BASEBALL AT A DISCOUNTED PRICE, PER INNING: The Padres fell 4-2 in extra-innings last night to the Oakland Athletics, dropping to 1-4 in extra-inning games this season...the Friars have gone 12-8 in their last 20 contests, but they having gone 5-19 on the season in the first game of the series and 1-12 in series openers at home.

- **Eric Lauer** worked 6.0 innings for the first time since May 22 @ WSH, and his seven strikeouts tied his career high...he did not allow a single earned run, and he now owns a 3-1 record with a 2.33 ERA (10 ER, 38.2 IP) when he works 5.0-or-more innings.
- **Cory Spangenberg** has now had multiple hits in consecutive games, and with his 14th double of the season, **Freddy Galvis** is currently riding a four game hitting streak, going 9-for-17 (.529) with a homer and four RBI.

MAKING MOVES: Today, the Padres reinstated LHP **Joey Lucchesi** from the 10-day disabled list (was placed on May 15 with a right hip strain), and the club placed RHP **Bryan Mitchell** on the 10-day disabled list with right hip impingement, retroactive to June 17.

THAT JOEY IS SO FUEGO RIGHT NOW: **Joey Lucchesi**, 25-year-old native of Newark, Calif., is set to make his 10th start of the season and his first since May 14 vs. COL...opponents have hit .246 against the rookie southpaw, and at Petco Park, he is 2-0 with a 2.87 ERA (10 ER, 31.1 IP)...Statcast data says that the lefty relies on two primary pitches: sinker (64.6%) and his curve (35.4%)...metrics have yet to accurately measure the hurler's "churve" (change-up slider).

GETTING AHEAD: The Padres bullpen has thrown a first-pitch strike 63.3 percent of the time this year, a mark that leads the Major Leagues.

SPANGENBURGEONING: **Cory Spangenberg** has logged multiple hits in consecutive games, and he has hit safely in his last nine starts since June 4 with six multi-hit efforts (.417, 15-for-36) and two triples and two homers.

DAYMAN, FIGHTER OF THE NIGHT MAN: The Padres began the season 1-8 in their first nine day games...since March 6, San Diego has gone 9-3, and they have also won four of their last five day games...in those five games, the Padres pitching staff has held their opposition to a 2.45 ERA (12 ER, 44.0 IP).

A 'PENCHANT FOR DOMINANCE: The Friar bullpen's 3.23 ERA (101 ER, 281.2 IP) this season is the fourth-best in the National League this season, and their 293 combined strikeouts are the second-most in the NL, behind MIL's 315...in the month of June, opposing hitters have hit just .198 vs. the Padres relief crew, the second-best mark in the NL, behind the SF bullpen's .178 opponent average.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Following the brief two-game set vs. Oakland, the Friars fly to San Francisco (four games, June 21-24) and Texas (three games, June 25-27)...by the end of the upcoming trip, San Diego will have played 17 road games since June 8 (and just the two home games vs. OAK).

PADRES ON DECK: In yesterday's Arizona Rookie League opener, SS **Xavier Edwards** made his professional debut, and he went 2-for-3 with two walks, a stolen base and a run scored...Fort Wayne (A) LHP's **Aaron Leasher** (who allowed a hit with a strikeout as the starter) and **Nick Margevicius** each worked a scoreless inning for the winning East in the Single-A Midwest League All-Star Game...Lake Elsinore's (A) 3B **Hudson Potts** and OF **Edward Olivares** each singled in the California League All-Star Game, RHP **Pedro Avila** pitched a scoreless inning, allowing a hit with two strikeouts, and RHP **Reggie Lawson** started and allowed a run on two hits with two strikeouts in an inning.

#37 LHP JOEY LUCCHESI (3-2, 3.23)

LET'S GO FUEGO: 24-year-old **Joey Lucchesi** is set to return to the mound today vs. Oakland after being placed on the disabled list on 5/15 with a right hip strain, missing the team's last 32 games.

- Today will mark his first start and appearance against an American League opponent.
- Prior to heading to the DL, his 3.23 ERA (17 ER, 47.1 IP) ranked 17th among all NL arms and led all ML rookies.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the Padres' 6-2 loss his last time out on 5/14 vs. COL, tossing 5.0 IP of three-run ball on six hits and one walk allowed.

