South team but won't be available due to inning limitations...C **Luis Campusano**, LHPs **Nick Margevicius** and **Travis Radke** and RHP **Aaron Leasher** will represent Fort Wayne (A) on the East team in the Midwest League All-Star Game in Lansing, Michigan.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#46 LHP ERIC LAUER (3-4, 6.20) @e_lauer10

LAUER HOUR: 23-year-old **Eric Lauer** (who celebrated his birthday on June 3) is set to make his 11th career start and first against the Oakland Athletics tonight...it will be his first career start against an American League opponent.

LAST TIME OUT: Recorded his third career victory on 6/13 at STL, allowing just two runs on a career-high eight hits allowed but did not walk a batter for the first time in his career in SD's 4-2 win.

V SUPPORTIVE: When the southpaw rookie gets two-or-more runs of support from the Padres offense (happened in five of his 10 starts), he is 3-0 with a 3.42 ERA (10 ER, 26.1 IP) and a 1.56 WHIP with just two home runs allowed...when he gets less than two runs of support, he's 0-4 with a 10.13 ERA (21 ER, 18.2 IP) with a .395 opponent average and a 2.57 WHIP.

JUNE BLOOM: After posting a 7.67 ERA from April-May (his first seven starts), he has tallied a 3.45 mark in June (his past three outing)...his -4.22 mark is the third-largest difference between ERA pre-June/in June among all ML pitchers (min. 25 IP pre-June & min. 10 IP in June).

GET TO 5.0: When Lauer works 5.0-or-more innings, he owns a 3-1 record, a 2.76 ERA (10 ER, 32.2 IP), .293 opponent average and 1.62 WHIP...when he tosses less than 5.0 innings, he has a 0-3 record, 15.32 ERA (21 ER, 12.1 IP) with a .456 opponent average and a 2.92 WHIP.

ERIC'S ARSENAL: Lauer has relied on four pitches this season: four seamer (62%), cutter (21.8%), curve (11.4%) and changeup (4.9%).

PICKOFF ARTISTS: Lauer's seven pickoffs lead the majors, two ahead of SEA Marco Gonzales and ATL Julio Teheran's five apiece.

- He has pickoffs in five straight starts, the longest pickoff streak in Padres history and tied for the second-longest in ML history with four others...Andy Pettitte had the longest streak (eight straight in 1997).
- **Lauer** (seven) and fellow rookie lefty **Joey Lucchesi** (three) have combined for 10 pickoffs this season...it's the most pickoffs by a Padre rookie duo in franchise history, ahead of **Clayton Richard** and **Josh Geer** six combined pickoffs in 2009.
- The Padres 13 pickoffs lead the majors, ahead of the NYM's 12.

LEARNING LESSON: Became the first Padres starting pitcher since Ben Howard on Sept. 14, 2003 at LAD to allow three home runs in an inning on 5/11 vs. STL., which occurred in the top of the third...allowed a career-high seven runs (six earned) on seven hits and a walk in SD' 9-5 loss

CHECK THE SPLITS: Lauer has walked five left-handed batters this season and yielded 19 free passes to right-handed hitters...lefties have also accrued just two RBI off the southpaw, while righties have combined for 29 RBI.

HISTORIA: Earned his first career win on 5/6 vs. LAD in Monterrey, Mexico, tossing 6.0-shutout innings behind a career-high 102 pitches and five strikeouts against one walk in the Padres' 3-0 victory.

- Became the first and only SD pitcher to get his first career ML win in a game played outside the US and Canada...also just the second starter to get such a win and the fifth pitcher (starter or reliever) to do so.
- At 22 years and 337 days old on 5/6, he was the fifth-youngest pitcher in the NL to record a win this season.

- Throws a first-pitch strike 68.8 percent of the time, ranking second among all Padres relievers behind Craig Stammen's 69.7 percent.
- His 37.0 IP lead the SD bullpen (among relievers yet to make a start)...has posted a 10.70 SO/9 inning ratio.
- Has only allowed multiple runs in a single outing on one occasion (2 ER on May 27 at LAD).

- His 21 saves rank tied for third in the majors and first in the NL...converted each of his 11 save opportunities during the month of May, tied with Kimbrel for the most in MLB.
- Since trading closer Brandon Maurer on July 24, 2017, his 39 saves in that time rank second in MLB, behind only SEA Edwin Diaz (43).
- 51.4 percent of his pitches this season have been sliders...169 of his sliders have been thrown for strikes, the highest total among major league relievers this season.
- Was named the National League Reliever of the month for May, the second such honor of his career (also, July 2017)...pitched to a 0.61 ERA (1 ER, 14.2 IP) during May with a 0.89 WHIP, 22 strikeouts and a .120 opponent average.

- Has pitched to a 3.00 ERA (5 ER, 15.0 IP) in 13 games at Petco this season and a 1.65 ERA (3 ER, 16.1 IP) in 15 games on the road.
- Is limiting opponents to a .213 clip (27-for-127) in his 30 appearances this season.
- Since the '17 All-Star break, has posted a 1.61 ERA (12 ER, 67.0 IP) and a .213 opponent average...is scoreless in 53 of his 61 appearances.