- He has now tossed at least 5.0 IP and allowed three runs or less in eight starts of his nine starts.

WHILE YOU WERE AWAY: Made one rehab start for Lake Elsinore on 6/14, tossing 4.0-shutout innings against Rancho Cucamonga.

PICK ME BABY ONE MORE TIME: Lucchesi's three pickoffs led all of MLB before being placed on the DL... fellow rookie lefty **Eric Lauer** now leads the majors with his seven pickoffs...their 10 combined pickoffs are the most by a Padres rookie duo since 2009, when **Clayton Richard** and **Josh Geer** combined for six pickoffs.

- **Cory Luebke** recorded the most pickoffs by a rookie in Padres history (four in 2011)...besides Richard's and Geer's three apiece in 2009, the only other Padres to have three pickoffs during their rookie campaigns are current bullpen coach **Doug Bochtler** in 1995 and **Ryan Buchter** in 2016.

NOT SO ROCKY: Is 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3 ER, 16.0 IP) with 17 strikeouts to five walks in his three career starts against the Rockies...Colorado is the only club which he has made more than one start against.

- Became one of just five pitchers to not give up a run in either of his first two starts vs. the Rockies (also: Christian Friedrich in 2016, Jacob deGrom in 2014, Matt Harrison in 2012 and Johan Santana in 2009).
- In his second career start on 4/10 at COL, he became just the seventh pitcher in Padres history to not allow a single earned run in at least 6.0 IP at Coors Field (last: Christian Friedrich, 6/12/16)...it has been done eight times, with Oliver Perez twice (7/7/02 and 9/7/02).

JOEY LU'KK'HESI: Among all ML starting pitchers who have made at least nine starts, his 9.13 SO/9.0 IP ratio leads the Padres staff and ranks 16th in the NL.

APPRECIATE THE HELP: Lucchesi's 6.27 run support average (runs scored while he's in the game) ranks eighth in the majors among all ML pitchers (min. nine games started).

THROUGH 4, UNDER 2.00: Lucchesi logged a 1.66 ERA through his first four starts with a 2-0 record...the last SD pitcher to have a sub-2.00 ERA over his first four MLB starts was Odrisamer Despaigne in 2014 (1.35).

FIRST IN CLASS: Made his Major League debut on 3/30 vs. MIL, becoming the first pitcher of the 2016 draft class to make it to the show...he was the second player overall drafted in 2016 to make it to the majors, following only Orioles **OF Austin Hays**...teammate **Eric Lauer** became the second pitcher of the '16 class to make his MLB debut (April 24 at COL)

- Lucchesi made just 39 minor league starts prior to his big league debut, going 11-9 with a 1.99 ERA (40 ER, 181.0 IP) and 204 SO against 36 BB.

LOOK BACK AT IT: The left-hander was named Padres Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017 after pitching to a combined 11-7 record with a 2.20 ERA (34 ER, 139.0 IP), 148 SO against 33 BB and a .200 opponent batting average in 24 appearances (23 starts) between Lake Elsinore (A) and San Antonio (AA).

- Began the season with Lake Elsinore and earned California League Mid-Season All-Star honors, pitching to a 6-4 record with a 2.52 ERA (22 ER, 78.2 IP) and 95 SO against 19 BB.
- Promoted to San Antonio on 7/1 where he lowered his ERA, pitching to a 1.79 mark (12 ER, 60.1 IP) while striking out 53 and walking just 14.

TYSON'S TURN: RHP **Tyson Ross** is scheduled to make his 15th start of the season tomorrow in Game 1 of the four-game set at AT&T PARK

- Took his first loss since 5/7 his last time out on 6/14 at ATL, tossing a quality start (6.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R) in SD's 4-2 defeat
- Has worked 5.0 IP or more in 13 of his 14 starts, including eight quality outings.
- The Padres have won six of his last seven starts and are 10-4 overall when he takes the mound.

- His 38.0 IP lead the SD bullpen (among relievers yet to make a start)...has posted a 10.42 SO/9 inning ratio.
- Has not allowed more than two earned runs in a single outing.

- Made two starts for the Padres in 2018...is the longest tenured pitcher who has appeared for the Padres at the big league level.
